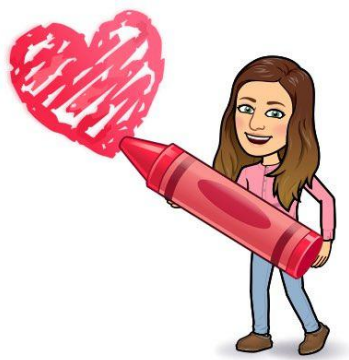
# MEET YOUR EVENT PLANNERS

### To add an Individual Account

Click “register an individual or family” then “I’m registering myself.” Submit your information and start logging!

### To add a Family Account

Click “register an individual or family” then “I’m an adult registering a child.” Fill in adult account creator information, then continue to add reader(s) information as needed. Once an adult is logged in, they have access to all members.

Only one email address per account can be used,

### **KIDS: (Babies – going into 5th grade)**

Earn a badge for every hour you read or are read to! Badges are awarded in your SummerBASH online reading tracker, Beanstack, and will only be earned when **LOGGING MINUTES**.

## **Where do I find out if an event location or time has been changed?**
