Parent and child time

INFANT CLASSES

Registration is based on age of the infant at the start of the class.

Discussions cover topics such as bonding, brain development, milestones, routines, feeding, sleep and more. Infant classes are non-separating; families stay together for the entire class time.

The Fourth Trimester

(Birth to 12 weeks)

The first 12 weeks postpartum, often called the fourth trimester, are crucial for mom and baby. This class covers the realities of this time, offering essential resources and building awareness that challenges are normal. You'll weigh and measure your newborn, track their growth and get information on sleep, attachment, development and mental health. Join us to build a supportive community of families; sharing experiences, learning and growing together.

Infant Classes

(Birth to 18 months)

Interact with your baby in a space designed for infants and meet other families. Learn fun play ideas, songs and get parenting support. Topics include bonding, family life, brain development, milestones, routines, feeding and sleep.

Infant Massage

(Birth to 9 months)

Understand and respond to your baby's cues through the relaxing practice of massage. Learn techniques for better sleep, digestion, brain development and deepening attachment. One-time classes offer a general overview; while two-time classes provide in-depth learning and practice opportunities.

FAMILY CLASSES

Multi-age classes are designed for parents and children from birth to five years old. There will be a variety of activities for children of all ages to explore and learn. Discussion topics focus on parenting children in this age range and the interests of the group. Topics may include developmental milestones, positive guidance, sibling relationships, media use and more! Infants from birth to five months old stay with their parents during group time. Parent and child separation time will be determined by the needs of the group.

The Circle of Security Parenting™ (COSP) program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-child relationships can be supported and strengthened.

This specialized class, created by Circle of Security International, is led by a registered COSP facilitator. Each session includes videos, skill-building, reflection, and discussion.

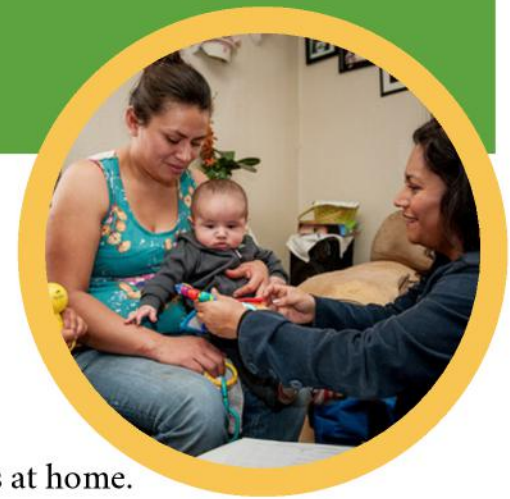

Registrations completed by 10 a.m. on Dec. 18 will enter the random lottery drawing.

After the lottery:

Registrations will be accepted first-come, first-served until classes are full. Space is limited.

Class registration is limited:

To serve as many families as possible, registration is limited to one ECFE class per child.

Cancellation:

Classes may be canceled due to low enrollment. We will help you select another class or provide a full refund if your class is canceled.

Class Fees:

Fees are processed on Dec. 18. After the lottery, fees are charged at the time of registration.

Refunds:

Full refunds are available if you cancel before class starts. After classes begin, refunds are prorated. To cancel, contact the ECFE office at 763-391-8777.

Accommodations:

If you need any special assistance or services to participate in a class, please call us at 763-391-8777 or TDD: 763-391-7250. We ask for at least 72 hours' notice, though a two-week notice is preferred, so we can make sure we have everything ready for you.
