The City of Elgin is looking for ways to cut down on single-use items, and the Sustainability Commission has proposed a potential solution to the City Council: a Retail Single-Use Bag Ordinance. This proposed ordinance would ban single-use plastic checkout bags and introduce a fee on paper bags distributed by retailers. Before the City Council makes any final decisions, city staff are asking residents and businesses to provide their feedback. Your input will be used to help guide the next steps for this potential new policy.

From Leaves to Lights Essential Fall Fire Safety Tips

Fall brings cooler weather, colorful leaves, and festive fun—but also fire risks. Burning leaves can release harmful toxins, cause wildfires, and may be banned in parts of Illinois, so check local regulations for safe disposal. Seasonal decorations like dried leaves, corn husks, and crepe paper are highly flammable—keep them

away from flames, and use battery-powered candles instead of real ones. Bonfires should be kept at least 10 feet from structures, never left unattended, and avoided on windy or dry days. Keep water nearby for safety. Enjoy the season while staying fire smart and protecting your home and community.

A Scenic and Safe Passage

Allen+Pepa Architects worked on this bridge for Elk Grove Village. The pre-assembled bridge structure was just set into place on October 14. The lead engineers are EEI and Benesch Engineering. After analyzing options, our architectural team created the unique 3-D modeling of the structure and focused on designing railings, lighting and decorative concrete. The three pieces are the switchback from the new business district, the distinct bridge over Arlington Heights Road and a sweeping ramp into Busse Wood. The steel columns resemble trees with integrated lighting. It provides pedestrians and bike rider safety and will create a strong public image.

English is Not Necessary if:

- You have been a permanent resident for 20 years and are age 50 or older.
- You have been a permanent resident for 15 years and are 55 years of age or older.
- If you are over 65 and have had permanent residence for 20 years, you only have to study 20 questions. You will take the exam in your language

To Apply for Citizenship You Must:

- Be 18 years old
- Be a lawful permanent resident for at least 5 years
- Be a lawful permanent resident for 3 years and married to a US citizen for 3 years.

Have Prepared:

- Residence card, Social Security Card, and driver's license or state identification.
- Dates of all travel outside the U.S. in the last 5 years
- A list of your addresses and jobs with dates for the past 5 years.
- Spouse's name, date of birth, Alien number and date of naturalization.
- Date of marriage and divorce from you and your spouse's previous marriages. Names, date of birth, and address of your children (If under 18.)
- If you have been arrested or given a citation, bring a certified court disposition.

Fees:

- \$10 fee to process the application and postage
- The USCIS fee for the immigration application is \$760 and they will now only accept payments made by credit card or bank account (account number and routing number).




