STARTING YOUR JOURNEY

INITIAL CONVERSATION

The first step to converting to Judaism is simple... START! An initial conversation with Rabbi Elton will kickstart the process. In this chat, you'll learn more about The Great Synagogue, be able to ask any questions, and understand more about conversion.

BETH DIN

Contact the <u>Sydney Beth Din</u> which oversees the process of all conversions. Provide all relevant forms and supporting documentation. You will be required to attend two meetings with the Beth Din before you are officially accepted into the conversion program.

CLASSES & LEARNING

Weekly group classes and learning are a core part of the process.

These interactive and engaging classes cover all elements of the approved curriculum and will also teach you steps for observance.

PROGRESS UPDATES

You will be required to have regular progress updates with Rabbi Elton (or the Rabbi at the synagogue you choose to attend), as well as progress check-ins at the Beth Din.

WHY THE GREAT SYNAGOGUE?

Located in Sydney's CBD, we welcome members from all over Sydney, no matter the synagogue you attend, to join our classes.

Overseen by the Sydney Beth Din, and following the Beth Din curriculum that meets international standards, The Great Synagogue offers interactive group learning within an accepting, fun and supportive environment.

By participating in our weekly classes you will have the opportunity to meet and engage with other conversion candidates of different ages and life stages who are all embarking on the same journey, and build lifelong connections and friendships in the process.

The Great Synagogue exists to create a beautiful community for its members and their families, including our conversion candidates. We are proud that The Great Synagogue was the first congregation in Australia and it has become a renowned place of aesthetic beauty, inspiring services with a history that spans many generations.

Inclusivity is at the heart of what we do, and we aim to build an engaged community that is deeply connected to the traditions and values of Judaism that will stand the test of time. We welcome diversity and deeply care for our community. We also recognise that everyone is at a different stage in their Jewish journey and accept them without judgement.

OUR CLASSES & CURRICULUM

The foundation of conversion is built on learning and practice. It's about understanding the values, history and practices of the Jewish people, accepting the Mitzvot (commandments) and living in accordance with the Torah.

We have extensive experience in delivering our classes and have a tried and tested format that works. Occurring weekly for one hour, our class format is conversational, initiates questions and discussion and supports the learning of our candidates. Questions are encouraged outside of class to further accelerate your learning and observance.

Classes are mandatory for all conversion candidates and their partners (if applicable), ideally in-person. Zoom attendance is permitted if traveling or in special circumstances.







Having worked with a large number of successful converts over a lengthy period, we have continued to evolve our program based on feedback to improve our learning experience.

We have interactive classes focused on Shabbat (the Sabbath) and Kashrut (keeping kosher) including a tour of a Shabbat observant and kosher home, we host afternoon tea in a Sukkah over the High Holy Days, hold a mock wedding ceremony so we can walk through the rituals together, play games to learn brachot (blessings) and even speak to past converts about their own journeys in classes and host Alumni gatherings.

Over the 12 month curriculum, we teach key units including:

- Glossary of Terms
- O Life cycle
- O Shabbat
- O Kashrut
- O Jewish History
- Morals and Ethics
- O The Jewish Calendar
- O Blessings and Prayer

While Hebrew is not part of our curriculum, we have recommendations for teachers and tutors who will be able to support you in unlocking, decoding and understanding Hebrew which is a cornerstone of Jewish life and prayer.

ABOUT OUR RABBI



RABBI DR BENJAMIN ELTON

I grew up in a traditional Jewish family home in Manchester, England. As a child, I was deeply connected to my Jewish roots and immersed in Jewish life. Our family had Shabbat dinners on a Friday night and kept a kosher home, even though we weren't fully observant.

In my teenage years, having gone to Jewish and non-Jewish schools, I made the choice to walk down a path of full observance, feeling called to keep fully kosher, keep Shabbat (including keeping the TV off from Friday sundown to Saturday dark!) and observing other mitzvot.

In making a decision like this, it's easy to fall down a rabbit hole and become more insular and reject wider societies and cultures, but I made sure to keep my interest in the broader world, studying history at Cambridge University and working in the British Civil Service for seven years. It was at this point I felt the desire to continue my own journey further into Judaism and I took a sabbatical which evolved into a complete career change. I went to train for the rabbinate in New York, where I studied for four years, before coming to Sydney in 2015 as Chief Minister of The Great Synagogue at the age of 35.

My path to observance and becoming a Rabbi is different to some other Rabbis I know. While many Rabbis continue a family tradition of generations of observance, my journey was not dissimilar to that of a convert; learning, trying, stalling and trying again until it felt doable and became an integrated part of my life.

