Dear Alternatives Community,

Alternatives began its life-affirming and eternity-shaping work in 1982. Over the course of those four decades, countless women, men, and children have been served in the name of Christ.

Women have chosen life after experiencing the love and care of Jesus Christ through our staff, volunteers, and partners. Men have been challenged and empowered to fulfill their God-given role as protectors of life. As a result, thousands of lives of the most vulnerable and innocent have been saved from the tragic fate of abortion.

Our Strategy

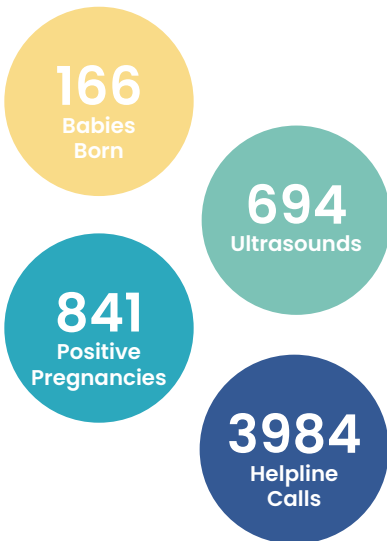

Intervention:

- Pregnancy Options – Pregnancy Tests, Ultrasounds, Momma Mentoring, Fatherhood Mentoring, Legacy Men’s Services, 24-Hour Helpline, and 24/7 Nurse Chat
- Counseling After Abortion
- Online Appointment Requests, Options Consultations, Telehealth Appointments
- Case Management, Uber Health Rides, Prenatal Resources, Adoption Referrals, Community Resources, Mom & Baby Gifts

Prevention:

- STD Testing and Treatment
- Sexual Risk Avoidance Counseling

Pregnancy Tests

The result often elicits joy, but there can also be a wide range of emotions as people start to process what the next steps might be. This is an opportunity for the caring and professional Alternatives staff to walk with the mother and father, to love them unconditionally, and to answer questions or sensitively offer information and resources.



Ultrasounds

One of the most important tools in the case for life is the ultrasound. Parents get a glimpse of the precious life God is forming inside the mother's womb. The impact is often life-saving and life-changing. Alternatives staff is honored to be there for those holy moments when mothers and fathers, many of whom come to Alternatives wanting to get an abortion, fall in love with their babies as the ultrasound scan is performed.

Momma Mentoring

Alternatives provides Momma Mentoring services to assist, encourage, and educate mothers. The challenges they face are great, but so are the rewards. Our desire is to partner with and support them as they pour into their children.

New to Alternatives in 2025, 24/7 Nurse Chat bridges the gap with fast, real-time communication, helping Alternatives build trust and provide meaningful support instantly through an intuitive messaging platform and resources.

Abortion-vulnerable women are met in their time of need. Almost 50% of client-initiated conversations start after standard hours. Using mobile messaging and app-less video chat, we can also reach new clients right where they are. Women facing unplanned pregnancies immediately grab their phones to search for help online. 24/7 Nurse Chat is ready to support them. Abortion-vulnerable clients are also offered life-giving relationships.

“Adding 24/7 Nurse Chat has significantly strengthened the way we care for clients by providing around-the-clock access to medical support, local resources, and scheduling assistance. Our staff also uses the platform to book appointments, follow up with current clients, and ensure timely, consistent care. 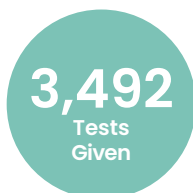

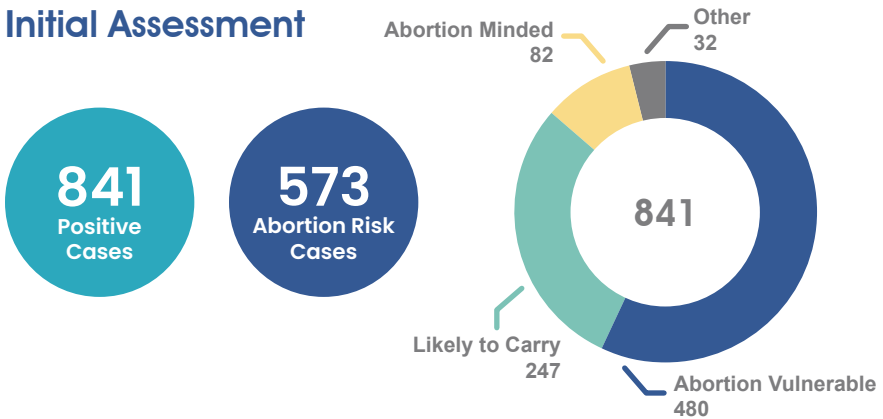

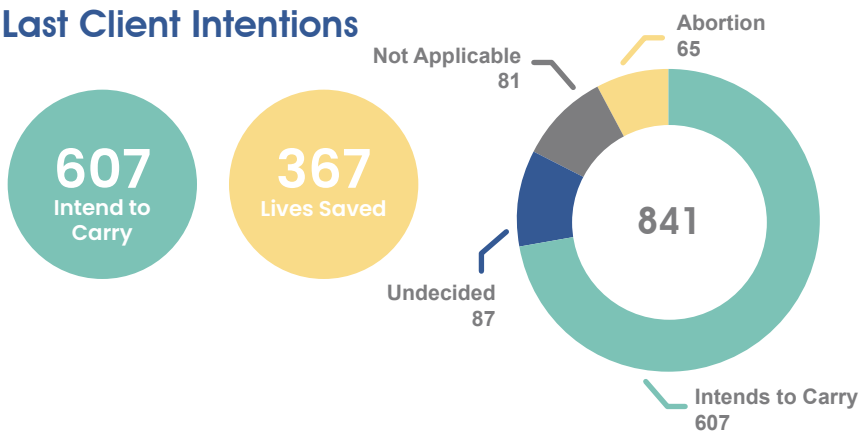
Initial Assessment is how the client may feel about their pregnancy before receiving any of our services.
