Project profile 042

Voznesensk Community Foundation, Mykolaiv oblast, project "Voznesensk Community Adult Education Center"

The project was aimed to create employment opportunities of IDPs residing in Voznesensk. In order to approach the problem systemically, the Adult Education Center was created and 3-months educational program for sewing was created - as there are 2 big sewing enterprises in Voznesensk. As a result of the project 5 educational programs were developed: sewing, photography, SMM, baking and barista. 46 masterclasses were conducted. Over 2000 people were informed about educational opportunities. AEC received 76 applications to participate in sewing training, 2 groups of 8 people were formed, 50-hour course was completed. 5 people were employed, 3 decided to start their own small businesses.

Project profile 043

CF Unity of Community - Wealthy Village, Kyiv oblast, villages Vita-Poshtova and Yuriivka, project "Bomb shelter for the community"

The project was aimed at providing safe access of community members to the underground bomb shelter, especially elderly people, children and people with disabilities.

Due to the project implementation the entrance and the staircase to the shelter were installed, the waterproofing of the foundation of the building was implemented, new powerlines installed and the heating of the premises was provided. This allowed to increase shelter capacity to host over 100 people at the same time as well as use it as a safe community center in other times.

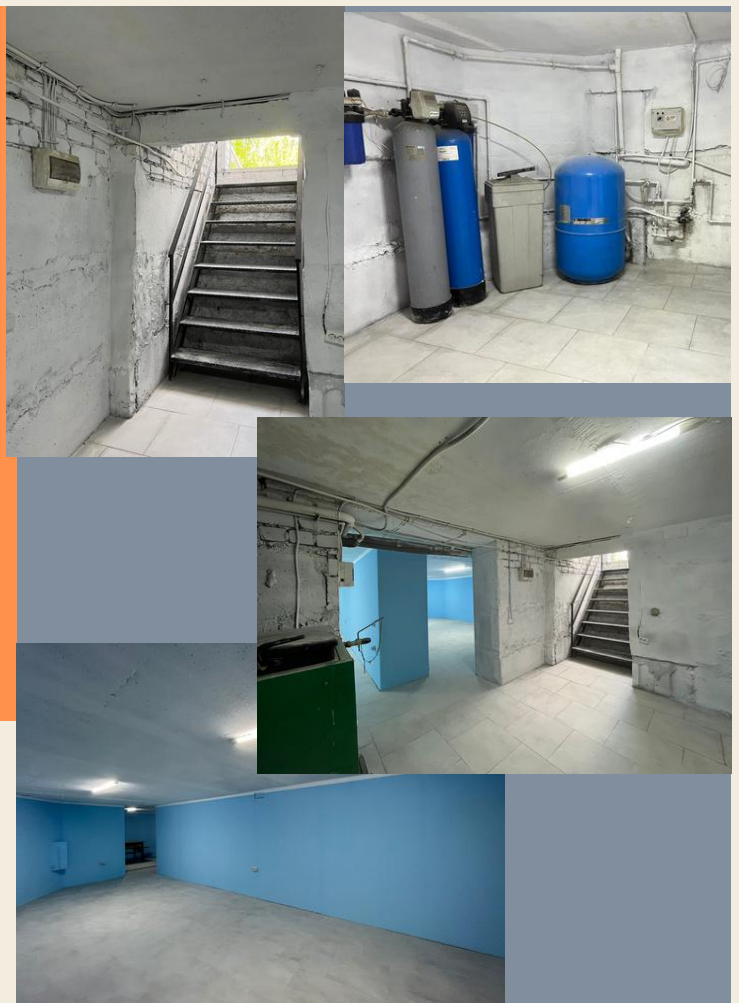

Project profile 044

Foundation of Snovs'k Community Development, Chernihiv oblast, project "Overcoming Consequences of War in Snovs'k Community"

In February 2022 Snovs'k community was occupied by russians and later liberated by Armed Forces of Ukraine.

The project was aimed improving the quality of life of community members by means of providing business education and equipment. In addition to that the training program was developed, training space was equipped, and 2 pieces of big equipment were purchased - a press and a dehydrator for fruit and vegetables.

In the course of the project 16 community members received beginner-level business-education.

Project profile 045

Boyarka Community Foundation, Kyiv oblast, project "Healthy Children's Smiles"

The project was aimed to increase the number of free-of-charge dentists services received by children from vulnerable groups - IDPs, families having many children, one-parent families, etc. - by 15%.

As a result of the project implementation additional dentists' workplace was equipped in Kyiv Oblast Children's Hospital. This allowed increasing the the number of services provided by over 30%. 166 kids from low-income families received free-of-charge services in July 2024.

