SYMPATHY & EMPATHY

EXPLORING EMOTIONAL MANAGEMENT

Emotions are not good or bad. They are just feelings. How you feel is okay. You get to feel how you feel. Everyone feels emotions. However, how you respond to emotions and your behavior when feeling emotions can be managed. Managing your emotions doesn't mean hiding them or pretending they don't exist. Instead, it means taking your time to think about the feelings more and using your body, and making healthy decisions when feeling intense emotions.

PEER PRESSURE

Peer pressure is the powerful social influence or urging to do things. Peer pressure can be positive or negative. For example, you have a substitute teacher today and a big test tomorrow. You and all your classmates quietly study without goofing off. This is positive peer pressure. If your friend wants to go out to the mall this night before a big test and not study, and you decide to go with them, you're feeling peer pressure not to study. This is negative peer pressure.

Sometimes, peer pressure can be unexpected. This means you feel pressured based on another person's actions or facial expressions. It takes courage to stand up for yourself and not be pressured into doing things you don't want to do.
