Weaving Connection with The Kinship Way

Throughout human history, people have connected with each other in many forms of Kinship or clan council in relationship with water & governing lunar cycles. In more recent times, with the quest for so-called 'progress', humans have shifted away from living in alignment with natural law while moving toward extractive practices. Much of this shift is the result of colonization which has been destructive to all forms of Kinship separating & isolating us while disconnecting us from nature.

Extractive colonized choices have led to our current

predicament, where we have reached or exceeded 6 or 7 of 9 planetary tipping points. Exceeding just one of these tipping points is a disaster, but exceeding 6 or 7?

Are we able to recognize the urgency for Kinship & identify the current state of planetary collapse we are living in?

Many people are feeling overwhelmed, isolated, frustrated & traumatized. To continue without changing course would be to choose the charred path that is expressed in Indigenous prophecies & teachings. If humans are to survive, it is urgent to choose another path, one that reconnects us with our gifts & responsibilities.



This vision is inspired by the teachings & wisdom of Indigenous community members, the way of water & how Mother Earth humbly regenerates herself.

Can we remember that, like Mother Earth, we are 70% Water, we are all Water beings? Can we create water cultures of care that reconnect us to sacred sovereignty? Can we share our gifts generously, identify our responsibility to Water by re-adopting her sovereignty model in a Kinship commons to heal & regenerate our broken water cycle?



Designing new practices invites us to live into our gifts, listen, witness, feed, nourish, tend, teach, share & care for ourselves and all beings in reciprocity.

Waterloom is an ongoing immersion that weaves water consciousness & connection to create & demonstrate new ways of thriving with the Kinship Way. We are weaving the teachings of The Kinship Way (Becky Big Canoe), The Way of Water (Bree Leggett) & The Creative Way (13 Moons by Jennifer Luxmore-Begin) to design & create Kinship commons frameworks to responsibly care for each other at all stages of life alongside Water & all beings.

Through The Way of Water,
we weave new fabric with
water, our common thread,
to create tapestries that
connect & heal our broken
water cycle in harmony
with Grandmother Moon &
her gracious governance.
Participate in immersions
or arts in action
installations to lift water &
create a heathy circulatory

Through The Creative Way, we are inspired by Anishinaabe moon teachings, ways to be together creatively with invites to find your way to ceremony & celebration where we flow with art, music, dance, feasts, fashion & fun. We follow fun to create healthy cycles within our watersheds.

This is a culture of care where we thrive, recognize & celebrate Water as Kin within Kinship clans created according to the The Kinship Way.



In many Indigenous cultures, being a member of a kin group confers certain privileges, such as being in council with other members to inform the Headman and/or Headwoman of the kin group about the state of wellbeing within the group and about measures needed to enhance the wellbeing of the group as a whole. It would also include the right to assistance with matters such as housing and food, as well as medical and spiritual care.

The Kinship Way embraces a new way of introducing ourselves,

a practice that honors and deepens our connection to place and our vital role in restoring the relationship with the land. As a member taking part in council, you will rise and share:

- Your name.
- Your kinship group.
- Your watershed and bioregion, acknowledging the land you belong to.
- Your age advisory council designation (youth, adult, middle, senior, or elder).

A statement about your relationship to your bioregion, articulating your commitment to representing and stewarding a chosen species or element of the ecosystem.

This act of sharing underscores our belonging to our kin, establishes our connection to the land, and reinforces our commitment to being mindful and responsible stewards of the earth and all its relations. Finally, every community that becomes a Community of Care and has all 12 kinship groups in operation, if it has an opportunity to choose a name, should make reference to the watershed it is in, in its name.

I've been working in the trenches, mostly outside of public view, on many areas of a good life. My first passion is natural building, mostly because I built a straw bale house to live in, and I'm well aware of the despicable housing conditions a great many of my people live in. So I involve myself with other women and grandmothers who are trying to create some assistance to those who need homes and housing.