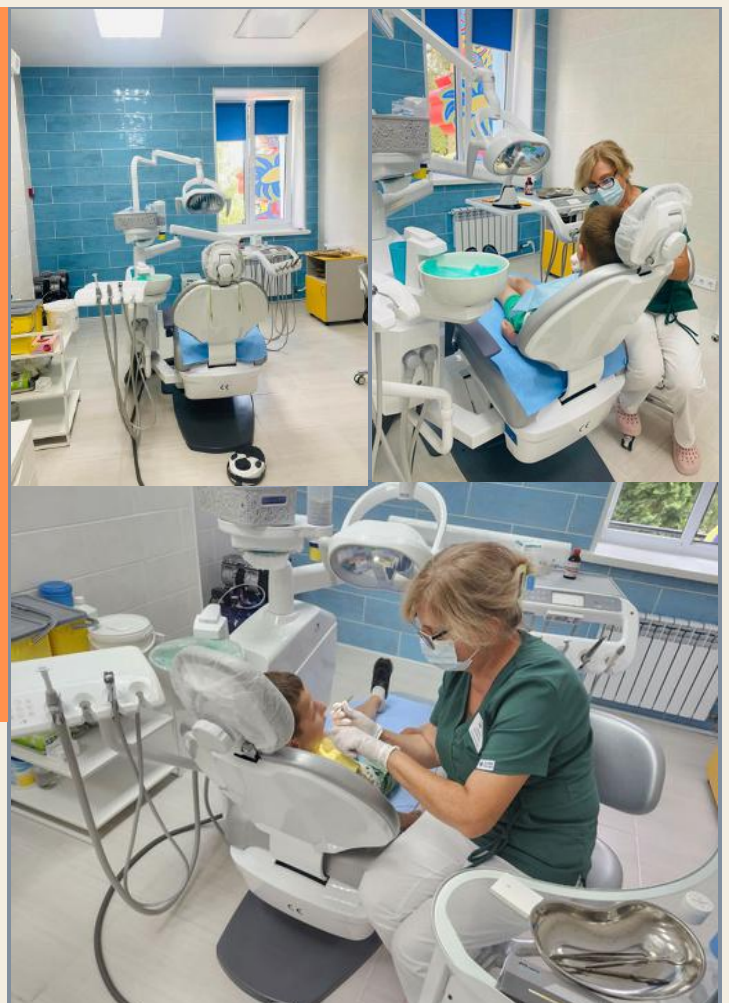

Project profile 046

Community Foundation “Ridnya”, Stryi, Lviv oblast, project "Strengthening capacities of community members to increase the output of local agro-produce"

The project was aimed at creation of local small-farmers' groups of activity in rural communities of Lviv oblast, equip them with tractor equipment (1 mini-tractor and 4 attachments: plow, disc harrow, cultivator, potato digger) for collective utilization, and thus strengthen the food security in the region by means of increasing local produce output.

As a result of the project implementation the equipment was purchased and community members have access to mechanical land cultivation. 1100 people were informed about the project, 307 people used the services at reduced price.

Project profile 047

Berezan Community Foundation, Kyiv oblast, project "The Power of Small Steps"

The part of Kyiv oblast was occupied in 2022 for several months, including Baryshiv district that neighbours with Berezan district. The occupation greatly influenced the psycho-emotional state of residents, especially youth and children. Due to the project implementation it was possible to carry out initiatives that improved mental and physical health of youth and children.

The project by Community Foundation of Berezan allowed implementing 10 projects in various schools and liceums of Berezan and Baryshivka territorial communities. These activities included: installing sports and workout grounds, reconstruction of gyms and locker rooms, conducting master-classes and equipping schools with materials for workshops, refurbishing youth spaces for study circles and events, conducting eco-events (youth clean-up days in communities and recyclable waste collection).

Vinnytsya Community Foundation “Podilska Hromada”, Vinnytsya oblast, project "The Power of Communication"

The project was aimed improving the quality of life of people who suffered from war by means of strengthening capacities of Vinnytsya Regional Clinical Medical Rehabilitation Center and Vinnytsya Regional Medical Center of Rehabilitation of Children.

In the course of project Implementation 2 rehabilitation centers were strengthened by developing strategies, brandbooks and navigation materials as well as by training their staff on crisis communications, effective communications and grant-writing.

Vinnytsya Community Foundation “Podilska Hromada”, Vinnytsya oblast, project "Brave to Know"

The project was aimed at formation of the culture of cancer preventive medical check-ups amongst Vinnytsya community members by conducting wide informational campaign.

Project activities included 2 meetings with GPs, 2 meetings with specialized doctors and 1 excursion to the Regional Oncological Center for community members. 140 people participated in these activities. In close cooperation with the Oncological center, the leaflets, posters, stickers and city-lights were designed. 2 videos (10- and 20-second) were shot and displayed at public screens, local TV channels and in social networks. CF “Podilska Hromada” reached out to 11 625 people via its social networks. At least 25000 people were reached by informational campaign.

