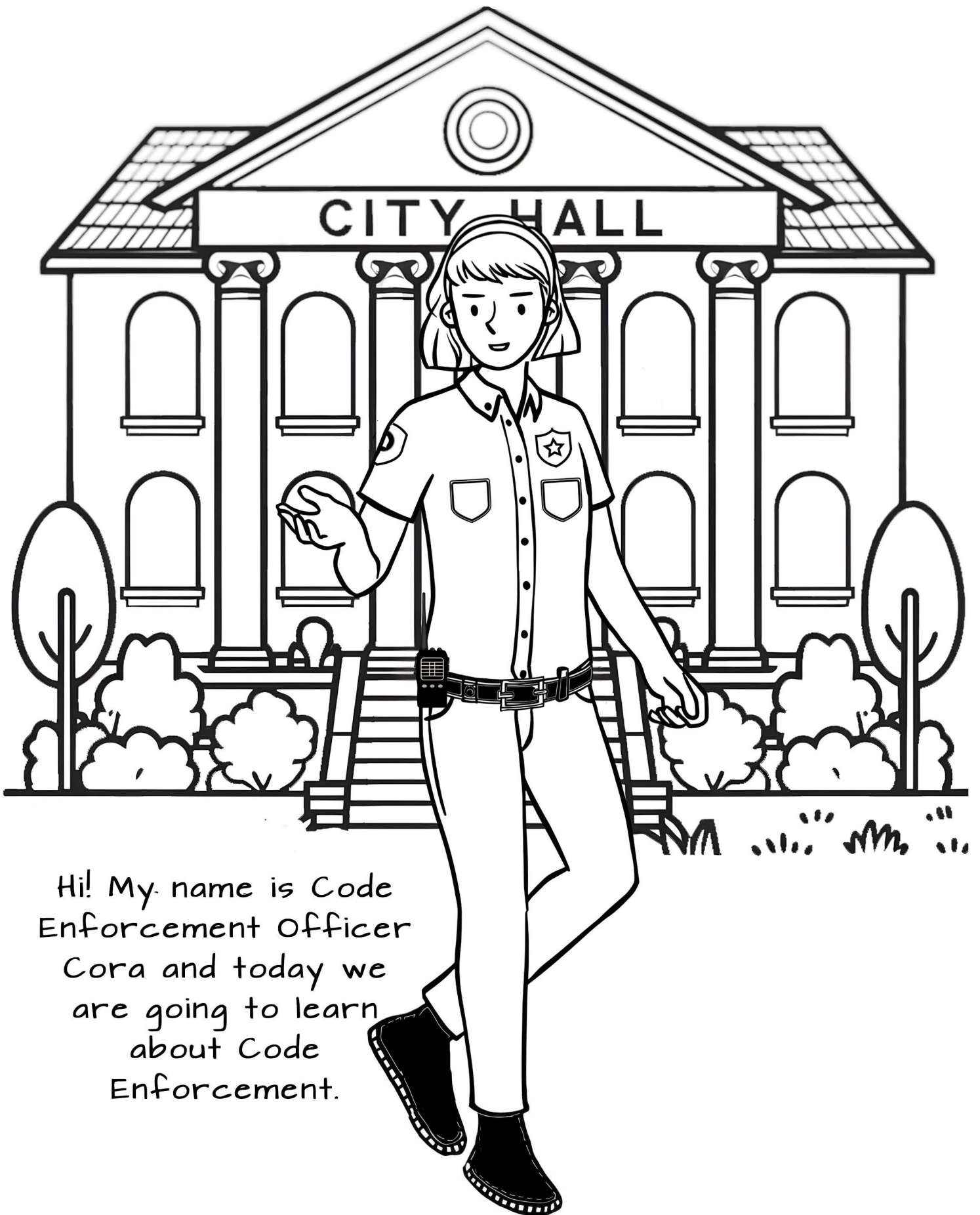

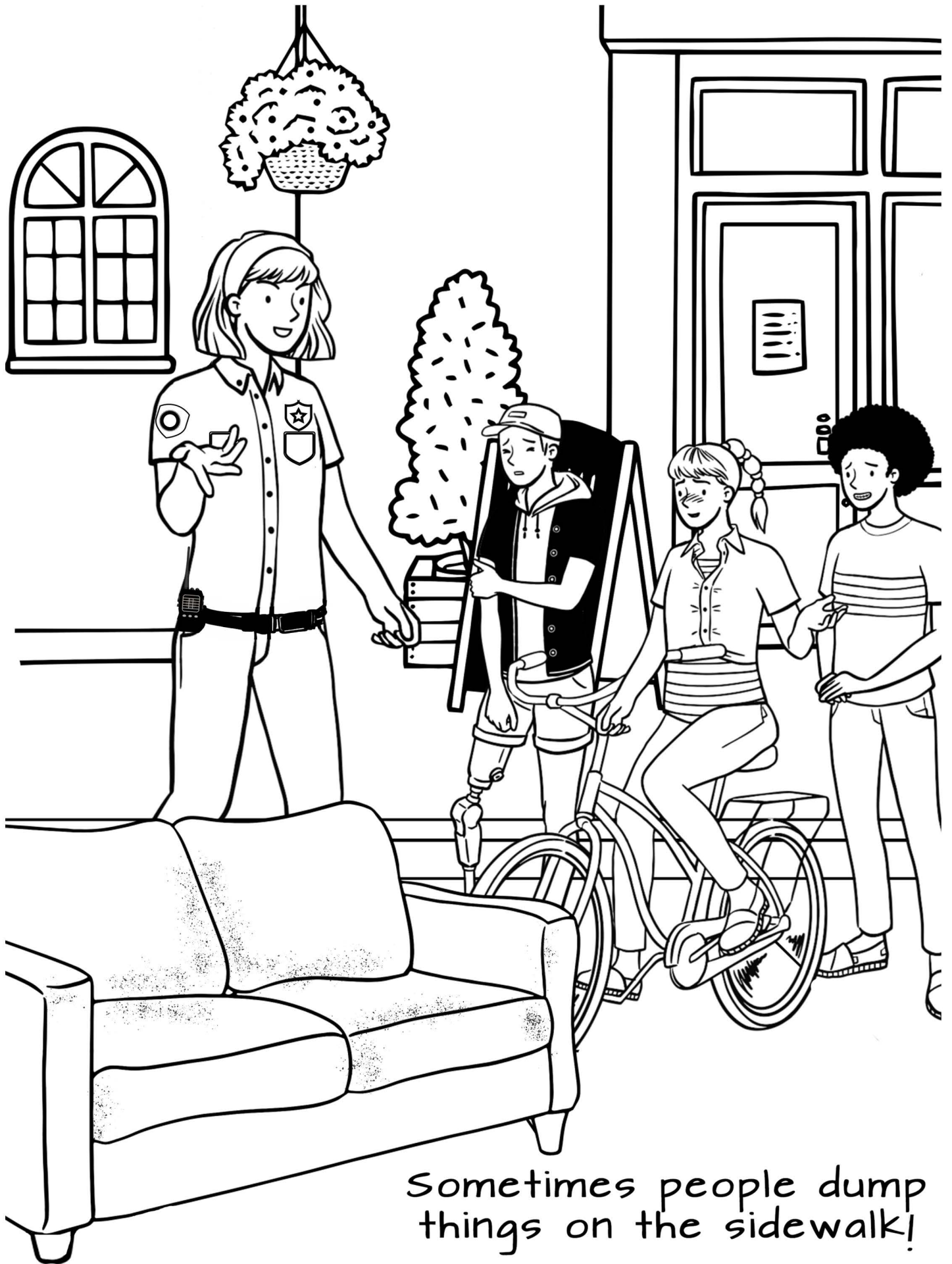

One of our jobs is to make sure people working in your home have permits. Permits allow the City to make sure work is done safely.

