We continue to identify and fund needed programs and work to increase community and corporate involvement in support of our schools. Foundation programs, like Grants to Educators, are supported by SKI Plano and other annual fundraisers. Our CORE Store provides teachers with free donated supplies. In 2021-2022 the Foundation partnered with 40+ businesses and organizations in the North Texas region to benefit students and academic programs.


