He has worked as a local pastor in Guinea-Bissau (2013), assistant pastor, church planter, chaplain and public evangelist (2014 - 2021). Elisabete has a degree in business administration and postgraduate degrees in financial management and nursing. She is currently studying medicine for missionary work in Guinea-Bissau. They have three children: Esther (22), Matheus (7) and Manuela (4).

Our family loves the Lord's mission, especially church planting, and wants to bring the message of Jesus' coming to our generation. Our motivational Bible text is Acts 18:9-10, in which God promises to support Paul's work and declares that He has many people in that city. Many in Guinea-Bissau will hear the message and accept Jesus into their lives. They are our responsibility.

- · Create small businesses that offer paid work to the unemployed, especially recently baptized young people who face food deprivation and Sabbath work conflicts.
- . Buy a solar system to reduce energy costs and the problems caused by the constant energy disruptions in
- . Build a well to collect drinking water, reduce water purchasing costs and minimize water scarcity in the capital.

The Project

Since the official language is Portuguese, but most, especially young people, do not speak the language, we decided we would teach Portuguese. In August 2021, Gláucia Batista, our first short-term missionary (STM), started teaching eight students in Antula neighborhood.

In April 2022, we opened the Casa Novo Tempo center of influence. More than 60 young people began studying Portuguese and English. Four more STMs joined the project that year, including psychologist Daniele Machu and journalist Emanuele Tofoli. We offer various training and qualifications for church members and the community. We also reopened Rádio Novo Tempo, which had been closed for almost three years.

Elisabete, a nurse, leads visits to the sick and provides health care and guidance. We also pray with them: Muslims, animists, Catholics and evangelicals, and they always hear a word of hope.

Church Planting

We began a small group that became a congregation with around 40 people attending Sabbath services. In September 2022, Geovan Machu and Lucas Tofoli founded a Pathfinder Club and Glaucia Batista and Emanuele Tofoli started an Adventurer Club. In July 2023, STMs Larissa Sasson, Thallita Cachoeira and Tamily Oliveira, were instrumental in helping organize and prepare the first nationwide Pathfinder Camporee, attended by over 1,000 young people and with more than 50 baptisms.



Furlough Launching Needed: \$47,658

Our re-launching goal covers the projected costs for travel to the field, furlough expenses and project reserves. We must reach this goal before we can return to our project.

Furlough Monthly Pledges Needed: \$664

Committed monthly funding sustains our project while we are in the field. It covers our project expenses, salary and benefits. This budget requires the commitment of individuals to give each month for the duration of the project or as long as they are able.

ABOUT THE GEBA ANIMIST PROJECT

Guinea-Bissau is located in West Africa, near Senegal. Its 2 million people are divided into 35 ethnic groups, with more than two-thirds living below the poverty line. A civil war rocked Guinea-Bissau, beginning July 7 1998, and on through May 1999, killing thousands and increasing the country's social difficulties.

The population is approximately 50 percent Muslim, 40 percent animist, and less than 12 percent Christian. The unreached comprise more than 85 percent.

The animist influence is very strong in Guinea-Bissau, that is why many continue practicing animist ceremonies, even among Christians and Muslims.

Family, tribal and cultural aspects make abandoning the ancestral practices of animism difficult. Fear of the consequences of breaking the relationship with spirits, such as being cursed, is a major obstacle to accepting the gospel. Many are expelled from their homes when they accept Jesus. In extreme cases, some are killed.