At this time, I formally work for the Ecological Farmers Association of Ontario as the Indigenous Outreach and Engagement person, and I find this work so rewarding. As our people reclaim food sovereignty, we have so much to relearn about gardening, farming, ranching, and wild harvesting. This wonderful organization is so helpful and supportive to both new and experienced farmers in Indigenous communities. We have our 2nd Annual Indigenous Growers Gathering coming up in December in London, Ontario, and we have a full roster of interesting presentations, keynotes, and workshops.

I'm also a founding member of the Mno Aki Land Trust, which seeks donated lands for the benefit of our people to have spaces to reconnect to Mama Aki (Earth) and practice many forms of land-based learning and cultural revitalization. The idea with Mno Aki is to bring Grandmothers into the stewardship role by determining what the donated lands will be used for, as it is possible that grandmothers know best what is needed by the people of their communities.

"When renewalis needed, a vision must be enacted for the people." Black Elk teaches: "You must do your duty and periorm this vision ior your people



Finally, the idea of the Kinship Way was preceded by a vision in which I saw the many colors of mankind dancing a sacred dance and coming together in unity. Shortly after, sitting at my keyboard, I suddenly wrote pages and pages of this new way we can utilize Indigenous wisdom to bring us all together under totemic symbols and the colors of the medicine wheel, which in one particular teaching symbolize the races of mankind. I have worked on refining and defining it in ways that make sense to the people of today. I feel that at first it feels complex and challenging, but in fact, it's really very simple. The challenge is that people have a program in their minds already of how governance works, in which they cast a vote every 4 years and give their power to a personality/party. The Kinship Way so beautifully and simply takes that power back so the PEOPLE determine the kind of life they will have.



The Kinship Way is taken from many models of traditional indigenous governance, providing each member with many benefits, as well as teaching how to live within natural laws that ultimately create our cradle of civilized relationships. The Kinship Way provides a path of relationship and reconciliation between peoples of all cultures and races for the systems to be fair, equitable, and determined by the people themselves. Born out of Indigenouslifeways, this vision emerged during a time of global pause and personal healing. It carries the medicine of circles, councils, and stories that have long guided humanity toward balance. This idea was born from several inspirations but is mostly attributable to 'spirit', that mysterious force in our lives that we should listen to with humility.


It also comes from my loveof and respect for my people, the Anishinaabeg of the Great Lakes region of North America, and our doodemag systemthat pre-dates colonialism. Also known as a clan system, it provided guidance and stability to our everyday lives and helped all of us to know our roles and responsibilities aswe moved through life. It also helped all clan members know the parts of society to which they are meant to contributeto the best of their ability, building on their strengths and talents.

As I was listening to conference presenters at the 7th Generation Bioregional Earth Summit 2024, I heard various speakers talk about how we need to put lots of effort towards stewarding and healing large parts of our ecosystem that have been damaged by industrialism and colonialism. The speakers were both Indigenous and non, and as I heard the Indigenous presenters speak, each one began their presentation by giving their name, their place of origin and their clan affiliation.





Kinship begins with the principle that all life is related. It is not a metaphor, it is a worldview. Each action, decision, and relationship in The Kinship Way is guided by values such as respect, reciprocity, humility, accountability, and equity. Humanity can draw upon the enduring legacy of indigenous peoples worldwide, who masterfully employed such systems to organize themselves and to disseminate knowledge, standards, stories, observances, responsibilities, and protocols. One of the main features of a kinship system is the creation of relationships among members and in relation to members of other kinship groups. All members of the same kin group, no matter where they are in the world, are 'kin' to one another. The relationship of brotherhood and sisterhood is promoted as the ideal because it is important that everyone experiences a feeling of belonging and connection in the world. However, personal autonomy and personal boundaries are always respected because each being is naturally endowed with a sense of sovereign-self and the right to personal self-actualization within mutually agreed upon societal boundaries, such as "do as thou wilt and harm none".



When I heard the main presenter stating that we needed a way to help connect people to the land and restoration work, it occured to me that the answer had already been spoken by the Indigenous presenters - the best way forward is the clan system! Clans effectively tie you to family, land and your specific role. This includes the natural world as the inspiration to help humans understand their connection to the web of life.

