

Thanks to you students in Canisius College's IMC Masterclass, and their professor (and FIOH-USA board member), Mary Owusu, our Giving Tuesday campaign was tremendous success. The eight students, majoring in Marketing, Digital Media Arts, and Integrated Marketing Communication (IMC), developed a stellar campaign including social media marketing, email marketing and digital awareness for Giving Tuesday, resulting in more than \$2,500 raised. A generous donor contributed two matching gifts which tripled the money collected to \$7,500. We are continuing to work with Mary's students, and are so grateful for their contributions to FIOH-USA. The IMC Masterclass is one of a kind in the USA, where students work experience what it's like to work in a marketing agency to develop and launch meaningful advance campaigns that organizations like FIOH-USA.

Student letter

"Now I am at my third year, semester one. I didn't get a chance to go back to school during November to do my practical exams because I could not get the transport and rent. Mom couldn't afford it by then. So I managed and applied for a special exam which I will do in April 2023. It will be exhausting since I will have other exams by then, but I promise you I will do my best and make you proud."

FIOH-Zambia Emerges From The Pandemic

Maureen Hamianze reports that the goat project is flourishing now that the goats have been moved to Chomo where the office and store are also located. The FIOH-Zambia Board of Directors will be meeting with the Youth Group to officially re-establish the Goat Project in which selected youth will be taught to care for the goats. As the herd expands the goats will be used by the community for milk and meat. The herd currently has 22 goats and 7 kids.

Monies set aside for the Bean Project because of the pandemic have been used for microloans to five women for their small businesses and market stalls. The repaid loan monies will be used to purchase beans in the north of Zambia and sell them in the south if travel and market demands make the Bean Project viable.



The business center reopened after Christmas and is doing well. The building that houses the business center and the FIOH-Zambia office has been re-furbished.

Agri-Vet Project an Overwhelming Success

The villagers in Gosese, Kenya had a better than expected harvest from the project supported by FIOH-USA donors for the last growing season. There was actually too good a harvest, making it difficult to shuck all of the maize they grew. They also realized that the stalks of maize and soybeans were going to waste because they had so many that chopping them up for animal feed was too labor intensive.

FIOH-USA funded a new project proposed by FIOH-Angelic Ark that enabled the purchase of three machines. \$3500 was sent for a maize sheller, a feed chopper/grinder and a feed mixer. The sheller automates the harvest of grain thereby saving the villagers many hours of difficult hand labor. The grinder and mixer allow the villagers to chop up the leftover stalks from the maize and soybean harvest enabling them to be used for animal feed. Green stalks can now be chopped for silage.






MEET OUR PARTNERS

She has a Diploma in community health and development and a Higher Diploma in Project Management. She is also trained as a psychological counselor and a play therapist. She currently heads HIV programmes in Kisimu.

She met our co-founders, Sr. Linda Glaeser and Michele Sprada in 2002 during a community health visit. FIOH-USA sponsored Lillian and her brother through college. Lillian states, "I decided to give back to underprivileged people by volunteering as a board member for FIOH-Kenya. I do it with passion and with all my heart because I know what it did for me and my family and the lives that have been saved in the