I've tried to bring this feeling into our Great Synagogue Conversion Classes and in my role as a mentoring Rabbi; creating a safe space to learn, try and to ask questions, all within a supportive and inclusive community. No question is silly, everybody is a lifelong learner and we enjoy ourselves and have fun as we go, even if the process can become challenging.



No matter your reason for conversion, whether it's fulfilling a religious calling to join the Jewish faith, having paternal Jewish lineage and wanting to become a full part of the Jewish people, or meeting a Jewish partner and wanting to create a Jewish home and family together, I am here to help and support you on that path.

My wife Hinda is also connected to our conversion candidates, teaching occasional guest classes, working with our brides-to-be on their premarital learning, as well as generally supporting those who are going through the program. Hinda is in the process of completing her Master's Degree in Social Work alongside co-parenting our children Lizzie (5) and Salo (2) and the newest addition to our family, David. We look forward to meeting you, hosting you in our home over a Shabbat or a festival, building a connection and celebrating with you.

I have been delighted by the wonderful people who have come through my classes and I have built special relationships with our students and alumni of all ages, family circumstances and life stages that I hope will last a lifetime.

The conversion process always starts with an informal conversation with me, so please get in touch with me to get the ball rolling and start the journey.

As within my Fijian culture/community, the Jewish community here in Sydney have been warm and welcoming. I feel like I have found my own small piece of the promised land here.




Our path to conversion through The Great Synagogue has been seamless! We are now finished the conversion process, are newly married, and could not be happier with our experience.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO CONVERT?

The answer really depends on you! At The Great Synagogue, we aim to provide you with all of the tools to be able to allow you to experience a streamlined and simple Orthodox Jewish conversion.

We find the conversion process will take, on average, between 12-24 months. This is dependent primarily on each candidate themselves, their individual circumstances and how quickly they wish to take up observance.

(\$) HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

We offer our conversion program completely FREE! It's included in the Conversion Candidate membership fee of \$150. This membership also includes a guaranteed seat over the High Holy Days, member pricing for all of our communal events and subscription to Great Synagogue publications including the annual Great Vine Magazine

Should you have a Jewish partner, they will also be required to attend classes. In order to do so, they will join The Great Synagogue as a regular member or a seatholder.

ARE THERE ONLY COUPLES IN YOUR PROGRAM?

No! Inclusivity and diversity are some of our key values and we welcome a variety of students including singles, couples, people of different ages and life stages.

Come as you are, no matter your circumstances and you will be warmly welcomed.

DO I NEED TO ATTEND CLASSES EACH WEEK?

Classes run weekly over a year long period. We strongly recommend you attend classes in person in the Sydney CBD on a weekly basis to ensure you are learning the curriculum, to allow you to engage with other students in the class, and allow you to ask questions and participate in the interactive elements.

We understand that due to travel or illness, in person attendance might not always be possible. In this instance, a Zoom link will be provided to allow you to still join.

Progress updates will be dependent on class attendance.

HOW OFTEN DO I NEED TO ATTEND A SYNAGOGUE?

Initially, we encourage you to just start attending. As you continue your journey through conversion and increase your observance, regular Synagogue attendance becomes more important and is a key part of your progress updates and check-ins.

DO I NEED TO GO TO THE GREAT SYNAGOGUE TO ATTEND YOUR CLASSES?

No! You don't need to attend The Great Synagogue to join our classes, however you will need to sign up for the appropriate membership at The Great Synagogue to be eligible to attend.

Should you choose to attend another Orthodox synagogue over Shabbat, the High Holy Days etc. and still come to our classes, this is fine. We will simply need to speak to the Rabbi of the synagogue you attend as another element of your progress and check-ins.



WHAT'S THE TIME COMMITMENT?

Classes run for one hour, once a week from February - December, with a mid-year break. We also have classes off for High Holy Days, Fast Days and other festivals. Dates are confirmed in advance.

We also recommend additional study outside of classes to further your knowledge and learning and prepare for relevant exams at the end of the conversion process. This is up to the individual.

IS YOUR CURRICULUM RECOGNISED AND APPROVED?

Absolutely! The Great Synagogue has been working with the strict requirements of the Sydney Beth Din for our conversion classes for many years, and our curriculum follows international conversion standards.

We are the longest running and most successful group conversion program, with more than 30 students who have undertaken classes, with a high volume of successful candidates completing their path to conversion through The Great Synagogue.

We have the benefit of knowing what works, having taught many successful cohorts, and as such we've optimised our classes to keep them interactive, engaging and encourage group conversation and questions.

IS THERE AN EXAM AT THE END OF THE PROCESS?

Yes. Held by the Sydney Beth Din, we aim to cover the content and curriculum that you may be asked during your exam.

The exam process depends on the progress of the individual and is an oral exam which may be held in several parts.
