
Through classes, workshops, trips, mentoring and more, the Institute offers you a safe space to learn all about God, ask questions and develop a meaningful relationship with Him.

SO, WHAT DOES THE JOURNEY LOOK LIKE?



1 EXPLORER

For those exploring the Christian faith or wanting to go back to the basics, we have created on-demand classes that introduce you to God and foundational Christian beliefs/practices. You can learn on your own time, at your own pace, commitment-free.

10 Sessions, Total Time: 1 hour 34 minutes




CHRISTIAN APOLOGETICS

If you've never looked into the Enneagram, now is the time. This on-demand class provides the perfect starting point for beginners and a roadmap for how to go deeper and wider with the Enneagram as you seek to discover more about yourself.

EVANGELISM IN THE MODERN WORLD 101

Jesus commissioned all Christ followers with the joy and responsibility of sharing the good news about God's salvation and grace with other people. So why do

many of us find this to be so difficult? Fear, insecurity, intimidation - all of these can be boundaries, not to mention the difficulty of navigating the changing beliefs of culture and biblical truth. In this class, you'll confront the barriers that are keeping you from sharing about Jesus and practically learn how to navigate conversations of faith.

As a parent, it can be hard to keep up with, much less navigate, what platforms your kids are using these days. In this practical class, we'll introduce the most commonly used media outlets, explain the potential dangers of each, and give some practical suggestions on what you as a parent can do to help guide your kids.

(FOR HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE STUDENTS):

This is a class you won't get to take in school but that you absolutely need for the real world. Set your financial portfolio off on the right foot by starting with Money Seeds.

SETTING SAIL: LIVING WITH PURPOSE

Kierkegaard famously said, "Life can only be understood backwards, but it must be lived forwards." Add ideas like "hindsight is 20/20," coupled with the fast pace of

life that leaves little room for thoughtful decision making, and we can often feel like our only option is to move through life and hope for the best. But what if you could develop a map of sorts that would guide you in the direction you wanted to go? In Setting Sail, we will look at how we might form a vision for our lives that will do just that.

Whether you are a young adult, in mid-life, or retired; whether you're single or married; whether you have a house full of children or you're an empty nester - this class will help you think through what God made you for and how you can get there.

THEOLOGY ON TAP

The word theology comes from the Greek words *theos* and *logos* and literally means "words about God." In other words, talking about God. But when most people hear the term "theology" they think of it as

something set aside for pastors who are attending seminary. But at its heart, theology has to do with the answers Christians give to questions people have about God and all things related to God. It's attempting to speak Christianly about the great issues of life; it's about having a biblical worldview; it's about forming a Christian mind. In this ondemand class, Senior Pastor Jim White takes his seminary-level course on systematic theology and breaks it down in a way that anyone can understand. In his words, "Let's pretend it's just you and me, sitting down together having a pint and talking about theology." In other words, this is going to be a theology discussion unlike any other, and we hope you'll join us for it.

Ultimately, the Christian life is not simply the accumulation of knowledge about God. Instead, it's about letting that knowledge transform who we are so that we can draw closer to God and position ourselves to be changed by Him. One of the best ways to embody what you learn is by participating in community with others. Our live classes and workshops offer you the opportunity to talk about what you're learning, ask challenging questions, experience encouragement and accountability, grow as you explore others' perspectives, and meet some wonderful people in the process.



A SINGLE LIFE

Every human being experiences singleness at some point in their life, and some for their entire life. In fact, singleness is currently at a record high in our culture. And yet, few of us have discovered the key to thriving as

single adults or have stopped to consider the unique ways in which singleness can draw us closer to God. In this class, we'll explore the many purposes God has for singleness, we'll examine Jesus' model of singleness, we'll troubleshoot some of the unique challenges of the single life, and we'll discuss the robust opportunities for communal life that are available. Whether you currently find yourself discontent in your singleness or loving every moment of it, this class will supply you with fresh vision and support.

BABY STEPS: BEGINNING THE PARENTING JOURNEY WELL

(FOR PARENTS OF NEWBORNS TO 18-MONTH-OLDS)

Congratulations on entering the wonderful adventure of parenthood! So, what exactly did you get yourself into? More importantly,

what kind of parent does God want you to be? In this class, we focus on you as the parent – celebrating your call to be a mother or father and helping you to understand the spiritual impact that you will have on your child. And as your church, we'll walk you through all the ways in which we aim to support you as you seek to raise your child in a Christ-centered home. Together, we will help you dream big for your child and learn how to make those dreams a reality.

THE BIG PICTURE BIBLE STUDY

RECOMMENDED PREREQUISITE: EXPLORING THE BIBLE (ON DEMAND)

The Big Picture Bible Study is an in-depth, chronological study of the whole Bible. In its entirety, it comprises 10 separate studies spread out over a two-year time frame. Students can enter the Study at any time.