This need for connection was heightened by the pandemic. With people everywhere feeling so disconnected, isolated and lonely. With so many people suffering, it occurred to me that we needed an antidote that connected us into a community of caring and peer support. Most of all, I was totally convinced that we need to co-create a self-governing society that is prosperous and stable for the wellbeing of the children of the world and the next seven generations to come

Becky Big Canoe is an accomplished **AnishinaabeKwe** mother, sustainable housing proponent, writer, artist, activist and powwow dancer. She lives on Georgina Island. She is actively involved in the Mno Aki Land **Trust. Becky works** with EFAO's Indigenous Outreach and **Engagement Steering Committee** to support knowledge sharing events, mentorship and soil testing for Indigenous growers and communities.

There is a time in every woman's life when the inner call to heal becomes louder than the noise of the world. It is a whisper that says, "Return home, Beloved. It is time." For me it was an inner shout, a cry that called for my soul to find its way back to the light of who I am.

It took years of learning the inner map for wholeness and practice but I finally got home. When I did it changed my life forever.

Discovering what it meant to be a whole human being was enlightening. I met my inner council - archetypal map of five and they know exactly what to say to me to help me know my purpose. I like many of you, I wanted to understand who I am and what my purpose was.


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



A few days ago, 13.10.25 in Kaikōura, the East Coast of the South Island, Aotearoa, NZ, we were blessed with a profound celestial visitation: a White Humpback Whale. Not just any White Humpback, it was believed to be Migaloo, a 38-year-old White Whale was first spotted in Byron Bay on the East Coast of Australia. This sacred Tohora (Whale) is a being long prophesied as the Navigator of Peace and herald of cosmic alignment.

This rare White Tohora, a guardian of ancient Dreaming and bearer of stellar transmissions, has returned as a creature of the deep oceanic currents, as a living messenger of Sirius, the spiritual Mothersun Star of Hine Takarua, and an ambassador of the cetacean language of light and sound, the divine frequencies that realign us with our own inner sonar, our truth-compass through this epic planetary unfolding.

The Cetacean Call: Remembering the Language of Joy

On my 60th birthday this January, we voyaged to Whale Island (Moutohorā), East Coast of the North Island, Aotearoa, NZ. There, among sea songs and wind whispers, we were greeted by a Tuatara (the oldest reptile, known as the living stargate) and a pod of laughing, leaping Dolphins. No one else aboard spoke Dolphin, so I did. Boldly. Authentically.

The moment I vocalized the cetacean tones, they responded, spiraling, playing, matching my joy with theirs. I witnessed golden spirals rising from the water, a luminous affirmation that when we meet creation with authenticity and love, it meets us back with miracles. This is why we are being called to reattune to the cetacean frequencies. To sing again with the living ocean of sound. To become sonar beacons of truth in a world relearning how to feel.



Deep beneath the surface of this mythic moment lies a greater convergence still, the meeting of the Ether Plasma Dragons, guardians of the planetary grid, and the Sonar Whales, carriers of the Galactic Songlines. In Aotearoa, they share the same name: Taniwha. Whale and Dragon one breath in two forms, both holding an octave bridge between worlds, singing the same tone through different expressions.

At the sacred threshold of Te Rerenga Wairua, the leaping place of spirits, First Light and First Dreaming converge. This is where Heaven and Earth have always touched, written into our creator god stories for millennia.

Now, the stellar consciousness of 3iAtlas enters, pulsing every 11:22 seconds, a hyper-intelligent plasma architecture never before seen or felt.

Light reflecting into itself. A mirror matrix duplicating planetary forms. The thing about our scars and wounds, pain lies deep within you. It can make you a victim or a survivor or even a hero... it can transform how we see events in our life, it can enable or debilitate. It is up to us, it is entirely possible to heal it and use the experience as your power, your wisdom, and your infinite worth. The wounds you carry, honour of the battles we survive, this is an introduction to my handbook (Chapter 1) to transform wounds to growth, understanding, and finally, even peace. I hope this assists you in understanding and gives you the insight that follows when we dare to heal.

