Speed of Play Tips

In last week's GA News, we noted that the pace of golf at the club has slowed over recent months despite better weather and the removal of preferred lies.

With conditions improving, rounds should be getting quicker, along with the greens. Here are some short, clear speed of play tips:

- Be ready to play when it's your turn.
- Choose your club while walking to your ball.
- Play a provisional if there's any chance your ball is lost.
- Keep practice swings to a minimum. One or two at most.
- Move directly to your ball after playing a shot.
- Park your buggy on the side of the green closest to the next tee. Do no leave your buggy at the front of the green.
- Read your putt while others are putting.
- · Putt out when safe to do so.
- Leave the green quickly and mark your score at the next tee.

Entering the final round, they were tied at the top, with the final few questions becoming vital to the result. In the end, it was the Royal Rories who took out the win! (pictured below)




