


During the summer we visit lovely gardens but in the colder months we meet indoors at The Crown and enjoy talks and light hearted competitions! Membership is only £10 a year.





I'm honoured to be the Great Ellingham Village Pump 'Miss May', although after the winter we've had and COVID rules, no friends popping in to help, I'm more 'Mrs May just have a sit down.' I'm flattered to have been asked, even though I know it's not me you want to know about, nor my very tolerant husband Andy. It's our alpacas and the rest of the menagerie. We have here 7 alpacas. 2 ponies (Midnight and Reggie), 4 pygmy goats, 3 cats, several chickens and our perfect 10 dogs, although I might be a bit biased.

First let me introduce you to the 'paca girls. There are two breeds of alpacas, suri's and huacayas. I have two suri's, dark brown Faith and her cria (baby) Mía. Faith is our oldest girl, she's 12 and very friendly. Mía was born last summer and

the most adorable alpaca ever, always smiling. The lightest fawn one is Amber, she comes to call and loves a fuss, which is guite rare for an alpaca. She had a cria last year which sadly we had to re-home as girls and boys can't live together. We hadn't counted on her missing him as much as she did so we're going to let her have a special cuddle with her boyfriend Sterling from Hillyridge Alpacas in Suffolk soon. Fingers crossed she has a girl next time. The darker fawn is Phoebe, she's quite nervous although very sweet and the three white ones are Juno, her daughter Coco and our newest addition, the lovely Genevieve. Genevieve was sold to us as she'd had a very hard time giving birth last summer. She has come to us as a non breeding pet home. If you see any of the alpacas hanging out with the dogs

when you go past, it's probably her. They've all just had their annual shearing, for their own comfort. I have bags here of fleece if anyone has got use of some for felting and I'd love to find someone with a spinning wheel. Foot trimming has to be done more regularly and can be quite a battle with some of them. Amber is the best, she just stands there. Genevieve breaks into Lord of the Dance.

We also have ten dogs who can be seen every morning playing in the field with the alpacas. We have 2 sheepadoodles (old English sheepdog x standard poodle) Jeff and Ruby. 2 St Berdoodles (St bernard x standard poodle) Barbara and Margo (The Good Life). 3 labradoodles Yogi, Meri and Wilma. And 3 standard poodles, Freddie, Skyla and Bonnie.


