# **What is a School-Parent Compact?**

A school-parent compact is a written agreement that parents, students, and teachers develop together. The compact explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. Parents, students, and the school team up to create a group of ideas that can assist students with realizing their



potential. This becomes the Compact that is signed as an agreement by all those involved in the child's education. Annual meetings are held to review the Compact and make necessary changes based on student needs.

Making sure my child arrives at school or boards the bus on time


Helping my child with learning at home to reinforce what's taught at school
