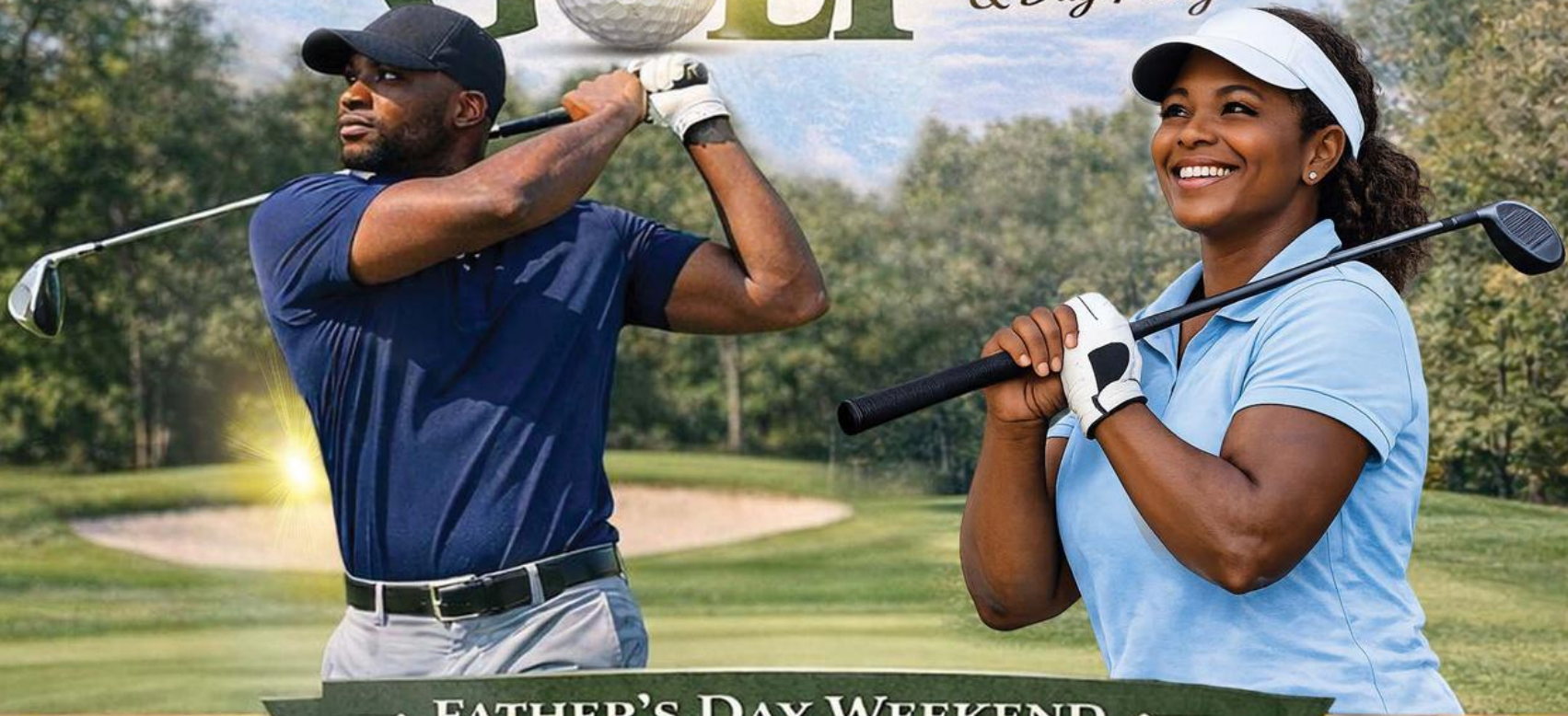

On May 10, 1930, on the campus of Howard University, in Washington DC, the National Pan-Hellenic Council [NPHC] was formed as a permanent organization. The stated purpose and mission of the organization in 1930 was "Unanimity of thought and action as far as possible in the conduct of Greek letter collegiate fraternities and sororities, and to consider problems of mutual interest to its member organizations." The Council is a collaborative umbrella composed of the nine historically African American Fraternities and Sororities also known as the Divine Nine [D9]. NPHC promotes interaction through forums, meetings, and other mediums for the exchange of information; while also, engaging in cooperative programming and initiatives through various activities and functions.

The NPHC of Southeastern Pennsylvania (NPHC-SEPA) prides itself on furthering the mission set forth by our original founding members. NPHC-SEPA represents Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia counties. With over 4000 members spread across 35 historically Black Sorority and Fraternity Chapters, we strive to make a meaningful, long-term, and strategic impact on the communities that we serve through education, community service, programming, and social action.

With our 17 Council Committees we host community programs and events that have strong emphasis on Social Action, Economics, Health, & Education. In the past year, we supported 24 local brands and partnered with 25 different Corporations, Organizations, & Elected Officials.

This inaugural golf tournament will be the foundation for all our future tournaments to serve as an integral support system for the scholastic endeavors for aspiring students in our region.
