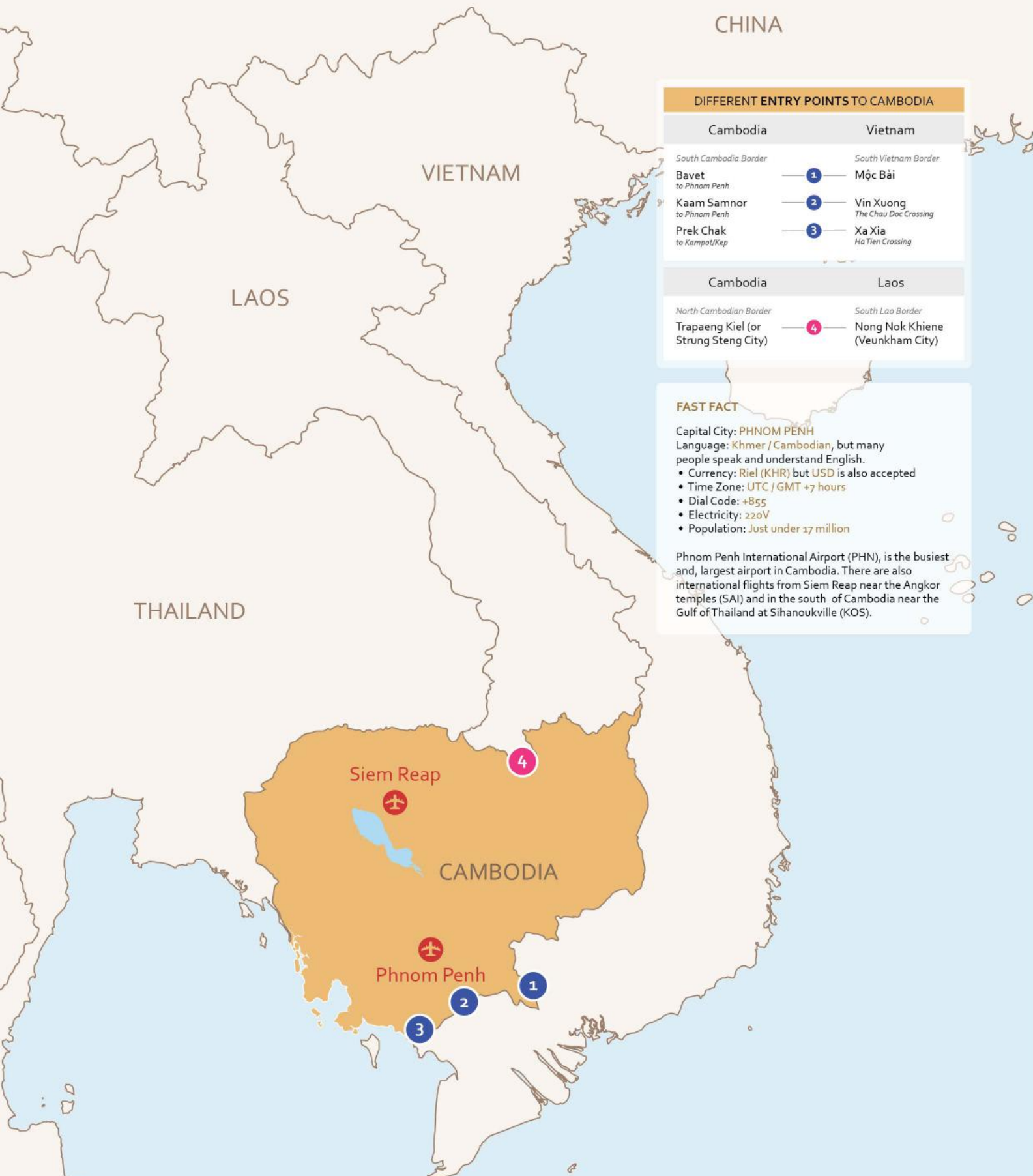

Phnom Penh International Airport (PHN), is the busiest and, largest airport in Cambodia. There are also international flights from Siem Reap near the Angkor temples (SAI) and in the south of Cambodia near the Gulf of Thailand at Sihanoukville (KOS).

Visa requirements vary depending on nationality.

- ▶ **Validity:** Valid for 30 days.
- ▶ **Procedure & Fee:** Can be obtained in the form of an E-VISA at evisa.gov.kh or in local embassies prior to travel. The fee varies depending on the visa type and application method. Express Visa with English-speaking assistance is available in Siem Reap (+\$40/pax) or Phnom Penh (+\$45/pax).
- ▶ **Note:** To enter Cambodia, you will need a valid passport with at least two blank pages. For the most current information and specific details, always refer to official Cambodian government resources or contact the nearest Cambodian embassy or consulate.

***Important:** Since July 2024, Cambodian authorities have introduced a mandatory e-Arrival Card to enter the country. This form must be completed online via a mobile app or the official website, generating a unique QR code to be presented to immigration authorities upon arrival.*

As of July 2025, a digital entry stamp (V-PASS) is now sent by email — based on the information provided in the e-Arrival Card — replacing the traditional passport stamp.

