

TEN (10) YEARS AFTER BEING AN ADDRESS DELIVERED BY

H.R.M. EZE (SIR) NELSON CHINYERE NWOSU KSC, FABS, FPPA, FNAH

ON THE OCCASION OF THE COMMEMORATION OF TEN (10) YEARS ON THE THRONE AS THE TRADITIONAL RULER AND IGBO OF AMAIGBO AT OBI EZE'S PALACE, AMAIGBO ON THE 28TH OF DECEMBER, 2024.

My dear people of Amaigbo, compliments of the season and I welcome you to this solemn occasion. You may kindly remember that at my coronation as the Igbo of Amaigbo in 2014, I wrote and presented a speech to the good, hardworking and blessed people of Amaigbo, which I titled "Amaigbo: In Search of Role Models". I distributed copies of the speech and encourage us all to go back home and read it all over.

As you have read it, juxtapose it with current happenings and realities in Amaigbo and decide if my prophetic utterances/declarations were right or wrong. While not playing the role of a "Judge" in this case, I can confidently, categorically, and unambiguously state that my prophecy was right. Amaigbo has progressed and grown in leaps and bounds in the last Ten (10) years and we give all glory to Almighty God for such a feat in our great land.

The manifestation of the prophecy I highlighted in that speech started with the invitation extended to me by Amaigbo Town Union (A.T.U) Lagos Branch under the Chairmanship of my resourceful and forward-thinking brother Mr. Chidi Anyiam to visit them to discuss my inaugural speech and strategies to implement the vision embedded in it.

I travelled to Lagos State and was accompanied by my UgoEze Dr.

(Mrs) Meg Nwosu, the then President General of A.T.U. Chief (Sir) Ken Eso, and Chief Laz Osuala. Members of A.T.U Lagos Branch are here present and can attest to the conclusion and recommendations agreed upon at that insightful summit.

Not long after, A.T.U (UK) under the purposeful leadership of Mr. Chinedu Osuji invited me and the A.T.U. National Executives to the United Kingdom to attend their summit to brainstorm on emerging issues in the same inaugural speech.

We went and had fruitful deliberations. The proceedings and recommendations from deliberations at that summit are available and can also be assessed in our archives.

In July 2015, A.T.U. (USA) under the able leadership of Mrs. Chinyere Udo-Okoro, invited me and my UgoEze to their convention which was held in Kansas City to discuss with Amaigbo people resident in the U.S.A. on the same inaugural speech.





Also in 2017, A.T.U. (USA) had their convention in California and extended an invitation to me and the then President General of A.T.U, Chief Laz Osuala to their convention to deliberate on strategies to develop Amaigbo and discover new role models. I appreciate Chief Laz Osuala for the strong commitment and support he gave to my message at the meeting.

After my coronation, I established the Eze-in-Council which meets on the 28th of December every year. The membership of this Council is drawn from prominent personalities from Amaigbo and some statutory members include: Igbo of Amaigbo who sits as the Chairman of the Council, two traditional Chiefs from the two Ibeahias, the President General of A.T.U (Men and Women's wing, former and serving), the Chairman of the Council of Chiefs, the Chairman of Nze-na-Ozo, Governor of Amaigbo Unity Forum, and other individuals invited by the Igbo of Amaigbo.

The Council is made up of several Sub-Committees, and one of the principal organs is the Sub-Committee on Peace and Conflict Resolution chaired by Nze George Ndupu at its inception, which handles land disputes, marriage disputes, divorce cases, Oparaship tussle, and other related traditional and Cultural matters. Nze Ndupu was succeeded by Barrister Innocent Etumnu, who currently serves as the Chairman of the peace and conflict resolution Sub-Committee. As a Council, we have recorded tremendous success over the past ten years. In addition, I have had the benefit of getting good advice from the Council, my contemporaries, and many senior citizens in Amaigbo.

My attendance at the aforementioned invitations and other meetings with critical stakeholders in the Amaigbo project led to the development of a new road map to discover the present role models and the quest for effective development of Amaigbo that we are celebrating today which has been piloted by the current President General of A.T.U., Sir. Fyne Madumere.

Over the past 10 years, I have worked closely and harmoniously with three Presidents - General of A.T.U namely Chief Engr. (Sir) Ken Eso, Chief Laz Osuala, and now Sir. Fyne Madumere. The Presidents-General and 2 other members of the Executives of the A.T.U. over the past 10 years have been cooperative and supportive.

Chief (Engr) Ken Eso, the then President-General of A.T.U. when I was elected Eze, led me and Amaigbo to meet His Excellency, Anayo Rochas Okoroacha, the former Governor of Imo State to decisively and thoroughly deal with some issues confronting my emergence and subsequent accession to the throne. Sir Ken Eso, your articulate and knowledge-based strategy is second to none. You are a trustworthy ally and a worthy leader. May history be kind to you and your family.

Chief Laz Osuala succeeded Chief Ken Eso, and during his time, Amaigbo faced many issues including a group of agitators in Umuchoke led by some dissidents who wanted to secede from Amaigbo and become autonomous. Chief Laz led his executives, and they rose to the challenge.





