






What is Pee Dee?

The Pee Dee Region of South Carolina gets its name from the Pee Dee (or Pedee) Native American tribe, who originally inhabited the area along the Pee Dee River. The Pee Dee people were part of the larger Siouan-speaking group of tribes in the Southeastern U.S. They lived near the river that now bears their name and played a significant role in the region's early history, including interactions with European settlers.

Over time, the name "Pee Dee" came to represent not only the river and the tribe, but the broader region surrounding it. Today, the Pee Dee Region refers to the northeastern part of South Carolina and includes cities like Florence, Darlington, Marion, and Dillon.

State Parks in the Pee Dee Region

The Pee Dee Region of South Carolina is home to serene state parks that offer a peaceful retreat into nature. Little Pee Dee State Park, nestled near Dillon, is a haven for wildlife enthusiasts and anglers, boasting the tranquil 54-acre Lake Norton. For those seeking adventure, Lee State Park provides kayaking and canoeing opportunities on the scenic Lynches River, along with nature trails that meander through diverse habitats. Each park captures the essence of the region's natural beauty and provides a unique way to experience the great outdoors.

Woods Bay State Park is a natural treasure in the Pee Dee Region, offering visitors a glimpse into the unique ecosystem of Carolina Bays. Located near Olanta, South Carolina, this 1,590-acre park features a diverse range of habitats, including marsh, sandhills, oak-hickory forest, and shrub bog. The park is renowned for its 1,150-foot boardwalk that meanders through a cypress-tupelo swamp, providing opportunities to spot alligators and other wildlife. For a more immersive experience, the one-mile canoe trail allows paddlers to navigate past the Carolina Bays, offering a serene and intimate encounter with nature. Whether you're interested in bird watching, hiking, or simply enjoying the peacefulness of the outdoors, Woods Bay State Park is a must-visit destination.







Darlington County is renowned for its vibrant annual events that celebrate local culture and traditions. The Darlington Raceway hosts two major NASCAR race weekends each year: the Goodyear 400 during the Official Throwback Weekend in the spring, and the Cook Out Southern 500, which kicks off the NASCAR Cup Series Playoffs in the fall. In October, the South Carolina Sweet Potato Festival, the county's longest-running festival, attracts over 27,000 attendees with activities such as children's games, crafts, live entertainment, a car show, and an array of food, including sweet potato pie. Additionally, events like the Taste of Christmas and Scare on the Square offer festive experiences that highlight the community's spirit and hospitality.

Visiting Lee County

In Lee County, cotton has reigned supreme for over 200 years—every fall, the landscape bursts into white with acres of ready-to-pick fields. Beyond agriculture, visitors will find lush parks, historic architecture, and tributes to local heroes and veterans. Bishopville Memorial Park features the Gratitude Merci Train and a statue honoring Medal of Honor recipient James D. Heriot. Downtown, the South Carolina Cotton Museum highlights the region's cotton heritage—plus a glimpse at what may be the world's largest boll weevil. Other local gems include the scenic wetlands of Lee State Park, a charming artesian well, the quirky Button Museum, and the enduring legend of the Lizard Man.





Visiting Marion County

Marion County, named after Revolutionary War hero General Francis Marion, honors its rich history through well-preserved buildings and museums. The Marion Historic District spans over 1,100 acres with architectural styles including Queen Anne, Colonial Revival, and Gothic Revival. Visitors can reflect at Amazing Grace Park, which pays tribute to Rev. Clementa Pinckney and the victims of the 2015 Charleston church tragedy. 



Visiting Marlboro County

Marlboro County, once one of South Carolina's richest agricultural regions, owes much of its early wealth to cotton—so valuable that land was said to be sold by the pound. This prosperity is still reflected in the county's grand Victorian, Queen Anne, and Greek Revival architecture. History buffs can visit the Bennettsville Visitors Center or the 1917 Marlboro Civic Center, once a stop on the vaudeville circuit. Don't miss a sip from Blenheim Mineral Springs, the birthplace of Blenheim Ginger Ale, or a stroll through charming Downtown Bennettsville for local shops, fresh produce at McArthur Farms, and southern eats at Stanton's Barbecue & Fish Camp.



Williamsburg County is situated at the southern tip of the Pee Dee and holds treasures of historical interests dating back to the 1700s. Kingstree was settled in 1732 when Calvinists from Ireland built clay shelters on the banks of the Black River at “the King’s Tree,” a tall white pine used as the mast for royal ships.



Visiting Williamsburg County

Williamsburg County, located at the southern edge of the Pee Dee region, is rich in history dating back to the 1700s. Kingstree was founded in 1732 near “the King’s Tree,” a towering white pine once used for British ship masts. The county is home to architectural gems like the 1823 Williamsburg County Courthouse, designed by Robert Mills, and the 1749 Thorntree House, one of the oldest in the region. Visitors can explore Revolutionary and Civil War history at the Williamsburgh Historical Museum. Outdoor lovers can spend a day enjoying the natural beauty of the Black River, known for its dark waters, white sandbars, and thriving wildlife. Food lovers can savor some of the state’s best barbecue at local favorites like Scott’s in Hemingway, Cooper’s in Salters, and Brown’s in Kingstree.