- Electric scooters and e-bikes, which are increasingly popular, allowing visitors to explore cities independently while reducing their environmental impact.



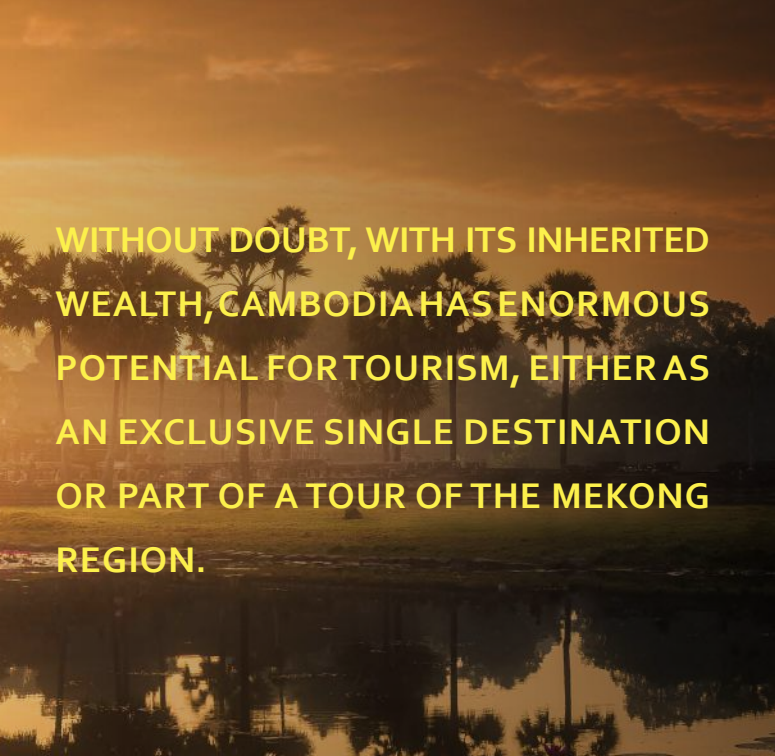

WE SUPPORT

The Angkor Hospital for Children was founded in 1999 and has become one of Cambodia's leading paediatric hospitals. It provides free, high-quality care to around 500-600 children every day. The hospital's strategic mission is to improve health-care for all children in the country, train medical staff and educate the community about health.



APOPO's demining teams operate in countries, such as Cambodia, that have suffered from the legacy of past conflicts. Their mission is to protect people and the planet through innovative solutions that use trained rats to speed up the detection of landmines. To date, nineteen mine-detecting rats have passed their International Mine Action Standards (IMAS) accreditation in Cambodia and are operating in the clearance process at 4 sites in the country.

