



Learners explored various story sequence pictures and engaged in the 'Think Square and Share' active learning visible thinking routine, creatively narrating stories in their own words. As a follow-up, they used their thinking skills to imagine and craft unique titles for their stories. This activity enriched their storytelling abilities and fostered creative thinking.

>>> BIOLOGY

Learners explored the concept - how the distance over which diffusion occurs affects its rate by using potato strips as their experimental model. The results demonstrated that a shorter diffusion distance correlates with a faster rate of diffusion.

CHEMISTRY <<<

Grade 10 learners took a diagnostic test on the mole concept to assess their prior knowledge in chemistry, specifically in calculating molar mass.