We made our submission against this move to the Imo State government and later, to the Imo State House of Assembly, which dismissed the agitation. Chief Laz, of a truth, you are "Ihejimaradike" of our time. You are bold and fearless. With men like you, Amaigbo does not fear any challenge.

The emergence of Sir. Fyne Madumere as President General of A.T.U. gave a big boost to my vision and dreams as outlined in my inaugural speech. He has utilised social media, personal goodwill, intelligent disposition to issues, and doggedness to lead A.T.U. He has been and is still at the forefront of our search for new role models for Amaigbo in all parts of the world. Under his leadership, A.T.U. is now a Union without borders. Sir. Fyne, you have shown capacity, honesty, finesse, and dexterity which are the hallmarks of great men. You are a strong pillar and a mover of mountains.

In the same regard, I commend and acknowledge all other past Presidents – General and executives of the A.T.U. who served Amaigbo from the beginning of time. You all played your role, sacrificed your all, and laid the foundation on which those who are serving and will serve can only build upon and expand the frontiers.

The history of Amaigbo is will not be complete without you all and your efforts. My Presidents-General (serving and emeritus), I appreciate all your sacrifices and commitment.

In the last Ten (10) years, Amaigbo as a Town has grown. Role models and new role models are emerging within Amaigbo, A.T.U. Branches in Nigeria, and the diaspora.

Some of such role models include

- Mr. Uche Anyiam (Chairman A.T.U. Lagos Branch);
- Chief Onyekachi Ihekwuazu (Former Chairman ATU Abuja);
- Mr. Kenneth Dike; and so many others too numerous to mention who are showing exemplary leadership at various levels and contributing to the overall development of Amaigbo.

The various A.T.U. branches within and outside Nigeria have been searching Amaigbo and the Diaspora to discover real role models (Sons and Daughters) who have the Amaigbo spirit in them and who are ready to be part of the united and shared vision for Amaigbo.





The results of the activities of these new role models under the guidance of the innovative and result-oriented Sir. Fyne Madumere, President General of A.T.U. are abundant in every corner of Amaigbo.

Such results can be seen in the construction of

- the Obi-Igbo ultra-modern complex,
- the construction of the magnificent entrance gate at Umuanya,
 - the renovation of several healthcare centres, interventions at Joint Hospital,
 - development of the Eke-Ukwu market,
 - renovations at Dick Tiger Memorial College and King Jaja School,
 - the upgrading of the School of Nursing to College of Nursing (Affiliated to Abia State University),
 - the upgrading of the School of Health Sciences to a Degree awarding institution,
 - construction of drainages across several villages,
 - remodelling of the Obi-Eze at the Palace,
 - the numerous Medical Missions,
- scholarship programmes, and other Human Capacity Development initiatives by various Sons and Daughters of Amaigbo, support and coordination of Amaigbo security watch and other security infrastructure, etc.

Such noble projects will accelerate the development of Amaigbo and help it regain its place of pride.

On this note, I say a big Kudos to Amaigbo security watch and Amaigbo youths for keeping Amaigbo safe. As we all know, without security, such developments will not take place.

I must commend the activities of the following organisations/groups which have keyed in and served our agreed purpose.

We thank the Churches and various revival missions in Amaigbo for continually praying for us.

I must add that Amaigbo women occupy a big position in my heart and administration. Our mothers, wives, sisters and daughters have made us proud. They have shown selfless service, love, and support to their husbands, sons, and our great town. Such women groups include

- A.T.U. (women's wing),
- ADAUSA (U.K and USA),
- Adaigbo group,
- Amaigbo Global women, etc.

Their commitment to Amaigbo led to the creation of titles such as Adaigbo, Ugosimba, UgoEzinulo, etc.





In the same vein, I encourage the youths of Amaigbo to brace up, develop, and equip themselves with the necessary tools and skills to prepare them for the future. Our youths are the future of this town. They will form a critical part of the upcoming role models on whose shoulders Amaigbo will go further.

Over the past years, I have seen young men and women who are vibrant, articulate, and strategic. I have seen across Amaigbo a young generation educating themselves across different fields of endeavour. The youths should shun negative tendencies and vices. It will be a shame if the current approach and strategy to close the generational gap fails.

The world we live in is evolving and new norms are emerging. Amaigbo should not be left out; our children and youths should know that the Royal Palace is open to constructive suggestions and critical thinking from them.

Umu Amaigbo, these achievements recorded also pose so many challenges for us. Such challenges include sustaining and maintaining the current infrastructure; developing new infrastructure for future generations; and most importantly, growing new role models to bridge the generational gap.

I believe that these challenges can be surmounted. Amaigbo as a town must avoid unnecessary distractions and those who try to cause disunity. Amaigbo must stand united in purpose. Amaigbo sons and daughters still watching from afar, I encourage you all to come closer and join hands to take Amaigbo to greater heights.

Politically, Amaigbo has come of age and recorded tremendous progress in recent times. Since the creation of Imo State nearly Fifty (50) years ago, Amaigbo has produced about Five (5) Commissioners.

