An unfortunate consequence of this is a growing number of delinquent youths – many of whom are addicted, violent, and suffering emotionally and academically. At Urban Light Ministries, we are also concerned. We want to work with you to make a lasting difference for these and other youth and families.

Through Fathering Strong, we facilitate the formation of fatherhood communities where dads can connect, learn together, and inspire one another. We are also dedicated to fostering stronger bonds between fathers and their children, regardless of the current relationship status of their parents. We do this through virtual and in-person group facilitation. We know this can create a brighter future because building better fathers benefits youth and shapes a safer society. We currently serve 247 member fathers, with 63 actively participating in our resources, including engagement in dad chats.
