Our Caregiver Hiring Process



Pre-Employment Competency Test

All caregivers participate in a an assessment prior to interviewing to evaluate their strengths and experience as a caregiver.



In-Person Interview With Our Recruiter

Every caregiver is carefully screened for relevant experience through an in-person interview by The HomeAides' recruiters.



Multiple Extensive Background Checks

We run comprehensive federal, national, state and county level background checks on all of our caregivers.



Prior Employment Reference Checks

We contact past employers to collect references and validate work history of caregivers applying to our agency.



Onboarding and Orientation

Caregivers will be educated on our policies and review and follow a detailed service plan created specifically for your loved one.



Ongoing Support During Cases

Caregivers receive continuing support from our Service Plan Managers to ensure they are meeting the needs of the client.

Flexible Service Plans With Transparent Pricing

Because every client's needs are unique, we offer a variety of different service plans that adapt to the level of support needed.

MOST POPULAR SERVICE PLAN

Live-In Caregiver

\$410/day

Best for families who need a caregiver to live with and care for the client ongoing 5+ days a week.

- 5-day minimum
- Billed up to 10 hour work day. Breaks/sleep times factored in.
- Dedicated caregiver who resides with the client ongoing and provides 24hr support as needed

24-Hour **Caregivers**

\$38.50 - \$41/hour

Best for clients who need 24/7 support and supervision throughout both the day and night.

- Typically (2) 12hr shifts
- Billed at an hourly rate per day based on the schedule created
- Around-the-clock caregiver coverage to ensure the client's safety and support day & night

Hourly Caregiver

\$38.50 - \$41/hour

Best for families who need a home aide 7+ hours per day on days and shifts of their choosing.

- 7 hour minimum
- Billed at an hourly rate per day based on the schedule created
- Multiple caregivers may be required for split shifts
