

What is a School-Parent Compact?

A school-parent compact is a written agreement that parents, students, and teachers develop together. The compact explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. Parents, students, and the school team up to create a group of ideas that can assist students with realizing their potential. This becomes the Compact that is signed as an agreement by all those involved in the child's education. Annual meetings are held to review the Compact and make necessary changes based on student needs.

Using my device(s) in accordance with the school's policy

Not disrupting learning by talking over the teacher, refusing to comply with my teacher's request, using profanity, horse playing, talking with peers without permission, or engaging in any other behavior that disrupts the learning process

Speaking to a trusted adult when I have concerns and not fighting or confronting anyone directly

Being accountable and responsible for myself and being respectful of myself, my peers, and the adults on campus

Fulfilling the intent of the campus by participating in one or more sports programs and/or career pathways

Parents are committed to...

Monitoring student progress and grades regularly via Canvas

Ensuring my child acts in accordance with the Student/Parent Handbook, the Student Code of Conduct, and the Dress Code

Sending my child to school each day with a minimum of a notebook and a writing utensil

Refraining from texting/calling my child during the school day; I will support the individual teacher's cell phone use policy during the instructional day

Making sure my child arrives at school or boards the bus on time

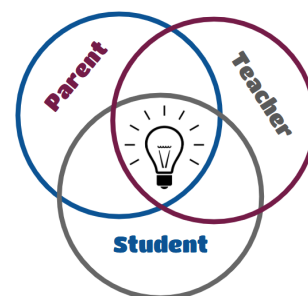
Helping my child with learning at home to reinforce what's taught at school
