Good afternoon, everyone! and welcome to today's game as Barnstaple Athletic step on to home turf for the first time this season and a warm North Devon welcome to today's opposition, Plymstock Oaks for what promises to be a thunderous game, and we wish them a fantastic day.

When these two meet last season it was honours even as both sides won their respective home matches with Athletic Losing by the narrow margin 30-25 before returning the compliment at Pottington Road winning 29- 14.

Plymstock Oaks, who finished fourth last season eleven points adrift of Athletic in third, arrive in North Devon fresh off a thrilling, high-scoring 57-41 victory over newly promoted Torquay, showing their intent right from the start.

For athletic their fortunes faired much worse on opening day as Paignton exacted revenge in Emphatic Fashion, beating Barnstaple Athletic 50-19 in a stunning reversal of fortunes avenging a heavy 50-26 defeat to Athletic last season.

Paignton delivered a powerful statement to the Counties 1 Tribute Ale Western West League and immediately established the "Cherries" as serious contenders for promotion. I

From the outset, the home side displayed a level of intensity that Athletic struggled to match. Despite a spirited performance and two first-half tries from the prolific Ashlee Crouch, the visitors found themselves on the wrong end of a 31-12 score line at the break.

Any hopes of a second-half comeback were swiftly extinguished by a relentless Paignton offense. Barnstaple's attack was stifled for much of the half, only managing to add to their score in the 67th minute when Jacob Mascall crossed the line. Harvey Rostock added the conversion, his second of the day, but it was consolation in a match dominated by the hosts.

Today Barnstaple Athletic will need to recapture the form that saw them secure a try-scoring bonus-point win in this fixture last season, a 29-14 triumph. To help that cause is the return of several squad members including Troy Willis at centre teaming up with Euan Kent, Luke Knight at Fly and Brendan Darley in the pack.

The Tics will need to be at their very best to get the result against a fellow title hopeful, which for us supporters will mean a fantastic and highly entertaining game to watch.

Some words from Athletic Coach Luke Berry


Just like that, we are back with another season ahead of us and one that we are excited to get stuck into.

Barnstaple Chiefs Open Campaign with Gritty Bonus-Point Victory

The Chiefs launched their National 2 West season in impressive fashion on Saturday, securing a hard-fought 24-17 bonus-point win against Old Redcliffians in a match defined by determined defence and a battling team performance. The collective effort was so pronounced that the sponsors, Chichester Homes, broke with tradition, awarding the Man of the Match honour to the entire Barnstaple front row rather than an individual player and well deserved it was.

The Chiefs signalled their intent from the opening whistle, dominating possession and territory for the first twenty minutes. An early lineout saw the pack drive a maul an impressive thirty yards down the pitch, pinning Old Reds on their own try line. Despite a series of pick-and-go attempts, the visitors' defence held firm, repelling the early assault aided by some handling errors from a Chiefs side shaking off early-season rust.

It was against the run of play that Old Redcliffians struck first, converting their maiden entry into the Barnstaple 22 into a converted try to lead 0-7.

Undeterred, the Chiefs mounted a swift and powerful response. Their forwards began to dominate the exchanges, and the pressure told with two converted tries in a decisive ten-minute spell. Brandon Moore and new signing Emosi Nadaubale both crossed the whitewash, overturning the deficit to establish a 14-7 lead.

A late penalty from Old Reds before the break narrowed the gap, sending the teams into halftime with the score at 14-10, setting the stage for a tense second-half battle.

The Chiefs' statement of intent was immediate after the break. Just three minutes into the half, Bertie Stretch crossed the try line, extending the home side's lead and setting the tone for a half of intense pressure. While Old Reds fought desperately for a route back into the game, they were repeatedly met by a ferocious Barnstaple defensive wall. The Chiefs' tackling, particularly through the midfield, snuffed out developing attacks and secured crucial turnovers, frustrating the visitors' efforts.

The pivotal moment arrived ten minutes later. Dominic Robson, a persistent threat with ball in hand all afternoon, powered over from short range for the decisive score.

The try secured the valuable try bonus point and ignited the home support, as a crowd of over 700 roared their approval in a moment of pure celebration with the Barum Roar.

Despite creating further chances, the Chiefs were thwarted by resolute last-ditch defending from Old Reds. The final ten minutes saw a dramatic shift in pressure, as the visitors mounted a sustained assault on the Barnstaple line. After scoring a converted try in the 73rd minute to close the gap to seven points, Old Reds threw everything at the Chiefs' defence in a desperate search for a draw.

In a nail-biting finale, the Chiefs were camped on their own line, repelling wave after wave of attacks. Their monumental defensive effort held firm until a final turnover sealed a hard-fought and well-earned victory, sparking celebrations from players and supporters alike.

So there we have it, a big, big effort by the Chiefs to grab the win on their first National 2 match for a couple of seasons. What stood out for me was firstly the defence which was fantastic all game and particularly during those final five minutes. Most of the kicking was also very, very good given that wretched wind, and we can forgive several of the lineout misses as judging them in such conditions must have been a nightmare.

The Chiefs are going to need all their skill and might for what looks likely to be a tough challenge ahead.
