A word from our Welfare Officer, Karen Harwood Dutt

Parkwyddn football club aims to provide a fun, safe and creative environment for all our, players, coaches and referees to participate in and develop individually and as a team. As an FA Charter standard community football club, we have a number of measures in place to ensure the safety and well being of all our players and volunteers.

Safeguarding and welfare can include simple things like ensuring that each player has suitable kit for training and match days. Ensuring a coach or assistant has relevant DBS checks, training and equipment fit for use. It can also include dealing with aspects of abuse. Each level one coach and club official has completed basic safeguarding and welfare training to support them in their role and they have access to signpost and report any safeguarding they may come across in their role.

RULES

Club Officials

- Each team must have at least one level one qualified coach on its touch line at any game/training.
- Coaches children are exempt from subscription payments for the team their parent guardian is named as the official.
- Teams can only 2 officials with exempt children.
- Any team official must have a DBS and be approved by the committee.
- Team officials should be clearly identified on match days and training.
- Team officials must under they are a club representative and they should follow the FA respect rules and actively promote them with their supporters.
- Team officials must ensure the safety and well-being of players on match days and training whilst on the touch line.



Our

RULES

Registration (club membership)

- Registration payments must be made by all players or parents/guardians. This payment may be waived at the discretion of the management committee.
- Players that have not paid this payment in full will not be eligible to take part in training or matches unless authorised by the management committee.
- Registration may be waived at the discretion of the management committee.
- This payment will be reviewed at the end of each season and is subject to changes.
- Players are able to register for more than one team if playing in different leagues.
- Players are not allowed to play any matches until all requirements are met for registration.

RULES

Subscription Payments

- Payments must be kept up to date. Failure to do this results in suspension from training and games until suitable arrangements are made to bring any outstanding balance up to date.
- Registration fees are required for all players. Any dispensations are made at the discretion of the club's management committee.
- Cross signed players are asked to pay an additional cost if signed to more than one team in the club. This fee may be waived at the discretion of the management committee.
- Player transfers will not be completed if there is an outstanding balance in subscription payments.

RULES

Fines

- All game offences that may carry a fine or match ban must be disclosed to a member of the management committee by the team coach within 24 hours of a game.
- Players are ineligible to train or play in games until a fine is paid in full.
- Where a fine is issued for a player under 18 a parent or guardian is liable to cover the cost. In this instance the player is ineligible to attend training or games until the fine is paid.
- Player transfers will not be permitted until outstanding fine costs are paid.
- Fines outstanding for a period of more than one month will incur an administrative fee of £5 per month the balance is outstanding. This may be waived at the discretion of the management committee.

RULES

Team Kit

- Home and away kits must be the official and club selected kit only.
- All kit must be purchased through Parkwyddn JFC and be approved by the management committee.
- All kits remain under the ownership of the club.
- Players are required to notify their club official of any damage to the kit.
- All kits must be returned to the club if a player transfers.
- If a player leaves and does not return the kit, they will be invoiced for full replacement.

Club Committee

- It is the committees role to ensure each coach is properly vetted.
- It is the committees responsibility to pass on information regarding fines and bans once clarified by the FA.
- The committee will meet with team officials 3 times in a season.
 - The beginning to discuss registration responsibilities.
 - The middle of the season to discuss the season and for coaches to raise any issues.
 - The end of the season to discuss presentation.
- An AGM will be held annually.

Winter Training

- The club aims to organise winter training for each team at a central venue where possible. Each team is allocated one training session per week based on their usual training schedule.
- If a team have a specific venue they prefer different to where the club propose, the club will review and pay for the venue providing the costs are reasonable and in line the going rates.
- In the event of games being cancelled due to bad weather the club cannot provide alternative all weather facilities. In the event of matches being cancelled, the team are free to raise funds and organise all weather facilities to ensure the match can still go ahead.

Tournament Support

- The club will subsidise each team for summer tournaments with an amount of £50 maximum per team. Should the cost of the tournament being claimed for exceed this amount, it will be the teams responsibility to raise the additional funds.
- Should the tournament cost less than £50, the spare monies will remain with the club and will not roll over to another tournament.
- Proof of purchase must be submitted to the club.
- The payment made by the club will be made either direct to the organiser or this can be made to a coach as reimbursement for a payment already made.