WHAT WE'RE STUDYING THIS SEMESTER: The Writings (series #6)

In The Writings, we're going to backtrack a bit in our chronological study of the Bible to tackle some poetic books and wisdom writing; specifically, we'll read the books of Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes and the Song of Songs. We'll dive into the historical and cultural contexts of these books and learn how to properly interpret wisdom literature

The Gospels (series #7)

In this series, we're turning to the New Testament to study the central figure of the entire Bible – Jesus of Nazareth. We'll study the four biographical accounts of His life – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John - to find out

what made this God-man such a polarizing figure. With intertestamental background, we will dig into the historical and religious climate of the world in the first century, taking an immersive look into the context of Jesus' audience.

CHRISTIAN CLASSICS

Because we are made in God's image, every person possesses the power to create. For those who are Christians, this includes the power to create beautiful images, inspiring music, and engaging stories that emerge

from their faith. In this class, we will read selections from great Christian writers and explore the way their words and wisdom can help guide us on our own spiritual journeys. In this edition of Christian Classics we will be reading selections from two great medieval writers (Dante and Chaucer), a selection of great Christian poetry, and a contemporary best-selling author, Bryan Stevenson.

CHRISTIANITY AND OTHER WORLDVIEWS

In this year-long series, we'll discuss the core beliefs of various faith systems throughout the world. We'll talk about evaluating truth claims, we'll compare and contrast

different faiths with Christianity; and we'll learn how to build bridges with adherents of other religions. This Spring we'll discuss Islam and Judaism. Over the summer, we'll tackle Mormonism and Jehovah's Witnesses, and then we'll wrap up with Eastern religions, contemporary spirituality and postmodernism in the Fall.




HOW TO ENJOY READING YOUR BIBLE

If you're a Christian, you know spending time in the Bible is important. Yet so many of us struggle to read it regularly. It feels like just another task to check off our list. We may

What if reading the Bible, though, wasn't something we felt like we ought to do, but something we actually enjoyed doing? That's what this class is all about – getting from "I ought to read the Bible" to "I can't wait to read the Bible!"

JESUS' FINAL DAYS

Beginning February 11, we're going to spend seven weeks preparing our hearts for Easter by studying Jesus' final week before His death. No previous Bible study experience is necessary. We're going to enjoy digging into

God's Word together, studying the cultural context of Jesus' day while also extracting practical applications for our modern context.

THE JOURNEY TO EASTER

Easter celebrates the most significant event in Christian history, but often because of its lack of a fixed date on the calendar it seems to pop up out of nowhere. We spend much of our time getting ready to

acknowledge and celebrate this miraculous event by rushing to buy plastic eggs, chocolate rabbits, pretty dresses, and preparing Easter dinner. What if there was a way to really steep ourselves in the majesty of God's plan for Easter, in the sacrifice of the crucifixion, and what that means for us today? What if Easter isn't simply meant to be an event but rather a journey? Enter Lent. Lent is an ancient practice that takes us on that very journey, preparing our hearts and minds to both savor Easter and respond to it in transformative ways. In this single-session class we will talk about the intention behind Lent and how you might enter into your own Lenten practice.

MARRIAGE PREP

Marriage Prep is a course designed to help couples get ready, not just for the big day but for a lifelong, Christ-centered marriage. If you are planning to be married by a Meck pastor, Marriage Prep is a required part of our

premarital process. However, we encourage any engaged couple to participate.

MONEY GOD'S WAY

Jesus talked about it more than prayer. He also talked about it more than faith. Why would Jesus put such an emphasis on money? Does He want us to be rich? Does He want us to give everything away?

Wherever you are with money, this class is designed to put a new perspective on the topic so you can learn what it means to manage money God's way. We'll unpack budgeting, debt management, insurance, investing and more in a practical, yet biblical way.

PARENTING WORKSHOP: THE CHARACTER OF GOD

We believe that parents are called to be the primary influencers of their children's spiritual lives. We also believe that it is no easy task! Depending on your own

upbringing you may or may not have a clear vision of what it looks like to lead your child toward God. You may wonder: "How can I help my child gain a clear and true understanding of what Christianity is? How do we bring God into the conversation naturally? How do we answer tough questions?"

As your church community, we hope to partner with you in answering those questions and giving you the confidence you need to lead your child well. That's why we are offering new Saturday morning workshops where we invite you to bring your child with you to see family discipleship in action and practice it for yourself. Our first workshop will focus on the character of God. Just as we would never want our kids to enter into a relationship with another human without a sense of that person's character, they need to understand who God is before they can make a choice to live alongside Him. We will look at ways in which we can fold the practice of introducing the character of God into the ordinary parts of our days.

PRAYING FOR YOUR CHILD AND THEIR

Having a child has been described as having your heart exist outside your body. We worry for them, have hopes for them, and grieve alongside them, but

often we aren't in a practice of praying for them. It can be hard to find a balance of praying for our own desires for our kids while still feeling like we are honoring their free will and God's eternal will. In this class, we will explore the role of prayer in a parent's life: how we can articulate our hopes and worries in prayer and simultaneously lay them before God, and how we can build a community practice of praying for the children in our lives that we care for. Each month we will explore a different topic of prayer and spend time practicing different ways we can pray for our young children, unborn children, teens, foster children, nieces and nephews, grandchildren, and adult children.