Healing The Soul Wound

Foreword

Healing is not a linear journey. It spirals through lifetimes, through cellular memory, through subconsciousness, through emotions. The wound we experience, whether emotional, physical, or spiritual, is not a weakness. It is an initiation.

In this Handbook, I do not seek to offer a quick fix, but rather an invitation: to meet yourself wholly, gently, and truly.

Introduction:

There comes a time in our lives when the pain we carry can no longer be ignored. It seeps into our thoughts, our relationships, our lives, and spills over, often affecting us when we didn't see it coming. At first it once impacted it may seem like a a permanent problem and may even derail us from our usual daily activities, gradually in time it manifests on occasion, as a distraction or something annoying that we tend to push to the side, there are the other more impactful experiences, life changing things that completely change the world we live in ... our responsibility to ourselves during these changes in our lives can be measured from acceptance and understanding to extreme denial, self medicating and present in emotional outbursts, anxiety and sleeplessness, the aspects of the dis -ease that we are trying to bear.

It's in the unpacking, revisiting, and understanding the wound, because over the months and years to follow, at times it raises its head. demanding our attention.

It is when we gently take time out and gradually return toward the wound, with curiosity and intention, that we can begin to see how the wound has been ignored to some extent, and that feels incongruent. We need to take the time to lean in and rethink and re-associate, reflect and understand that if we want to solve the problem, and get past it, we need to begin to open it up, to debride it healing from the inside out.,

To debride is a term meaning to reopen the wound. to clean away at the source... and to prepare the wound to heal from the inside out.

This book is an empathetic guide, an invitation for the reader to join me journey from pain to healing. You are invited to feel deeply, honestly, and remember to open up, as we shine a light into the abandonment of denial, to those areas in your life that have until now been cast aside. The power lies within you. We learn that pain is a personal lesson about growth and mending and choosing to heal, and furthering our understanding.

The wound bears silent testimony to what has been broken. It speaks without words, marking the place where life was altered. Through its ache, we are reminded of the moment of sudden impact. It is both an injury and a messenger. In tending it, we come face to face with truth, the impact of the wound itself bearing witness to the potential need to defend and to cleanse, protect our being.

Invocation:

Let the wound reveal itself now, as a mark of survival. Let me listen, feel, understand, and reassess myself anew.

Reflection:

The wound is often seen as something to cover up or shun, ignoring it. In its reveal, the rawness can point towards what matters, on a deeper level, where what was unhealed, with understanding and attention, was seeking to share an aspect of our journey we have until this moment ignored. Welcome the opportunity to explore the feelings surrounding the wound. To witness without shame or fear is to reclaim our story.

Steps:

1. Notice the wound

2. Bring your attention to where the wound resides physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

3. Focus on control

4. Identify your ability to stand in your power while focusing your attention and energy

5. Select the wound that feels most present or the one that wants to be addressed

6. Unpack it gently

-Explore its impact on your life, experiences, and perspective, without judgment.

-Acknowledge that consciously, you are allowing it to speak.

-Listen and honour the experience.

-Note your feelings.

7. Prepare for release 8. Begin to soften, acknowledge, and hold the love and support for yourself as you release what no longer serves you.

9. You have debrided your wound

Affirmation

I acknowledge the wound I have carried.

I stand in control with my intention and understanding.

I begin my journey of release, relinquishing that which has held me back.

Mantra of Release:

"I have begun the journey of letting go. I release this pain fully and invite the life force, the energy of life force, to now fill the space I have cleared with light, healing, and renewed vitality."

Congratulations, you have begun clearing your way to your own source of being, to a better you.

I honour the wisdom in my wound and allow it to teach me.

I want to speak to you, as a woman who's been cracked open and still chooses to shine. You might be standing in a moment that feels like the end.

Maybe you've just heard the word cancer.

Maybe you're grieving someone who held your whole heart.

