Enigmatic and driven, he is one of the faces of modern Argentinian winemaking and in 2019 was voted one of South America's most exciting winemakers by Decanter.

CHILE

This slender country boasts an ideal climate, diverse geography, and a winemaking heritage dating back to the 16th century when Spanish conquistadors brought grapevines to the region.

Chile's wine industry is characterized by its impressive range of terroirs. From the cool, coastal vineyards influenced by the Pacific Ocean to the warmer valleys sheltered by the Andes Mountains, Chile's diverse microclimates contribute to the creation of exceptional wines.

One of Chile's signature grape varieties is Carménère, a red grape that was mistakenly identified as Merlot for decades. Today, Chilean Carménère is celebrated for its unique spicy and herbal notes. Additionally, the country produces outstanding Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, and Sauvignon Blanc, among other varieties.

The Chilean wine scene is also known for its sustainability efforts. Many wineries prioritize eco-friendly practices, making Chile a global leader in sustainable wine production.

COLCHAGUA VALLEY



Caliterra - Alberto Eckholt

Caliterra was established in 1996 as a joint venture between the families of Robert Mondavi and Viñedos familia Chadwick. In January 2004 Viñedos familia Chadwick became the sole owners of Caliterra, at the heart of which is the impressive 1000ha Caliterra Estate.

The name Caliterra is taken from 'Calidad' Spanish for quality and 'Tierra' – land. The wine making philosophy of Caliterra is to produce environmentally friendly, quality wines in the heart of the Colchagua Valley where 247ha are currently under vine on prime hillside sites resulting in high quality fruit and complex wines.

Caliterra has pioneered a move to sustainable wine production with the country's leading consultant. The four pillars of this approach are sustainable viticulture, community commitment, environmental preservation and eco-friendly packaging – for more information see 'green matters' Caliterra is certified sustainable – one of the very first Chilean wineries to achieve this accreditation.



CALITERRA TRIBUTO GRAN RESERVA MALBEC



Polished ruby-red, with ripe blackberry and plum fruit, hints of spice, sweet almond and mineral undercurrent, velvety tannins, bright acidity, fresh finish.



CALITERRA RESERVA MERLOT



Juicy plum and red cherry, soft violet and gentle spice. Smooth tannins, bright acidity, easy-drinking, medium-bodied.



CALITERRA RESERVA CHARDONNAY



Golden-yellow with green hues, crisp and bright; think green apple, citrus zest, mango-pear and mineral notes, with refreshing acidity.



CALITERRA PETREO MALBEC



Juicy dark-fruit and spice: deep ruby Malbec with blackberry and pomegranate, violet floral lift, stony minerality, fresh acidity and fine tannins.



ENGLAND

England has emerged as an exciting and unexpected player in the world of wine production in recent years. The country's wine industry, once considered a novelty, has been gaining recognition and respect for its quality and innovation.

England's wine regions, primarily in the southern part of the country, benefit from a climate that has become increasingly favourable for grape cultivation due to climate change. The chalky soils of regions like Sussex, Kent, and Hampshire are reminiscent of Champagne in France, making them well-suited for growing classic sparkling wine grape varieties such as Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. English sparkling wines have garnered international acclaim and have been likened to some of the best from Champagne.

English still wines, especially whites made from Bacchus a, are also making waves for their unique flavours and qualities. English winemakers often focus on producing high-quality, small-batch wines with a strong emphasis on sustainability and organic practices.

Tourism in English wine regions is on the rise, with vineyard tours, tastings, and wine-related experiences becoming increasingly popular. Jacques Bruwer, born in 1966, literally grew up in the vineyards, so it came as no surprise that he decided to follow in his father's footsteps. After completing school, he studied wine-making at Elsenburg Agricultural College in Stellenbosch. In those days, the 10 best students of the Cellar Technology course were allocated a bloc of Chardonnay grapes to work with. "It turned out to be a very significant experience", he recalls. "My father always said that to him the ultimate in wine-making was to produce a 'Champagne' in the traditional way and that is what I decided to do with my block of Chardonnay."

After studying the science of winemaking for several years, he gained further practical experience in both Germany and France and then, in 1990, joined his father on the family farm. With regard to both the latest equipment and vinification techniques, Jacques is in the forefront of innovation. He does not believe in just copying others. "If you copy you will always be second best. I am not a guy who likes to do the same thing year after year. I always embrace a fresh challenge."
