r. Abhishek Dasore is in Top 2% of scientists in the field of Mechanical Engineering and Transport for the year 2024. This recognition has been conferred by Stanford University in collaboration with Elsevier, based on a comprehensive analysis of citation metrics and scholarly contributions.

The data for this recognition is derived from the Elsevier Data Repository (August 2024 data update for "Updated Science-Wide Author Databases of Standardized Citation Indicators"), published on 16 September 2024 (Version 7, DOI: 10.17632/btchxktzyw.7). The selection criteria are based on the c-score, which focuses on the impact of scientific work through citation counts, co-authorship adjustments, and author position contributions. Scientists ranked within the top 2% of their respective fields are recognized in this database.

The dataset encompasses citation metrics for both career-long contributions and citations received during

the calendar year 2023. It includes detailed metrics such as the h-index, co-authorship adjusted hm-index, and the ratio of citations to citing papers. Data on retracted papers and citations to/from retracted papers have also been incorporated in this update.




7 August - National Handloom Day




