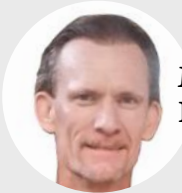

## Should we still send traditional Christmas cards in the age of social media and e-cards?

Facebook posts and Instagram captions wishing goodwill and holiday cheer have begun to flood social-media feeds. But for many, Elf Yourself, JibJab and digital e-cards have nothing on the traditional ones that arrive in the mail. "Opening the inbox just isn't the same as opening the mailbox," said Kyra Blaksley of Gilbert.

While far fewer people use the U.S. Postal Service — 154.3 billion pieces of mail were sent in 2016, down from 212.2 billion in 2007 — the holidays still see people buying stamps and addressing stacks of cards. In 2015, 1.6 billion Christmas holiday cards were sold, holding steady from recent years, according to the national Greeting Card Association. That's still down from 2.7 billion reported in 1995.

We asked (on social media, of course) whether we should still send Christmas cards. The response was a fierce "yes." Some say they let the tradition go to avoid the stress, but the resounding majority of more than 250 comments on Go Gilbert, Living Chandler, Love Mesa Life, and Surprise Matters Facebook groups offered clear advice to the fence-sitters: Send Christmas cards.



- They're more personal.
- It shows the sender took time, instead of just clicking a button online.
- It beats the heck out of bills and junk mail stuffed in the mailbox.
- Cards help decorate the house.
- And it's tradition.

While many say the number of cards they receive has dwindled, and that social media is the culprit, they agreed that nothing beats a handwritten card. You can't hold an email. "Social media doesn't last forever," Gilbert resident Susan Vucko said. "You can't pick up an (online post) and see that handwriting." Her family treasures are pulling out handwritten cards of Christmases past from her mother-in-law, who has passed away. "It's like hearing her voice again. Social media can't do that," Vucko said.

Family photo Christmas cards are a favorite for many. And what could be more adorable than newborns and pets? For Cathleen De La Torre in Surprise, Christmas cards kick off the holiday season. As a child, Aunt Marie's card would show up like clockwork the day after Thanksgiving. "That card let me know that Santa would be here soon," she said. De La Torre now sends more than 200 Christmas cards the day before Thanksgiving. "Mine might be the first one you receive but still to this day my Aunt Marie's card is always the first one I receive."

But what type of card to send? A recent Arizona transplant found state-themed cards from Prickly Pear Paper in Gilbert to send to her Midwestern friends and family. Many of the cards feature a saguaro instead of the typical snowy scene.

While retailers offer greeting cards that sing, light up and unfold with pop-up scenes, some like to send more personalized handmade or photo cards. "The younger generation sends out all of the family photo cards, which we just love. They're into doing Christmas cards in their own, new way," Vucko said.

Chandler resident Billie Freiwald says older people sending store-bought cards with simple signatures make up the bulk of what she receives. But she values the photos and messages. "If you can't spend time together in person, this is the next best thing," she said.

You can't hang an Instagram. Artfully displaying cards is part of the tradition for many. Whether hanging cards around an entryway or using twine to string them across the room, many say they display each and every card they receive. Another saves the prettiest cards each year to cut and use as gift tags next Christmas.

So, dust off your creativity — or borrow some from Pinterest — because the cards are coming.

**Fascinating Poinsettia Facts**



Impress your friends and family this Christmas when you share these poinsettia facts:

- \***How big do Poinsettias get?** - In its native habitat of Mexico and Central America, the poinsettia can grow as large as a small tree, up to 16 feet tall.
- \***Butterflies Love Them.** - Butterflies love the flowers of poinsettia. If you live in a warmer climate (no frosts or freezes at all), plant your poinsettias outside to draw butterflies to your garden.
- \***Not So Toxic.** - Despite the widespread myth, poinsettias are not extremely poisonous. Though the sap is mildly toxic and causes stomach distress, no deaths of people or animals have been reported from eating poinsettia. In fact, studies say that a 50-pound child would need to eat 500 leaves before being in grave danger. Given that poinsettia is very bitter, it's unlikely a child or pet would take more than one bite.
- \* **What are some other uses for poinsettias?** - Poinsettia is a flowering plant. The whole plant and its sap (latex) are used to make medicine. ... Some people apply poinsettia latex directly to the skin (use topically) to remove hair, treat warts, and heal other skin disorders. It also used topically for toothaches.
- \* **Why do we have poinsettias at Christmas?** - The bright red flowers were known as the 'Flores de Noche Buena,' or 'Flowers of the Holy Night.' The shape of the poinsettia flower and leaves are sometimes thought as a symbol of the Star of Bethlehem which led the Wise Men to Jesus. The red colored leaves symbolize the blood of Christ.