Maybe you're walking through divorce, estrangement, or financial loss.

Maybe you're simply tired of being strong, of holding it all together.

I see you. I feel you, and I want you to know, his is not the end. This is your beginning. We are in the sunset of our lives, not fading, but flourishing. This is the golden hour where grief meets grace. Where we say goodbye to what was, and gently begin again.

We Don't Rush Healing, We Ritualize It
We light candles for our losses.
We speak names that deserve remembering.
We write affirmations for the woman we are becoming.

We gather in quiet, in rhythm, in truth.

This is the work of legacy. This is the work of Kintsugi Woman. This is the work of continuing, begin again, beautiful one.

You are not too late.

You are not too broken.

You are not alone.

You are a siSTAR, A woman who continues, even when life says pause. So today, I invite you to look deep within. To gather your stories, your scars, your sacred truths. Begin again, ot despite what you've been through, but because of it. Take a quiet moment.

Light a candle. Write down one thing you're ready to release, and one thing you're ready to reclaim. Whisper this:

"I honor what was. I embrace what is. I begin again."

Then breathe, rise and continue.

We're walking this path together, siSTAR. Arm in arm. Heart to heart. Soul to soul.

Mith Love From YourCosta Dica Connection:



All in a day in Costa Rica! I dreamed, early in the morning... that I went into a restaurant and there was my brother. (He died at age 70 in Jan. 2025 from complications from diabetes).

I approached Garey (who I have been estranged from for the last 6 years). He had a product of some type he was getting ready to promote/sell. I told him I would help him.

We had a cordial, nonchalant conversation, friendly, collaborative as I asked him about his product. The most vivid part of the dream was me, meticulously packing a bag for him. We were going to go out together. I realized we each had a car. This dream probably has many meanings, but what I came away with was a special bond and closure with my brother!

That ...same morning about 6 am, I was walking on the beach. It was low tide. I was walking amongst the rocks when one of the rocks moved! On close inspection, it was a marooned sea turtle, probably an Olive Ridley. (This is the season when the sea turtles come up on the shore to lay their eggs.) (Had she seen the new turtle tattoo on my ankle and identified me as a friend?) Her shell body was the size of my arms held out, creating a big circle. I squatted down to reach her. She was very heavy! I looked up and down the deserted beach...searching for help.

All of a sudden, Riggo, the owner of a beachside café, appeared from the shoreline. He was able to lift our turtle twice to larger and larger tide pools till she was in a place with a passage way to the open sea. He assured me (in Spanish and Pantomime), that the tide would come and allow her to swim out! I was so relieved, I hugged him and he disappeared! I felt a sense of awe! I imagined Jane Goodall was smiling!







Still early, around 8:30am...I received a call from Susan. She and her husband, Paul care for Migo, a free-wheeling dog that has adopted our Villa Development. Last week, I had sent an SOS to our Canto del Mar Community, telling them that Migo had wondered into my porch area and seemed to want a lot of attention. I had discovered he had an infected ear that had ballooned to 3 times its size! So many of the people who live here are gone, renting out their Villas.

I wanted to know...was anyone feeding Migo? Looking after him? Paul, Migo's best friend, fosters cats and dogs, supporting and promoting a spray and neutering program in the local community and area of Dominical, Costa Rica. I discovered that Paul was in the states, recently having received a diagnosis of pancreatic cancer.

There was a response from the owners of villas in our HOA. What could they do to help? Susan...now back from the states for a week to take care of things here...had a plan. Get Migo on a leash, get him into the car, and get him to the vet. (Migo is basically a jungle dog who hates cars, vets, and being owned!). Three of us reported for duty and got Migo into the car and on his way to the vet. Neighbors who often spar with each other offered \$ to help with Migo's vet bills. He is a symbol of freedom in Canto del Mar, wanders on a whim, and is friendly to everyone. He is our mascot! We want him around! Two saves and a healing in one morning!

Even though there is strife in the world...there is collaboration, compassion, and miracles! This month, with the October Full moon representing a sense of harmony and balance in the Universe, may it infuse each of us with equanimity!

