#### 3K Program (3 years by September 1)

- Three-year olds are taking on new challenges every day!
   New words, thoughts and friendships are being formed.
- They plan engaging hands-on lessons that guide children's learning.
- Must be toilet trained
- Schedule is Thursday and Friday 8:00 am 11:00 am

#### 4K Program (4 years by September 1)

Four-year olds are ready for the continued academic and social challenges before them. Language and critical-thinking are in rapid growth. They are starting to think logically and can use language to express their thinking. They are eager to explore more about the world!

- They plan engaging hands-on lessons that encourage discovery through play.
- Must be toilet trained/Bathroom Independent
- Schedule is Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 8:00 am - 3:00 pm