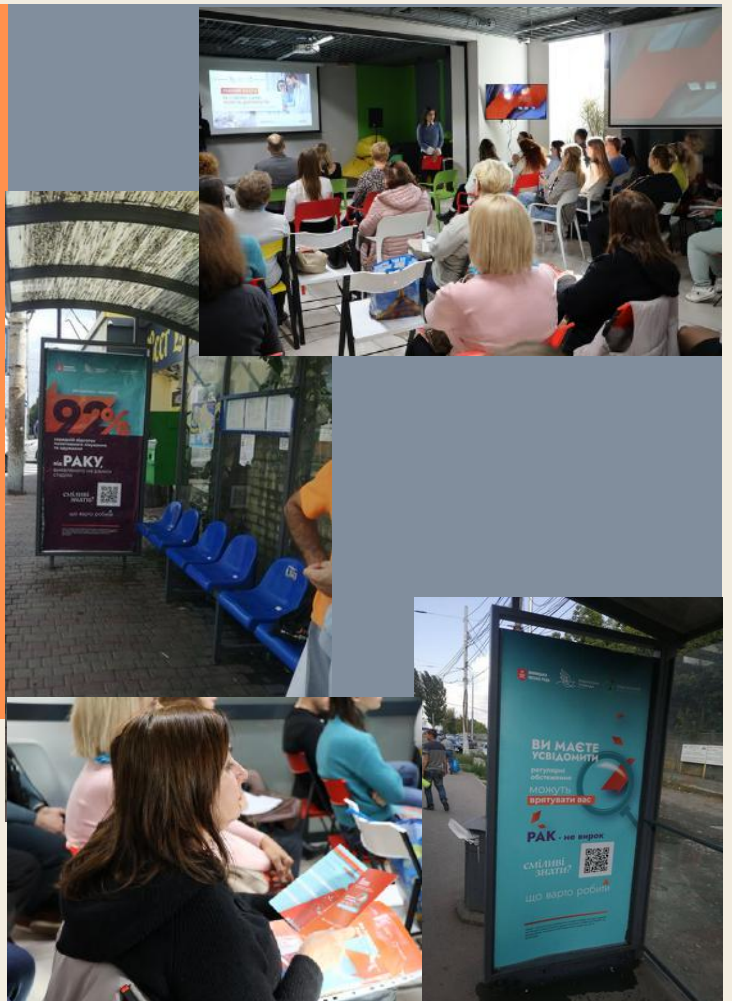

Kharkiv Community Foundation “Toloka”, Kharkiv oblast, project "Improving conditions in polyfunctional children’s spaces of Kharkiv and oblast"

The project was aimed at creating spaces for communication and joint action of inhabitants of Berezan and Baryshivka communities of Kyiv oblast.

4 communities received 4 refurbished and equipped children’s spaces for cultural leisure and events. The underground premise in Kharkiv is used for groups of psycho-emotional support, children’s symphonic orchestra recitals and events; the space in Paniutine village is used for cultural events, the open-air cinema is operating; the space in Mala Rogan village is used for dance and arts-n-crafts classes; the space In Elitne village is used for cultural events.

Vinnytsya Community Foundation “Podilska Hromada”, Vinnytsya oblast, project "Your Children's Space"

The project was aimed at creating comfortable spaces including inclusive needs for children and their parents in two hospitals of Vinnytsya.

2 Vinnytsya children's hospitals received 180 items to equip children's leisure and play rooms in medical departments of long-term stay in order to improve psycho-emotional state of children undergoing treatment.

Over 7000 little patients will be able to recover after treatment In both these rooms in one year.

TARGETED FUNDING

Kharkiv Community Foundation “Toloka”, Kharkiv oblast, project "Creation and equipping of spaces for psychological relaxation and sensory Integration of children

The project was aimed at creating and equipping 2 spaces for psychological relaxation, sensory integration and rehabilitation in two children’s hospitals of Kharkiv and oblast.

In order to equip two spaces, 15 items of rehabilitation equipment was purchased, 45 m2 of soft flooring was laid, completed the reconstruction of the premises for equipping the room for leisure and play for children with oncological diseases. 6800 little patients will be able to utilize the spaces and equipment In one year.

TARGETED FUNDING

Berezan Community Foundation, Kyiv oblast, project "Playrooms for physical and intellectual leisure of small patients"

The project was aimed at creating two playrooms for physical and intellectual leisure where children can have some rest after their treatments and communicate to each other.

2 play rooms were refurbished and equipped in the Center "Children's Hospital" of Brovary town. The approximate number of children who can use these rooms in a year is 2500. Approx. 6% of little patients are representatives of vulnerable groups - IDPs, children with disabilities, children without parental care, orphans, children from families with many children, etc.

Berezan Community Foundation, Kyiv oblast, project "Civic Initiatives: Improvement for common well-being"

The project was aimed at implementation of socially-important initiatives that improve mental and physical health in communities of Kyiv oblast.

6 socially-important Initiatives were Implemented In 3 territorial communities of Kyiv region - Berezan, Baryshivka and Studenyky. As a result of the project the stadium in Korzhy village was equipped, women's space in Morozivka village was refurbished and equipped, Semenivska medical outpatient clinic was provided with necessary goods, cuttlery for Baryshivka Lyceum #3 was purchased, coffee machine was purchased for the youth space In Berezan Professional Lyceum, and various supplies for arts-n-cratfs actiities of Berezan Women's Club Malva were purchased.
