Now

Apply for admission and freshman academic scholarships at apsu.edu/admissions.

The application for admission is also the application for these scholarships, which you can receive up to four years. Please complete your admission application before the priority date of Nov. 15.

Soon

If you haven't already, take the ACT by finding test dates and registering at ACTstudent.org.

Applicants who have completed the test are encouraged to send a student copy of their results to APSU Admissions. While the ACT is not required for admission, taking it can help you earn scholarships.

During your senior year

Oct. 1

Apply for housing at apsu.edu/housing. The sooner you apply, the more room options you'll have. You must be admitted to APSU to apply.

If you're single, under 21 years old and starting college with fewer than 12 credit hours, you must either live on campus or with a parent/guardian who lives within 50 miles of campus.

December

Hoping to receive financial aid – including Tennessee Lottery scholarships, TN Promise, grants and loans? Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at FAFSA.gov.

March 1

The application deadline for all APSU scholarships – except freshman academic scholarships – is March 1. Apply at apsu.edu/scholarships.

April 1

Watch for Governors Orientation (GO) information and register early.

Admission Criteria

Generally speaking, you'll gain admission if you:

→ Earn a 2.85 cumulative high school GPA, a 20 on the ACT or a 1020 on the SAT

and

→ are missing no more than two college prep courses¹

→ THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

→ AUSTIN PEAY STATE UNIVERSITY

Submit the application for admission at apsu.edu/admissions as soon as possible to apply for scholarships you can receive for up to four years. To apply for other APSU scholarships, submit the scholarship application at apsu.edu/scholarships by March 1 after your admission.

→ THE STATE WHERE YOU LIVE

If you're a Tennessee resident, visit tn.gov/CollegePays to learn about Tennessee Education Lottery scholarships. Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [FAFSA.gov](https://fafsa.gov) to apply for these scholarships.

→ PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS

Organizations offer scholarships based on almost any criteria you can imagine. Check with guidance counselors and websites like FastWeb.com* and Scholarships.com* to identify such scholarships.
