




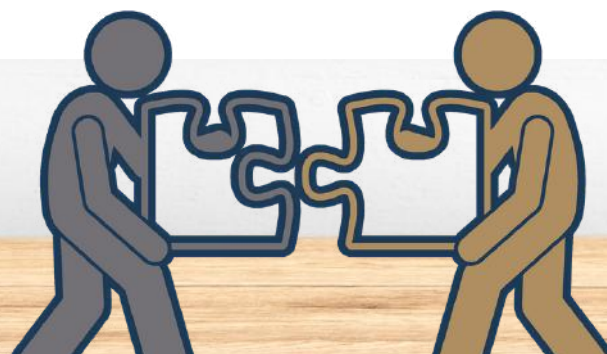
## THE BASICS

### Term & Permanent Life

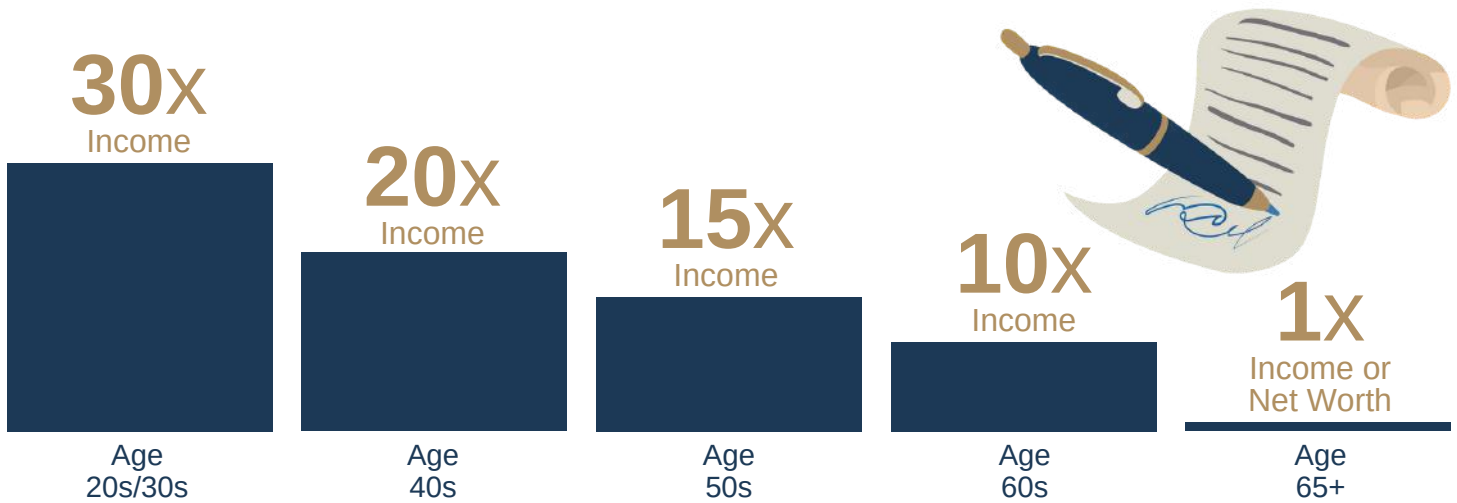

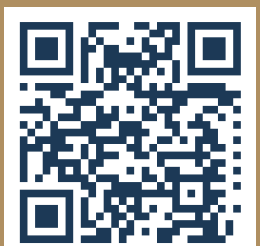
