CELEBRATING A CENTURY!

This Saturday, we honour Dominic Robson on his 100th appearance for Barnstaple! Since his debut in 2020, he's gone from strength to strength, crashing over for 11 tries—including a match-shaping brace just last week. Huge congratulations, Dominic! Here's to the next 100!

The fixture between these the Chiefs and Hornets is always one circled on the calendar, a match defined by physicality, passion, and pride. Historically, games between the Chiefs and Hornets have been tightly fought affairs and none more so than when these two last met in the 2022/23 season in National 2

West when both lost home advantage as first the Chiefs beat Hornets at Hutton Moor Rd with the closest of score lines 22-23 before the Hornets returned the compliment a few months later at Pottington Road winning 12-24.

Hornets arrive with a spring in their step, enjoying a positive vein of form. They have secured both wins at home including an impressive victory last Saturday beating Taunton 57-22, demonstrating a potent attacking threat.

As for the Chiefs they earned a themselves a worthy try bonus point in a tough encounter against Exeter Uni in what has been described as a pulsating West Country derby. Ultimately beaten 43-26 in this high scoring contest the Chiefs, playing with characteristic grit and determination, weathered an early storm after the hosts crossed the line within just two minutes. But the Barnstaple response was immediate and powerful with Brandon Moore igniting the Chiefs' campaign with a trademark powerful pick-and-go, crashing over to get Barnstaple on the board. The reliable boot of Henry Sellick added the extras, calmly slotting the conversion to level the score.

The Chiefs then went ahead as Brandon Moore was once again at the heart of the action, adding a crucial score to the scoreboard to which Exeter replied to ensure the sides went into the break locked at 14-14.

The second half exploded into life with the Chiefs seizing the initiative immediately after the restart. In the 42nd minute, the

powerful Dominic Robson burst through to dot down, sending the travelling Barnstaple support into raptures.

Exeter mounted a significant fightback to take charge of the game but the Chiefs never gave up. The final word fittingly went to the men in red, when in the 73rd minute, the outstanding Dominic Robson with another explosive pick-and-go try, showcased the raw power and never-say-die attitude that defines this Barnstaple side.

While the final score line may not reflect it, the Barnstaple Chiefs were immense throughout, matching their university opponents at half time and for much of the second half. The home side showed how dangerous they are in the later stages. However the fight shown to secure a bonus point away from home against a strong Exeter side will provide a powerful platform to build upon for the rest of the season.

So, get ready, Barum and expect a full-blooded, committed, and entertaining eighty minutes of rugby today when the Chiefs and Hornets lock horns at 2.30pm. It is going to be a corker of a game and I want to hear you all in full voice.

Next weekend the Chiefs make the short trip to Taunton whilst Athletic visit Cullompton in the Devon Cup.

At Pottington Road we have the Buccaneers hosting South Molton II and Barnstaple Colts against Topsham Colts.

Barnstaple Athletic Answer Critics with Stunning Nine-Try Demolition of Plymstock Oaks



Barnstaple Athletic delivered a thunderous response to their opening-day disappointment, producing a spectacular, nine-try performance to demolish last season's fourth-place finishers, Plymstock Oaks, 57-7 on Saturday. Just a week after a heavy defeat at Paignton, Athletic emerged with a point to prove, and did so in emphatic fashion under glorious sunshine, lighting up the field with a display of dominant, expansive rugby.

Athletic were straight out of the blocks from the start and they took charge of the game and finally shaking off a frantic start where forced offloads stifled early chances, the home side found their rhythm. The breakthrough came on 20 minutes when Brendan Darley powered through multiple tackles to score the first try, converted by Harvey Rostock, the first of six conversions on the day.

Settled and now controlling both territory and possession, Athletic extended their lead before the break with a clever cross-field kick which was collected by Reuben Faulkner's outstretched arm as it bounced, who then raced down the line before passing inside for Josh Ridewood-Williams to canter under the posts for a 14-0 half-time lead.

Any notion of a Plymstock fightback was extinguished within seconds of the restart. A fluid move from a scrum,

involving Sam Carr and Haydn Gosling, sent Faulkner diving over for try number three.

What followed was a devastating ten-minute blitz that put the game utterly beyond doubt. Ridewood-Williams and Darley each crashed over for their second tries in quick succession. Then, two former colts combined as Max Moore claimed a high kick before charging into Plymstock territory and then offloading to Jamie Townsend, who muscled his way down the line to go over for the sixth try. Max Moore then turned scorer, pouncing on a loose ball and sprinting through a gap to score under the posts.

This weekend they have a breather before embarking on three difficult trips on the road to Cullompton, Torquay and finally Newton Abbot before they are back on home soil.