In this regard, we thank and appreciate the Executive Governor of Imo State, His Excellency (Senator) Hope Uzodinma for appointing Four (4) Amaigbo sons as Commissioners in the Five (5) years of his administration.

This is in addition to other Amaigbo's sons and daughters being appointed as Special Assistants/Advisers. The Governor through such appointments has shown that he loves, honours, and recognises Amaigbo. As a town, we wish the Governor a successful tenure in good health and great accomplishments.

Also, our appreciation goes to the Federal Government of Nigeria for appointing one of our great sons Dr. Chikwe Ihekweazu as the Pioneer Director–General of the Nigeria Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), and currently the Assistant Director–General at the World Health Organisation (WHO).

We also thank the Federal Government for appointing Honourable Amaechi Nwoha as a National Commissioner at the National Assembly Service Commission.

Both mentioned are in addition to other appointments that were not mentioned. I am glad our sons and daughters occupying various appointive and elective seats are making us proud.





The numerous successes achieved in the last ten years have brought me so much joy. It has shown and proven that as a people, if we come together to actualise a vision, we all can achieve it to the glory of Almighty God. As our faces are different, so are our opinions and approaches to various issues. Despite these inherent differences, I encourage us all to remain united, live peacefully with ourselves and our neighbours, and be good ambassadors of Amaigbo.

Amaigbo sons and daughters worldwide have shown love, respect, loyalty, commitment, and dedication to the Monarchy, and Amaigbo in general. I acknowledge the selfless, voluntary, and generous donations and contributions to several projects and developmental initiatives in Amaigbo.

As I have always said, I operate an opendoor policy, so feel free to come around or call me. Once again, I appreciate you all for your trust in me and my shared vision for Amaigbo. I promise to do my best in good conscience to lead Amaigbo as her Traditional Ruler and Igbo of Amaigbo.

During these past 10 years, I owe tremendous appreciation to my darling wife, UgoEze Dr. (Mrs.) Meg Nwosu. She has been my strongest pillar, and a co-initiator of the successes recorded, and this should not go unnoticed.



AMAIGBO TOWN UNION UK (ATU UK) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME - A VISION OF IMPACT AND EMPOWERMENT

The Amaigbo Town Union UK (ATU UK) Scholarship Programme was born out of a shared vision by the ATU UK to uplift young people from our community by supporting their academic dreams and building future leaders.

Approved by the General Assembly and inaugurated on 15th May 2024, the ATU UK Scholarship Board was established to design a fair, transparent, meaningful and sustainable scholarship scheme. The goal is to support at least six new scholars each year with the sum of \\$500,000 annually, in addition to existing recipients, so that by the scheme's fifth year, ATU UK will be sponsoring a minimum of thirty scholars on an annual rolling basis, amounting to \\$15,000,000 per year.

At the heart of the programme lies our collective belief in human empowerment. Prior to the establishment of the ATU UK Scholarship Programme, ATU UK had already built a strong track record of supporting youth education and empowerment in Amaigbo. From paying for West African Examinations Council (WAEC) and National Examinations Council (NECO) examination application fees for over 50 Amaigbo students in our key secondary schools, King Jaja High School and Dick Tiger Memorial Secondary School respectively, to renovating classrooms in both schools, to name a few.

Our members had also been adding their individual support to our collective effort by supporting the recruitment and remuneration of teaching staff in our key schools, thereby ensuring the continued provision of quality education to our young people in Amaigbo.

Therefore, applying ourselves to the establishment of an empowering scholarship programme, although the first of such programmes by any community group in Amaigbo, was not a novel endeavour for ATU UK.

The scholarship is funded through a levy on all ATU UK members and generous voluntary donations. These contributions directly enable our young people to access higher education, reduce hardship and achieve long-term self-reliance.

Applications for the 2024/25 scholarship opened on 15th July 2024 and attracted over 80 applications. After rigorous sifting and financial hardship assessments, 10 candidates were invited to final interviews held on 30th November 2024.

The Scholarship Board ensured candidates were assessed transparently against key criteria – academic excellence, leadership, extracurricular involvement and community impact – free from discrimination, be it gender or otherwise.

Six outstanding students were awarded full scholarships of \\$500,000 each for the 2024/25 academic year (renewable annually):

Additionally, four runner-up candidates (Echefu, Amarachi Peace; Iheanacho, Solomon; Nwamba, Mmesoma Peace; and Enwerem, Chukwunonso Eric) each received a one-off \\$500,000 grant to recognise their merit and need.

Heartfelt messages of gratitude from recipients have touched the ATU UK community and reaffirmed our mission. Their stories of hope and determination have inspired ATU UK to expand the programme and do even more in the years ahead.

Applications for the 2025/26 ATU UK Scholarship Programme officially opened on 5th August 2025. We strongly encourage eligible candidates to apply and all ATU UK members and well-wishers to continue sponsoring this life-changing initiative. Our ability to continue delivering and expanding this critical initiative depends on your generous contributions and donations.

Let us continue to be the Human Empowerment Leaders and Pacesetters (HELPers) that our community needs and deserves.



Once again, thank you all for coming.