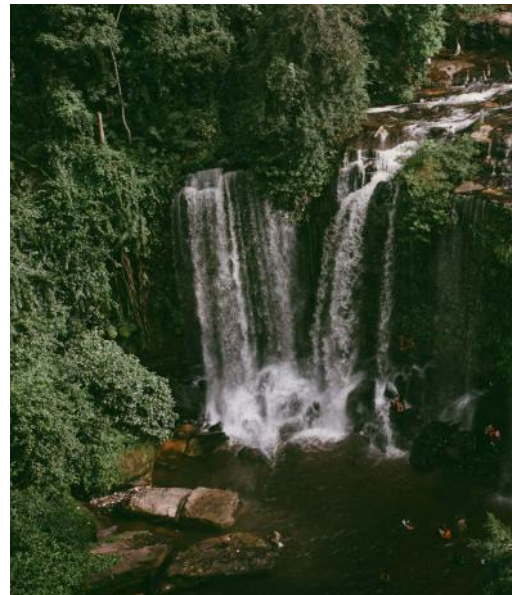

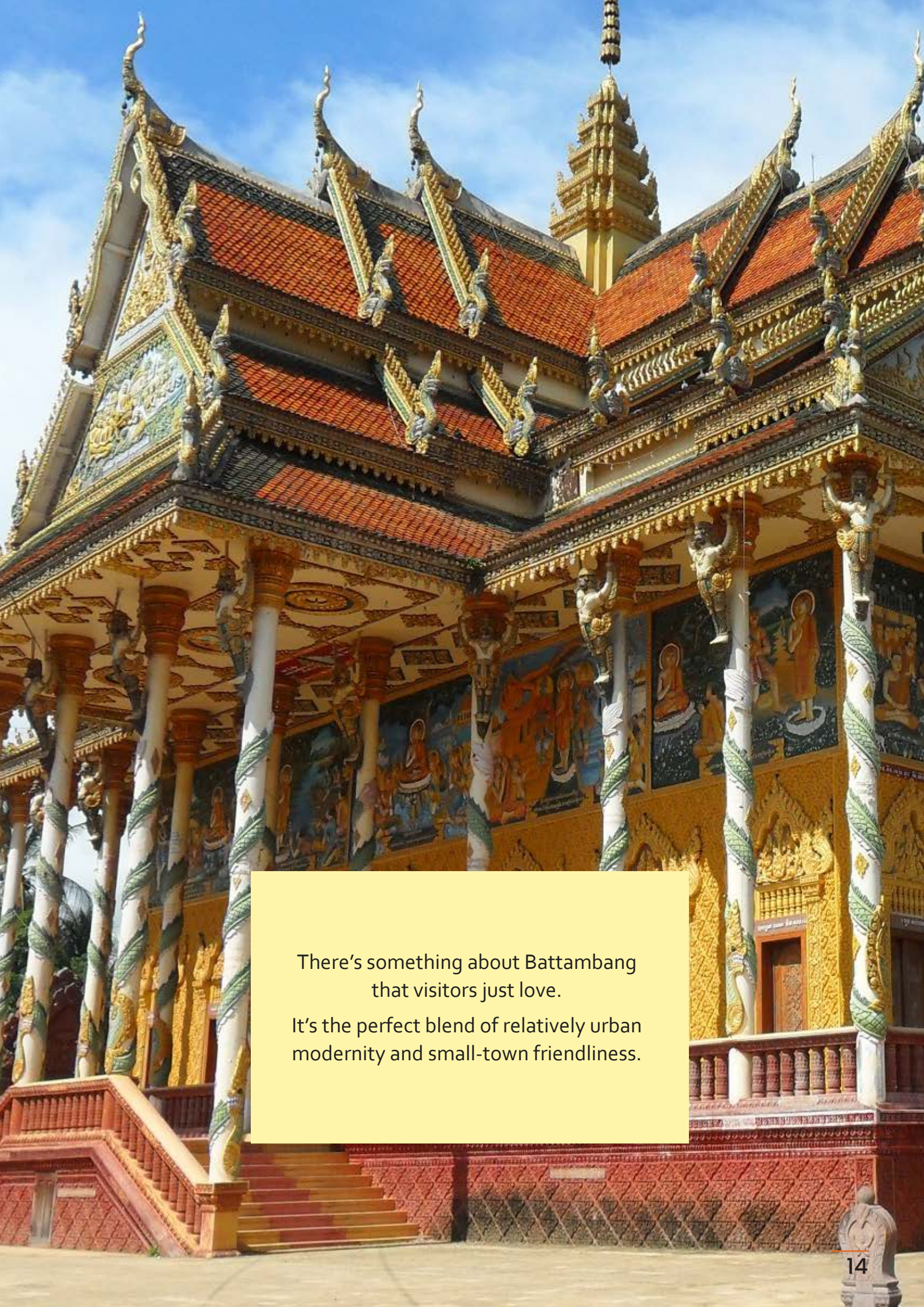

KEP & KAMPOT

Kampot is a small town in southern Cambodia best known for its sleepy riverside atmosphere is quickly transforming into a **lively tourist destination**. Here, you'll find plenty of restaurants and bars with accompanying live music as you relax along the slow-moving waters. This **quaint little town** has a lot more to offer, whether you're looking for a full day of adventure or a relaxed afternoon of riverside lounging.



Kep is a small but **cute Cambodian coastal town with a long history**. A former bustling beach resort, well-loved by the French during the colonial era and then popular with Cambodians after the nation became independent, Kep's glory was shattered by the Khmer Rouge. Bullet holes can still be seen in some of the town's old buildings.

Since its comeback, it is now a nice place to spend a few days relaxing on quiet beaches, exploring the countryside, dining on tasty seafood, and slowing down the pace of life. There's a good selection of places to stay, ranging from luxurious hotels to cheaper valued beds.

SIHANOUKVILLE & ISLANDS

Located on Cambodia's southern coast, about a 5-hour drive from Phnom Penh, Sihanoukville is a **rising tourist hub** known for its natural beauty and untouched beaches. As the country's main seaside destination, it serves as a gateway to nearby **idyllic islands like Koh Rong and Koh Rong Samloem**. Koh Rong, just off Sihanoukville, is celebrated for its pristine white sandy beaches and vibrant evening atmosphere at Koh Touch, while quieter spots offer serene relaxation. Koh Rong Samloem, a 20-minute ferry ride away, features the tranquil Saracen Bay, cultural experiences at M'Pai Bay, and secluded escapes at Lazy Beach.

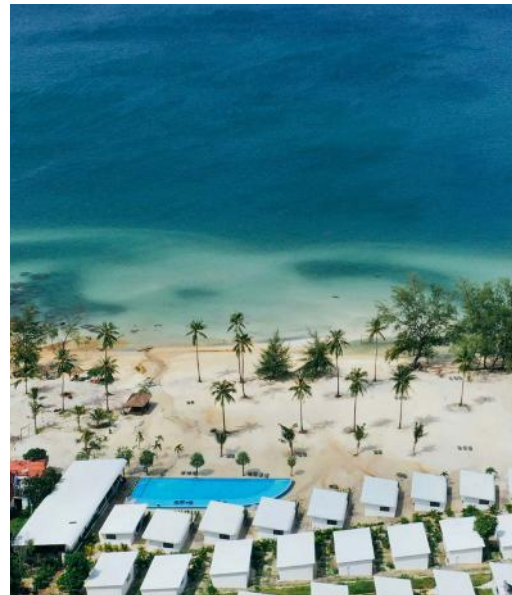