Addendum: Migo had his ear lanced, had surgery, and now has stitches. He currently sports a cone on his head. Susan is caring for him and handing him over to me to continue his medication regimen and his next vet appointment! Please send positive vibes out to Migo, but especially out to Paul for recovery from his upcoming year treatment program. Gracias!














Everyone's Whole

So many are ignorant of compassion's call


How can we get there... to the place where we share?

When I heal my heart, and you do it too

When I was a teenager I was always sewing and creating clothes. And, in amongst that, I discovered the beauty of being able to work with colour. It was with great enthusiasm that I set out to dip into dyeing... though in my first efforts I learned there was more to it than the colouring only. I'm not sure now if I took on the challenge, or volunteered for my brother and his friends to create purple single styles as they played their gig they were looking sharp and edgy, but it wasn't until after the gig that they realized that they were wearing purple imprints for days. Oops, LOL, a bit more refining, tweaking, setting the dye fast, and rinsing, there was more to this, ah, but the colours worked ...

The little Dylon tins were so powerful in transforming old T-shirts and scarves, and old vintage dresses. I got more proficient with raffia tied off in circles, I'd create suns and stars strategically placed...

So recently, I was inspired by these memories, and as I had some old lace on hand, I decided to take a friend up on the offer of harvesting some mulberries.

I was working with the season, this inspired me ... it felt aligned. A creative venture I'd been wanting to get back to for decades... where colours changed with the season. The thought of dyeing some lace from its vintage fade to a vibrancy with seasonal fruit inspired me.

In this case it was mulberries and black tea
I photographed the out come and have given you
the recipe for the mulberry dyeing ritual for
cotton, lace, or light fabrics

1. Prepare the Fabric

Begin with dry cotton lace or a soft cotton T-shirt. If it's new, wash it first to remove any factory finish. Let it dry, then soak it in strong black tea; this acts as a gentle natural mordant and softens the fibers. Once soaked, hang it to dry again.

2. Prepare the Mulberries

Choose ripe mulberries, the kind that almost fall into your hand. Place them in a bowl or pot, mash them slightly, and let them rest overnight. As they sit, their juices will begin to flow, deep and wine-like, releasing the essence of their colour. If some berries have already begun to ferment, all the better, their natural alcohol helps the pigment bloom.

3. Create the Dye Bath

In the morning, cover the berries with fresh water. Bring to a gentle boil, then lower to a simmer for 25–30 minutes. Turn off the heat and let the mixture rest, allowing the colour to deepen as it cools.

4. Dye the Fabric

Once the liquid is cool enough to handle, place your tea-soaked, dried fabric into the pot. Press it down gently so it is fully submerged. Cover and let it sit in the dye until the bath is completely cool. The longer it rests, the deeper the tone will become.

5. Finish and Set the Colour

Put on gloves and carefully lift the fabric from the dye. Squeeze the excess liquid back into the pot, save this dye for your next piece. Hang your dyed garment in the shade to dry slowly. When it's dry, rinse gently in cold water with a splash of vinegar to help fix the colour. Hang again in the shade to dry completely.

6. Et Voilà

You now have your own mulberry-dyed creation — touched by fruit, time, and patience.
Each piece will be unique: a whisper of the season, the earth, and your hands.



You will need:
-Ripe mulberries (the darker and softer, the better)
-Cotton lace, old T-shirts, or natural fabric
-Strong black tea
-Gloves
-Stainless steel or enamel pot
-Vinegar (white)

You will find the way through.


You may choose the sentiment of your nostalgia,

All beings are worthy of the recovery of our true humanness. You can expect the discomfort of facing dysfunction, an urge to run from your authentic self, a sense of revelation, and the pregnancy of possibilities. You may even return lost pieces of soul and power. And then you'll integrate it all.

This 9 months long course is a re-birth. It requires commitment and a desire to be a leader in the renewal of Life. These teachings, this Medicine, will challenge you and grow you to the next level in your evolution.



and I don't need to.




