To add an Individual Account

Click "register an individual or family" then "I'm registering myself." Submit your information and start logging!

To add a Family Account

Click "register an individual or family" then "I'm an adult registering a child." Fill in adult account creator information, then continue to add reader(s) information as needed. Once an adult is logged in, they have access to all members.

Only one email address per account can be used, this includes family or individual accounts.

KIDS: (Babies - going into 5th grade)

Earn a badge for every hour you read or are read to! Badges are awarded in your SummerBASH online reading tracker, Beanstack, and will only be earned when **LOGGING MINUTES**.

YOUNG ADULTS: (going into 6-12 grades)

Earn points to unlock badge prizes and enter raffles for big prizes! You'll receive a badge prize at 400, 2,000, 4,000, 10,000, and 20,000 points. Electronic raffle tickets for Big Prizes are available for every 400 points (up to 40,000 points).

Points system:

1 Book = 400 points

3 1 Minute = 1 point

ADULTS: (Ages 17 and up)

Earn points to unlock badge prizes and enter raffles for big prizes! You'll receive a badge prize at 2,000, 4,000, 10,000, and 20,000 points. Electronic raffle tickets for Big Prizes are available for every 400 points (up to 40,000 points) earned through reading or completing activities in Beanstack.

Points System:

1 Book = 400 points

3 Minute = 1 point

Reading to a child or a magazine?

Only log that time by minutes in Beanstack.

Where do I find out if an event location or time has been changed?

Visit louisburglibrary.org or Louisburg Library's Facebook page for current location and inclement weather information.

What happens if I am not feeling well and want to visit the library?

What happens if I need to cancel an event registration?

There are a couple of easy ways to cancel.

How much does an event cost?

Not all events have a fee. Some do. All events that have a fee require registration.






