Purpose



- **Uncover Ideological Framing:** Reveal how the European Commission's Türkiye2024 Report constructs an "EU vs. Türkiye" narrative through Teun van Dijk's Ideological Square.
- **Expose Power Relations:** Demonstrate how language choices reproduce or legitimize EU dominance in enlargement discourse (Fairclough & Wodak, 1997; van Dijk, 1993).
- **Bridge Scholarship & Policy:** Showcase CDA's value for analyzing official policy texts, linking linguistic micro-features to macro-level geopolitical effects.
- **Inform Stakeholders:** Provide academics, policymakers, and students with a clear model for critically reading EU reports and similar diplomatic documents.

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Research Questions


- Which of van Dijk's four strategies are most salient in the 2024 report?
- What lexical, grammatical, or rhetorical devices (passives, nominalizations, evaluative adjectives, connectors) enact those strategies?
- How does the resulting discourse legitimize EU policy stances and shape perceptions of EU-Türkiye relations?
- What can this case tell us about the role of official EU discourse in maintaining power asymmetries within enlargement politics?



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DÖRNYEI'S L2 MOTIVATIONAL SELF SYSTEM

- Dörnyei's L2 Motivational Self System is a theory of language learning motivation centered on learners' visions of their future selves as successful L2 users.
- the **Ideal L2 Self** reflects the person the learner aspires to become and includes motivations like career or social integration.
- the **Ought-to Self** involves attributes the learner feels they should possess to meet others' expectations or avoid failure.
- the **L2 Learning Experience** relates to situational factors like the teacher, curriculum, or classroom environment.
- Motivation arises from both internal visions and external influences. This theory emphasizes the role of imagination and real-life experiences in shaping learners' motivation.



Background of the Study

- English for Academic Purposes (EAP) plays a vital role in equipping students with the necessary linguistic and rhetorical skills, and critical thinking for academic success, and focuses on preparing students for discipline-specific academic discourse.
- EAP, a goal-oriented approach, supports non-native English-speaking students and scholars with the linguistic and genre-specific skills needed to participate effectively in academic communities (Hyland & Hamp-Lyons, 2002)
- EAP equips learners to comprehend complex academic content, produce coherent and well-structured texts, take part in academic discussion, and think critically about information and ideas (Flowerdew, 2013).



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ACADEMIC SATISFACTION

Lent et al. (2007) defined academic satisfaction as "the enjoyment of one's role or experiences as a student" (p.87). Academic satisfaction encompasses various aspects, including students' experiences of campus life, the quality of their adaptation to the academic environment, satisfaction with courses, interactions with peers, and overall well-being (Chen & Lo, 2012). Research suggests that academic satisfaction enhances students' self-belief, which in turn contributes to better academic performance and a more fulfilling learning experience (Zapko et al., 2018).

- 1/3 children (aged 6 – 18) say they speak a language other than French at home (4 million children)
- 7 164 primary schools have at least one allophone pupil

Pedagogical Value

"Speaking exams give students a chance to express what they know."

- Encourages active language use
Speaking brings language to life and gives learners a real purpose.
- Builds confidence and autonomy
Students take ownership of their learning through oral expression.
- Moves beyond rote grammar knowledge
Focus shifts from memorization to meaningful communication.



Implementation Challenges

"It takes too much time and students get nervous."
(Interviewee-D)

- Time constraints in crowded classrooms
Large class sizes make one-on-one assessment difficult.
- Uneven performance due to anxiety
Anxious students may underperform in stressful oral tests.
- Difficulties ensuring scoring consistency
Lack of rubrics leads to variation between teachers.

