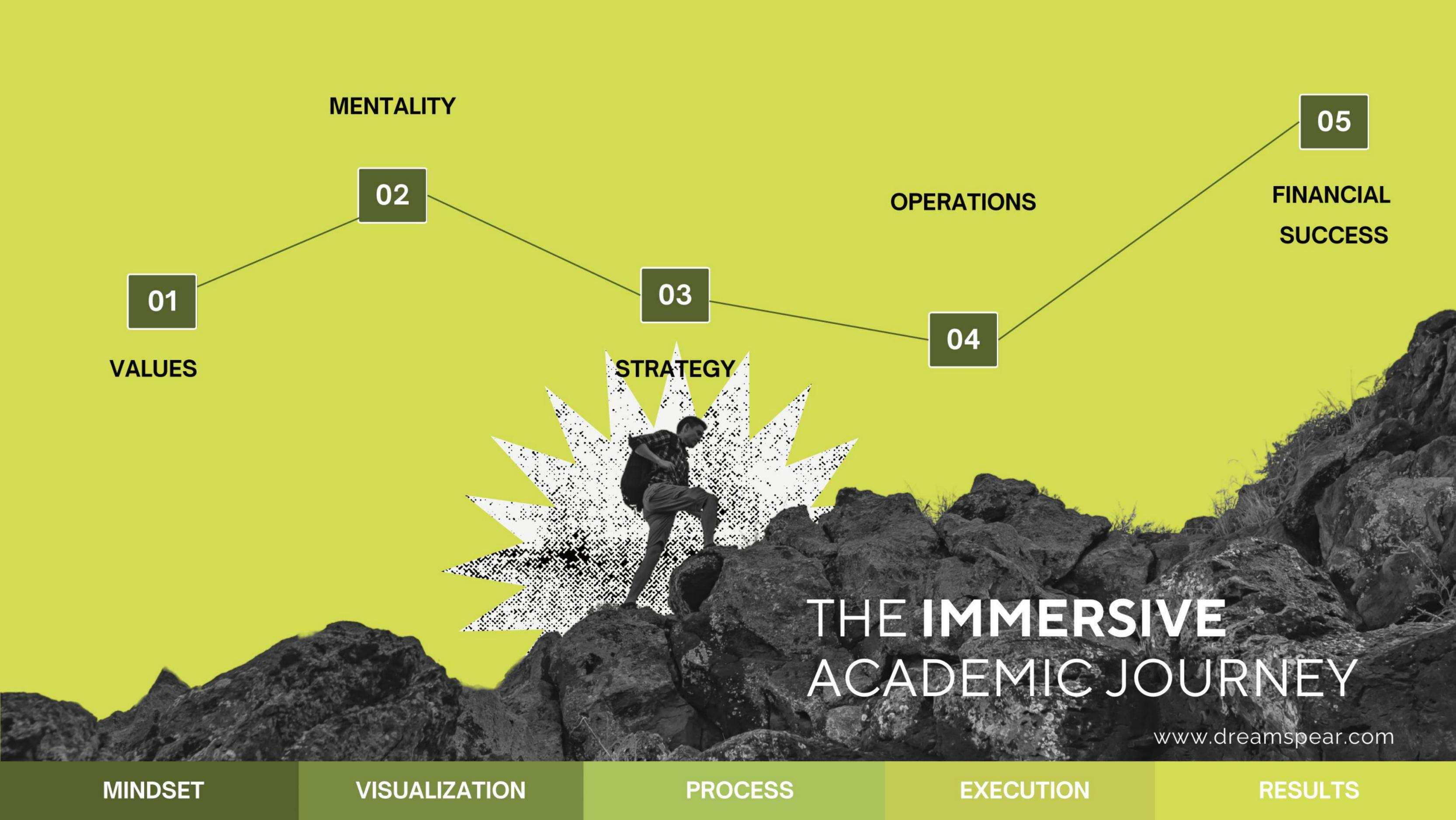

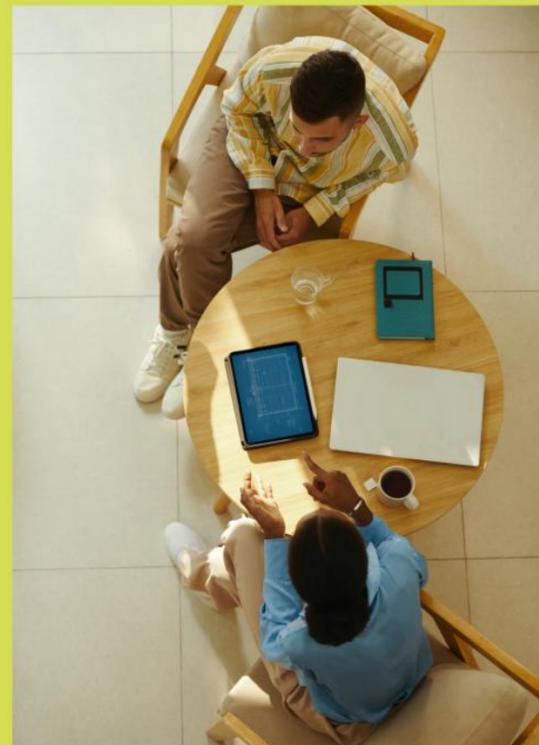

IMMERSIVE LEARNING

The program takes place in Pedasí, Panama, which functions as a living learning laboratory where students engage with local culture, nature, and community experiences.

This environment allows participants to connect theory with real-world context, fostering deeper learning and personal development.

THE EXPERIENCE

*During the camp, students take part in **hands-on business projects, team challenges, and innovation labs**, applying **real-world problem-solving skills** in a **practical setting**.*

*Learning sessions are **balanced** with **outdoor activities** such as **surfing, beach exploration, cultural visits, and guided outdoor experiences**, allowing students to **reset, connect, and build confidence** outside of **traditional classrooms**.*



This **experience** is designed to **help students** develop **initiative, communication, teamwork, and decision-making skills**, while **gaining exposure** to **entrepreneurship** in a **real-life context**.

By the end of the program, participants return home with **stronger independence, clearer thinking, and practical tools** they can **apply** to their **academic and personal growth**.

2 Hold your space in the program of your choice.

Make your program or internship selection and complete the Contact Information form. Submit the deposit and application fee, that holds your spot on the program as you complete the remaining steps of the application.

3 Complete the online application.

Part of the application process is for you to reflect on yourself as an applicant. Complete a brief series of short answer essay questions and a self-evaluation, which help us get to know your motivation for going on a DreamSpear program. This also ensures that your interests are aligned with what the program offers. Finally, complete a medical questionnaire, which helps us prepare to accommodate for preexisting conditions, food allergies and other safety and health-related considerations.

CAMP Q&A

What is DreamSpear ?

