



We work in the City, and people call us when they need help keeping their neighborhoods clean and safe.

One of our jobs is to make sure people working in your home have permits. Permits allow the City to make sure work is done safely.




Sometimes a house may have way too many pets.



Sometimes we have to visit stores because someone painted graffiti on the wall.