As one of the key measures of linguistic complexity, lexical diversity provides insight into students' vocabulary use, and it is among the factors to take into consideration when tracking writing development. 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The Participants of the Study

- A total of 1441 English teachers
 - currently employed by Turkish Ministry of National Education (around 68000 English teachers) → state schools including primary schools, secondary schools, and high schools across Türkiye
 - 965 ELT & 472 Non-ELT (4 Missing)
 - 1099 Female & 341 Male
 - the youngest teacher was 22 and the oldest teacher was 62 years old
 - return rate was 73 % (1441/2000)
 - participants from 81 cities of Türkiye
- Convenience and snowball sampling
- The sample size was determined depending on the table of sample size provided by Cohen, Manion and Morrison (2007, p. 104).






The nature of the study

- A case study → “portray, analyse and interpret the uniqueness of real individuals and situations through accessible accounts” (Cohen et al., 2007, p. 85)
 - real teachers
- “Case studies are the preferred strategy when ‘how’ and ‘why’ questions are being posed, when the investigator has little control over the events and when the focus is on a contemporary phenomenon within some real-life context” (Yin, 1994, p. 1).
- Qualitative research tradition



In conclusion

- Emphasis on personal traits (respectful, patient, energetic, empathetic)
- Teaching seen as both professional and interpersonal
- High value on pedagogical skills (engaging methods, classroom activities)
- Importance of socio-affective qualities (motivation, emotional support)
- Language proficiency as a fundamental requirement
- Professional development and cultural awareness noted, but less prioritized
- Effective teacher = empathy + instructional skill + motivation + communication
- Implications for teacher training, hiring, and professional growth

• SE refers to teachers' belief in successfully performing teaching tasks (Bandura, 1997). According to Bandura (1986), individuals can shape their environment through beliefs about their abilities. Behavioral, personal, and environmental factors interact to form these beliefs. Language learning is complex and multilayered, influenced by many such factors. While most studies focus on learners' perceptions (Schunk, 2003), instructors' views are equally vital. SE helps predict prospective teachers' classroom performance.

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Communicative Strategies Identified

- Performative intentionality (e.g. promises, justifications, appeals).
- Framing and narrative structuring for persuasion (giving examples of crimes and generalizing the cause of the harm, e.g.: *Laken was stolen from us by a savage, illegal alien gang member ... That's why the very first bill I signed ... mandates the detention of all dangerous criminal aliens.*; giving one-sided views/evaluations: *the tyranny of so-called "diversity, equity, and inclusion" policies; framing immigrants as aliens, criminals, savage gang members, liberal agenda regulations as ridiculous, unfair, corrupt, unaffordable, Insane, etc.*)
- Appeals to shared identity to mask persuasion as solidarity (*Despite the best efforts of those who would try to censor us, silence us, break us, destroy us ... We will never let anything happen to our beloved country.*)
- Strategic ambiguity to allow multiple interpretations (*Now it's our time to take up the righteous cause of American liberty, and it is our turn to take America's destiny into our own hands and begin the most thrilling days in the history of our country.*)

- This study attends to 'accusations in video games'
 - produced and performed by participants in and through interaction
- Accusing as a specific action
- The interactional and sequential organization of accusations (how they are produced and how they are recognized)


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
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

Introduction

Margaret Atwood's *The Handmaid's Tale* depicts a dystopian future in which the Republic of Gilead constructs an altered social reality by exercising ideological control, religious exploitation, and ritualised social practice. 





Concluding remarks

- This paper presents contributions to the understanding of moral work in technologically-mediated situated activities.
 - The social organization of situated activities are intertwined with their moral organization.
- Interactional and sequential organization of accusations in multi-activity settings
 - Descriptions by accusing participants hold opponent gamers responsible for moving away from the moral and expected ways of playing the game.
 - Responses to accusations often justify the conduct on the virtual pitch, treating it as fair.
- This study demonstrates that participants orient to the fair progression of their games by way of marking the transgressive conduct of their opponent gamers in explicit ways.
- Participants treat the conduct of the avatar footballers, mobilized via tangible controllers, on the virtual pitch as accountable (see also Tekin 2024, 2025).