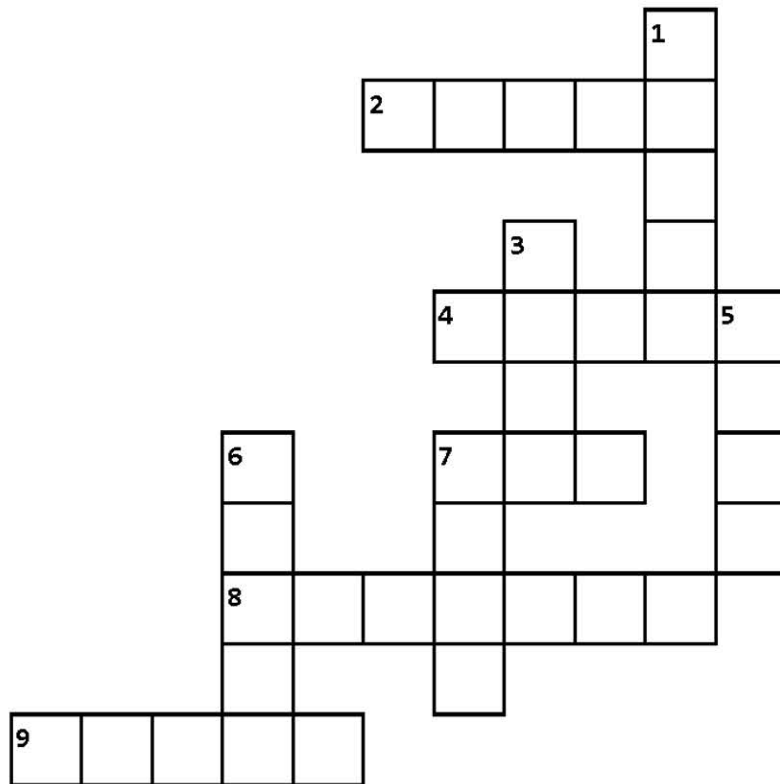


Sometimes a house may have way too many pets.

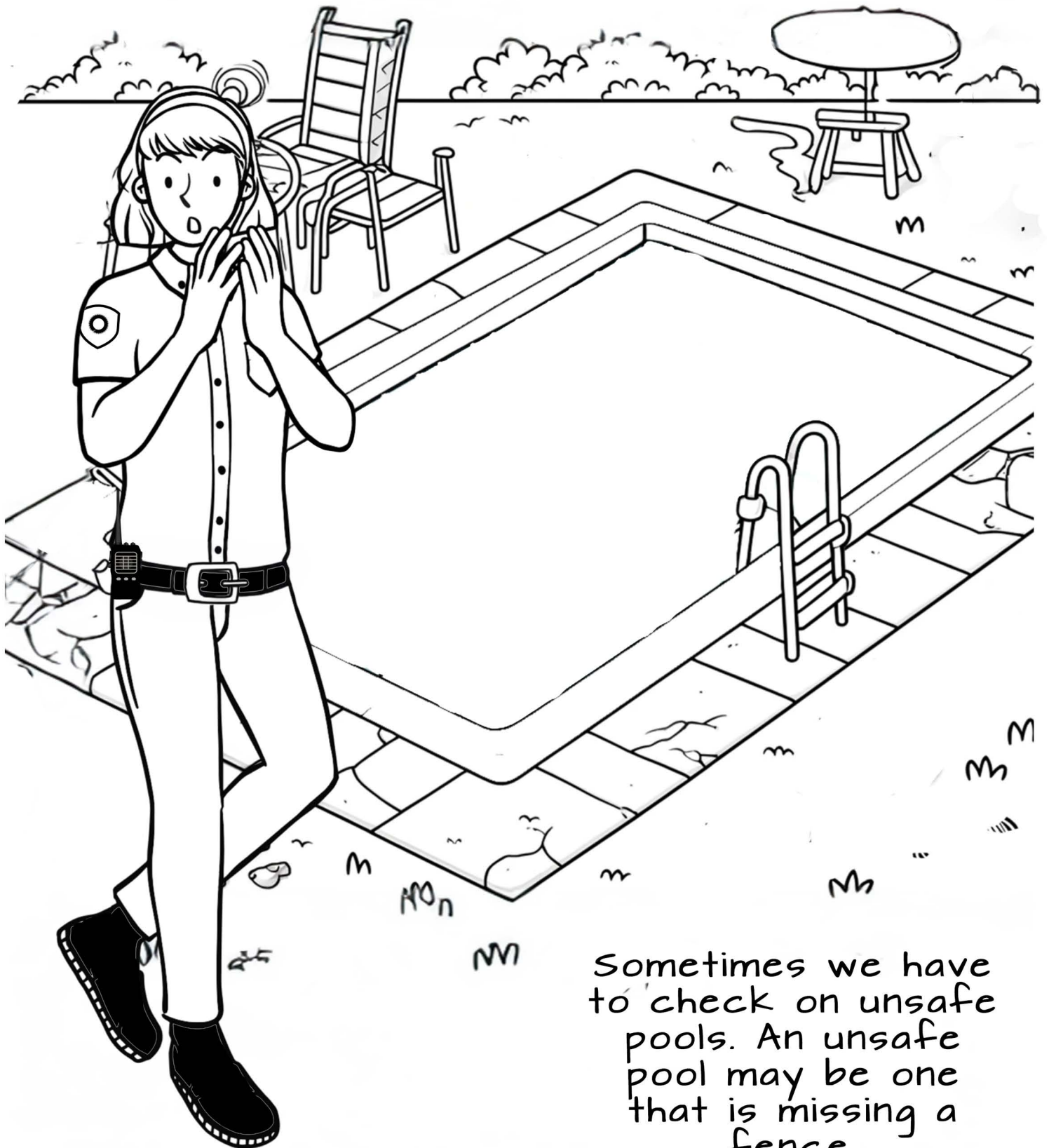

Sometimes we have to visit stores because someone painted graffiti on the wall.



