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PARADIGM SHIFT: Maintenance to Mission

What We Know:

The Conveyor Belt, assembly line, consumer-based model of formation has failed us. Already Pre-COVID, parishes nationwide experienced record numbers of attrition, growing apathy and disconnection. We know something different must be done, but letting go of that which is familiar, even though it is failing us, is difficult for many of us.



THE VISION:

Youth Ministry should bring young people to:




BELONG LISTEN

BELIEVE TEACH

Small vs. Large, Relationships, Caring Accompaniment, Listening, Responding, Sharing, Witness, Formation



BECOME SEND

Transformation, Conversion, Sacrament, Commitment, Share, Desire, Witness, Relationships, Serve

DISCIPLING PROCESS:

Every parish is different in charism, culture and tradition necessitating variations in ministry style. The Office of Marriage, Family Life, Faith Formation and Youth Ministry has developed a discernment process and will accompany parishes in building customized ministry (grades 6-12) using the vision as a guide.