OVERVIEW:

The Christian life is a life of transformation. The apostle Paul described it this way: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" (2 Corinthians 5:17, NIV). And yet this life change doesn't happen in isolation. Instead, God delivers us from a life enslaved to sin and into a community of fellow believers who can encourage us, support us and keep us directed toward Him.

The Institute's Spiritual Mentoring Program allows participants the opportunity to target specific areas of spiritual growth they hope to pursue and then develop them within the context of biblical community.

This program is perfect for any Christ-follower who wants to mature their relationship with God, connect with others with similar goals, and who is willing to learn from a mentor's guidance and accountability.

STRUCTURE:

Participants are placed in small groups (3-5 participants or couples) under the direction of a volunteer spiritual mentor. While the mentors are not professional counselors or sinless examples, they have walked a similar road and are able to provide the wisdom of experience, hindsight and reflection. Additionally, they serve as guides, helping participants seek God's counsel to become aware of opportunities for growth, establish a strategy to achieve specific goals, identify obstacles that might derail one's focus, and keep participants focused on God throughout the process. Specifically, mentors are available in the areas of:

- Marriage
- Parenting
- Spiritual Formation (i.e. developing spiritual disciplines, experiencing Christian community, outwardly expressing one's of faith, etc.)

The Spiritual Mentoring Program is structured with monthly meetings spread over the course of seven months (from March through September), combining one-on-one and group meetings:

PARTICIPANT EXPECTATIONS:


In addition to attending the monthly meetings, participants are expected to complete personal reflection assignments and preparation exercises throughout the program. Participants are required to apply for the program and will be selected based on suitedness and availability. For marriage and parenting mentoring, both spouses must be present unless in a single-parent home. If selected, participants will receive training and more specific details about the program. Mentor and mentee applications will be accepted beginning January 2024.

GENERAL

Are classes only for people who attend Meck?

No! Meck Institute classes are open to anyone and everyone to attend. Some classes are age-specific (noted in the class description); otherwise, there are no restrictions. In fact, we encourage you to invite friends, family, coworkers, etc. to attend with you.

How much do classes cost?

Most classes are completely FREE. Only a handful of classes require a small fee to cover material costs.

What supplies do I need to take a class?

Most of our classes will have an accompanying workbook, which will be provided for you. You'll have the option when you register to have yours emailed to you as a PDF, shipped to you, or you can pick it up at Meck's campus in Charlotte.

Are classes in person or online?

Both. We offer in-person, live streamed, online and on-demand classes. The format of each class is indicated in the class description. Here's an easy breakdown:

- In person classes take place live in a physical classroom at Mecklenburg Community Church.
- Live stream classes also take place live in a physical classroom at Meck, but you
 can choose to attend virtually.
- Online classes are live but exclusively online, with the teacher joining you in the virtual classroom.
- On demand classes are pre-recorded and available for you to access at any time.

What does it mean to attend a class via live stream?

When in-person classes feature a live stream viewing option, the teacher will be in a physical classroom with in-person students, but you can opt to participate in class virtually. You'll be able to ask questions and take part in group discussions, but from the comfort of your home (or wherever you are).

I registered for a class, but I can no longer make it. What should I do?

No worries! Life happens, and we get that. Simply email meckinstitute@mecklenburg. org to let us know you cannot make it.

IN-PERSON CLASSES

Do you offer childcare?

Sometimes. If you attend an in-person class on a Sunday, you can utilize MecKidz for your children while you're in class. For weekday classes, we offer childcare for most of our parenting classes.

ONLINE CLASSES

Are the online classes live or pre-recorded?

Most classes are live unless designated as "on-demand." We believe that learning takes place best within community, and live classes provide a great atmosphere for meeting new people and forming meaningful relationships. Additionally, you'll be able to chat with the instructor and receive feedback in real time. If you're not comfortable attending live, or if your schedule doesn't afford you that option, you can always register and wait until the class recording is available a few days after the live class takes place.

Will I be on video?

While we encourage everyone to have their camera turned on during class, it's not mandatory in our adult classes. We do, however, insist on having cameras on for our children's classes as an additional security measure. But don't let the camera be a deterrent to your participation. The atmosphere of our online classes is casual, so feel free to wear your pajamas, eat dinner while participating, and even have your cat join you for class as well.

Do I need to download any software?

Not unless you want to. We utilize Zoom for our online classes, and you can attend a class through your web browser without downloading any additional software. However, to access the full functionality of Zoom, we encourage you to download the desktop app on your computer or the Zoom app on your phone. Once you click on the classroom link (which you'll receive via email), you'll be prompted to download Zoom if you haven't already. If you don't wish to, simply select "ignore", and you'll be able to access the meeting through your web browser.

Can I access class recordings?

You sure can! A few days after class, you'll receive an email with the class recording. You'll be able to watch it as many times as you'd like for three months.
