





Inventions in the service of human needs.

Now days, lack of clean water causes many problems around the world. If only there was a simple and effective solution to provide clean water for those who don't have access to this basic right. Luckily, there is! It is called "The Drinkable Book!!. Each page of the drinkable book is coated with silver nanoparticles and when water is passed through it, 99.9% of the bacteria are killed, resulting in clean and safe drinking water. a long-lasting sustainable water purification system. Lastly the book also educates its users about water hygiene and gives useful advice about sanitation and safe water habits.


Global water supplies are also decreasing at a fast pace. By 2050, 42% of the earth's population will live in countries where freshwater stocks will not meet their needs.

Innovation in the service of human health.

Believe it or not, mosquitoes are one of the most dangerous animals on the planet, being the cause of millions of deaths in countries like Brazil, Indonesia and Thailand. Diseases such as Zika virus, West Nile virus and Malaria can be spread by mosquitoes to others without them even realizing!

Through travelling and trade, mosquito species can be transferred into new habitats and infect populations in all countries. Therefore, if we don't take any measures, this can result in an epidemic.

Kite patch is a small square that you stick on your clothes and it makes you practically invisible to mosquitoes for 48 hours. When you wear it, mosquitoes cannot trace you, because it blocks the mosquitoes ability to detect carbon dioxide thus they cannot locate you.

It's amazing how a small square can be so effective!





Innovation combating plastic pollution.

Nowadays the majority of people make an excessive use of plastic which has an adverse effect on the environment, people and animals, as it biodegrades after 450-1000 years. Consequently, we have to find effective solutions to this issue.

A promising invention that could help solve the problem is Edible Water Bottles. Edible Water Bottles are clear pods made of seaweed which are 100% biodegradable. They can contain water or other liquids.

The Floating Rubbish Bin is another viable solution. It is an automated marina rubbish bin that collects floating rubbish, debris and oil 24/7 dep


signed by Andrew Turton and Pete

When plastic is discarded it can harm animals and break down into micro plastics entering marine and land ecosystems and even infiltrate our food. Innovation could be the key to reversing the damage!
