# ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

ISZL provides a rigorous college preparatory high school curriculum that leads to our NEASC-accredited ISZL High School Diploma. All students partake in a well-rounded educational experience through the successful completion of the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) in Grades 9–10. In Grades 11–12, students have the opportunity to choose between the IB Diploma Programme or ISZL High School Programme. At this time, we have approximately an even 50/50 split between students completing IBDP and those in the High School/AP Programme.

## HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from ISZL, students must demonstrate satisfactory completion of the IB Middle Years Programme and subsequent satisfactory completion of the IB Diploma Programme, or the ISZL High School Programme, including a minimum of:

- Ten courses over Grades 11 and 12
- Six courses in both Grades 9 and 10
- Four years: Service Project(s)
- Three years: English and Humanities and Science and Mathematics (at least one year in Grade 11 or 12)
- Two years: Language Acquisition
- Two years: Arts or Design or Physical and Health Education

## CLASS OF 2025

The Class of 2025 has 115 students. The High School enrolment is 474 students, with approximately 120 students per grade level.

## ISZL GRADING SYSTEM

### ISZL 7-POINT GRADING SCALE VS. LETTER GRADE AND PERCENTAGE RANGE

ISZL employs a 7-point internal grading scale influenced by, but not equivalent to, the IB 1–7 grading system. ISZL does not produce or report a Grade Point Average (GPA) nor rank students.

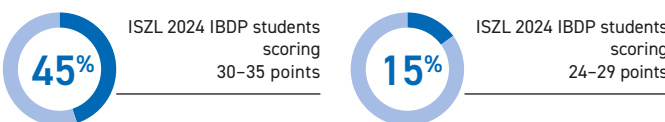
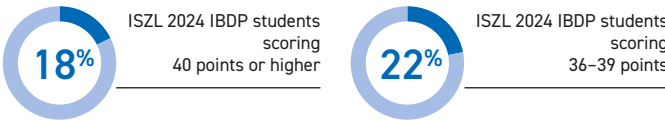
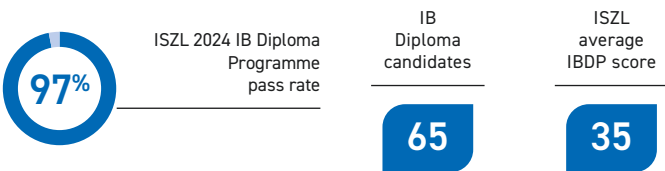
