



Spartanburg has seven school districts locally administered and independent of each other. District lines generally relate to city boundaries but they are not exclusive to them.



Relocation to Spartanburg Buyer's Tips



Research your options

If you already have found a job then you probably want to use the location of your future employer to decide where to live. If you plan on finding a job when you arrive then you will at least want to research places to see what area you are most likely to find employment with your qualifications. Other things to consider when finding a neighborhood are your current financial situation and estimating how much you can afford in a home.

You should also ask yourself: What is

your time frame for moving? Why are you buying a home? Are you ready? Answering these questions will help you define your goals and will make your research easier. Once you have a definite idea of what kind of home you are looking for and the price range of the home you can afford, then you're ready to move forward. You can start searching for housing and also finding out what financing options are available for you.

Hire a buyer's agent

Buying a home in an unfamiliar area carries risks and it can be overwhelming. That's why it's important to work with a real estate agent. You don't want to make a mistake buying a home in the wrong neighborhood.

Find a buyer's agent who can represent

you in the home buying process and someone who has experience working with relocating buyers.



It is important that you already know how much money you can spend on a home. If you can attach a prequalification letter with your offer to

purchase a property, a seller will take your offer more seriously because it means that a lender has determined that you are a suitable candidate for a mortgage.

Finding the right home

When searching for your home, having a list all the things you want and need in your home is important. Note the musthaves, the deal-breakers, and your wishlist to help you target your search. This will save you a lot of time especially if you have a limited time to visit and check the area.

There are a lot of real estate websites where you can view many homes and their details, see video tours, and access neighborhood information. One great example of this is

GreaterGreenvilleAreaHomes.com. Once you have found homes that meet your real estate needs, you can arrange with your buyer agent to view them in person.

Secure financing

Once your offer has been approved and both sides have signed a purchase contract, it is time to begin the process to secure your mortgage. You will need to meet with your lender within the time frame noted on your purchase contract to formally apply for your loan. Your loan approval will be based on the information you provided to your lender during your initial application, so you should try to keep your financial life as stable as possible during the process – any changes to that information could very easily affect your loan approval.

Closing

This is the last step in buying and financing a home. You can check with your buyer's agent about the details of your closing. He or she will be able to keep track of the transaction and communicate with your lender or title company to make sure everything is moving along in a timely manner. The final walk-through is typically scheduled within the week leading up to the closing date. Your final walkthrough is to ensure that any repairs have been completed if stated in your contract and that the home is ready to move into.

Moving

Moving out from your previous home also needs planning. As soon as you know a moving date, get price estimates and a list of services. Weeks before your moving date, you can start packing if you're doing the work yourself. If movers will do the packing, ask the moving company for advice on the best ways to prepare.