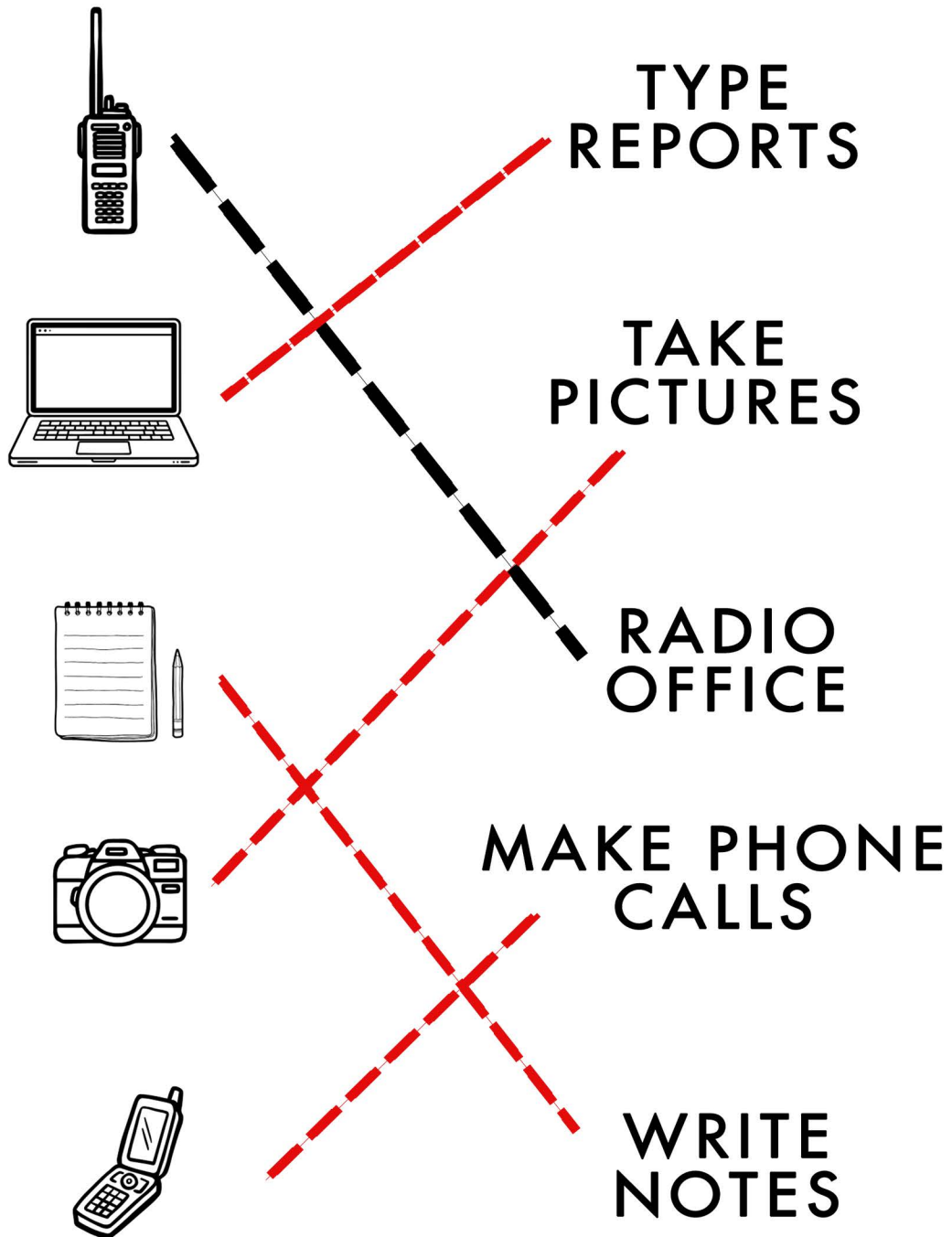
Sometimes we have to check on unsafe pools. An unsafe pool may be one that is missing a fence.
