

Doris Una Skyring Memorial Scholarship Terms & Conditions

This scholarship was founded in 1959 from a legacy of the estate of the late Dr Doris Una Skyring.

- 1. The name of the scholarship shall be "The Doris Una Skyring Memorial Scholarship".
- The scholarship is for one year for a program of study in Medicine at the University of Queensland.
- 3. Subject to availability of funding, the scholarship shall be awarded to a student who is resident in The Women's College during the tenure of the scholarship and who is pursuing a program in Medicine at the University of Queensland.
- 4. If the applicant is a current resident of College the Principal will make recommendations to Council.
- 5. If no current resident wishes to avail herself of the scholarship, it may be advertised and a sub-committee of Council, appointed for the purpose of selection of a suitable candidate, will make recommendations to Council.
- 6. The scholarship shall not be awarded in any year where there is no candidate deemed to be of sufficient merit.
- 7. In making the award, the Council may take into account:
 - a) previous academic record
 - b) other factors deemed by Council or its committee to be relevant to the award.
- 8. The value, and frequency of any award, shall be determined by the College Council, having regard to maintaining the capital value of the investment.
- 9. The emoluments of the scholarship shall be paid in equal instalments to coincide with the issue of each College account and by deduction from the account.
- 10. The Council may revoke the award of the scholarship during its tenure if, acting on a decision by an absolute majority of Council members, such action is deemed to be necessary.