DreamSpear Azuero is a 15-day and 21-day immersive educational camp focused on entrepreneurship, innovation, leadership, and real-world learning. Students learn through hands-on projects, community engagement, cultural immersion, and outdoor challenges – not traditional classroom lectures.

Who is this camp for?

This program is designed for students ages 18–25 who are curious and interested in learn about leadership, entrepreneurship, creativity, and meaningful experiences beyond traditional education.

Where is the camp located?

The camp is hosted in Pedasí, Azuero Peninsula, Panama, with the main base an oceanfront learning space that serves as the center for activities, classes, and student life.

How do students arrive?

Students arrive in Panama City, where the program begins. The following day, the group can either flies together to Pedasí or get by our recommended shuttles, ensuring safe and supervised travel throughout the program.

What is the learning structure like?

Each day combines:

- experiential classes (mindset, innovation, leadership)
- community projects with local organizations
- outdoor challenges (surf, hike, kayak, etc.)
- cultural workshops (cooking, artisan labs, storytelling)
- individual project development
- Learning follows the DreamSpear framework: Mindset → Visualization → Process → Execution.

Do students work on a project?

Yes. Every student develops an individual entrepreneurship or innovation project from observation to final presentation, supported by group activities and daily mentorship.

What kinds of activities are included?

Students participate in:

- surf and water sports
- hiking and nature exploration
- community service with local NGOs
- cooking labs and cultural workshops
- leadership and trust challenges
- creative labs and reflection sessions

All activities are designed as learning experiences, not excursions.

What are accommodations like?

Students stay in shared bedrooms at Hotel Punta Franca to encourage community living. A limited number of private rooms with private bathrooms(6) are available for an additional fee.

What is the student-to-staff ratio?

The camp maintains a regular 10:1 student-to-staff ratio, ensuring close supervision, mentorship, and support at all times.

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