Rethinking Men in Feminism through Masculinity Studies

- Second-wave feminism: men as unified oppressor class.
- Late scholars expanded focus to male vulnerability.
- Masculinity studies emerged to explore male subjectivity.
- Focus on emotional openness, care, and ethical relation.

- Connell (1995, 2005) Hegemonic and subordinated masculinities
- Kimmel (1998) Masculinity as homosocial enactment.
- hooks (2004) Patriarchy harms men through emotional denial.
- Butler (2004) Vulnerability and gender performativity.
- Promoting masculinity as relational and plural.



Literature Review

- Several studies compared ChatGPT's scores with human raters' scores and found a strong correlation (Mizumoto et al., 2024; Shin & Lee, 2024; Yancey, 2023; Yavuz et al., 2023).
- Li and Huang (2024) compared ChatGPT versions 3.5 and 4.0 with teachers; found higher reliability of ChatGPT 4.0.
- Yamashita (2024) found that ChatGPT-4.0's severity level was similar to that of human raters.
- Yancey's study (2023) showed that students' L1 affects the agreement rates between human raters and AI raters.

Disadvantages of Multimodal Writing

- Educators often struggle with limited technology skills, inadequate devices, and poor internet access.
- Administrators and teachers face challenges uniting in-class and out-of-class communication (Bowen and Whithaus, 2013; Vandommelle et al, 2017; Hawisher et al., 2010).

Untraditional (n=5)

- Participant 4 argued that what they did in their classes, although they did not know about the term multimodality, let their classes be more than "just using language in written form like texts or sentences"
- Participant 9: "*I know that the more different ways students learn something, the better they will learn and remember*"



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


- Participant 4 argued that what they did in their classes, although they did not know about the term multimodality, let their classes be more than “*just using language in written form like texts or sentences*”
- Participant 9: “*I know that the more different ways students learn something, the better they will learn and remember*”




4. CONCLUSION

The study finds that teachers prioritize listening and speaking, but students struggle most with speaking and writing due to anxiety and low confidence. Teachers use flexible, student-centered strategies such as gamification, group work, visuals, and simplification, and technology tools like Kahoot and ChatGPT to boost motivation and engagement. At that point, flexibility and innovation are have a great importance since theoretical knowledge from teacher education needs to be adapted to classroom realities even if it is helpful.

Effective teaching requires balancing all skills, adapting to classroom needs, and integrating tech for better learning outcomes.





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

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

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Theoretical Background and Literature Review

- With the shifts to **social constructivist** paradigm, the perception towards teacher learning has changed.
 - *By linking expert knowledge and experiential knowledge, teachers gain new understandings of their teaching and themselves.*
 - *It is a complex and long-term process which is manifested through participation in teaching and learning contexts (Freeman & Johnson, 1998) rather than being absorption of knowledge in a single moment.*
- The shifts regarding teacher learning paved the way for emergence of **reflective approach** within **SLTE**, and reflection has been at the center of innovations in SLTE (Farrell, 2015a, 2015b).



Participants

The study involved 12 participants from various fields across Turkey.

The participants were:

- Psychological Counselors
- Primary School Teachers
- Mathematics Educators

All participants were native English speakers and had experience in teaching Professional English as a Foreign Language.

Their ages ranged from 25 to 50 years old.





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

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

The Polis: Digital Bodies, Mutable Selves

Consciousness as Software

In the polis, consciousness functions like software, with mutable avatars representing identity, detaching self from fixed representation.

Gleisner Bodies

Yatima's transition to a physical gleisner body demonstrates identity's persistence: "All invariants intact" (Egan 145), suggesting identity resides in mental patterns, not physical ones.

Normadic Subjectivity

Rosi Braidotti's "normadic subjectivity" applies, defining the posthuman as a "multiple and non-unitary entity... defined by relationality and process" (Braidotti 190).

Yatima's seamless transitions across bodies and viewpoints embody this relational existence. The citizens of the polis illustrate subjectivity as informational transmission, not material substance.





