But the idea didn't come from farmers or movie-theatre-chain-owners – it actually started with a group of grade school students at Cunningham Elementary School in Joliet (now billed as "The Home of the Comets and Kernel Kids"). The law designating popcorn "the official State snackfood of the State of Illinois" was enacted in 2003. It seems only fitting, since the state's official vegetable and grain are both also corn. (The official state pie, however, is pumpkin.)

### The largest tree, by volume, in the world - General Sherman in Sequoia National Park



At about 52,500 cubic feet when it was last measured accurately in the 1980s, General Sherman is the world's largest tree as measured by volume. (For reference, that's about half the volume of an Olympic-size swimming pool.) But despite being big, General Sherman is not particularly old by sequoia standards — the tree is only about 2,000 years young, whereas other sequoias are thought to be more than 3,000 years old. Hyperion, by the way, is the world's tallest known living tree, but not the biggest overall. It's almost 380 feet tall, whereas General Sherman is about 275 feet high.
