Brazoria and Columbia Veterinary Clinics

There is a buzz of excitement and a bit of mystery around town lately. It's always exciting seeing a new business being built from the ground up. The Brazoria Veterinary Clinic will have a new home soon. Their new facility will offer 10,000 sq. ft. of hospital and treatment space for small animals.





"We're very excited. Our current building was built in 1975. You can imagine the challenges with our space.

The clinic was begun at the Stanger ranch in 1945. Dr. Dennis Huebner is the 3rd owner in the 80 year history of Brazoria Veterinary Clinic. We are proudly one of the oldest veterinary practices in the State of Texas," Linda Huebner said. To help with pet anxiety the new clinic will feature separate entrances for canines and felines along with separate waiting & treatment areas. The facility will have 11 exam rooms, 7 for dogs and 4 for cats. There will also be a specially designated "Comfort Room" which will be utilized for private family time with pets when dealing with end of life procedures or critical medical decisions. A private check out area is designed for handling payments and special help regarding monetary issues.

This facility will have a full time pharmacist to handle all prescriptions and questions regarding administering medications, along with a curbside pickup area designated for picking up prepaid medications.

There will be an emergency entrance for daytime and after hour emergencies that need urgent care.


Once construction is finished, they will proudly be one of the largest businesses in Brazoria as they move the small animal operations to the new space and continue to use the current barn facilities for large animals.




Brazoria Police Department




