### Seafarer Talks



An interview with COFF Glenn Bruno Anthony Dsilva, who received the MOL Loyalty Award for being a Seafarer in MOL Q. Any incidents that comes to your mind when thinking of for more than 10 years. Here are his views and answers to a couple of questions put to him:

#### Q. How did you get to choosing this profession?

#### your time at sea?



On February 12, 2025, MOLMI inaugurated the K-SIM, a cutting-edge simulation system by Kongsberg, to support the expanding MOL LNG fleet. This LNG Full Mission Cargo Simulator is the first of its kind in India, complemented by the installation of six LNG steam ship desktop simulators.

Capt. Animesh Hore, GM of GMRMO, expressed great satisfaction and confidence that this training tool will further the professional development of MOLMI seafarers and enhance safety to achieve the MOL 4 zeros.

Kongsberg's simulation models meet STCW requirements and each K-Sim Cargo model has achieved DNV Standard of Compliance as a Class A simulator, adhering to the latest DNV Standards. Their modular software configuration uses true physical and gas laws, providing realistic simulations. Kongsberg's project execution processes include regular status reporting, design checkpoints, acceptance testing procedures, comprehensive system training, and a long-term service and support program.

With over 40 years of experience and numerous installations worldwide, Kongsberg remains a leader in maritime simulators. MOLMI is a DNV-approved Maritime Training Provider (MT ST029) and conducts multiple DNV ST008 accredited courses.



## 16 Medifacts-



As temperatures are soaring, maintaining proper hydration is necessary for overall health and well-being. - Maintaining Cognitive Function: Staying hydrated helps keep the mind sharp and focused whether it's at work or at home.
- 4. Preventing Heat-Related Illnesses: Proper hydration helps prevent heat-related illnesses like heat exhaustion and heatstroke.

#### Recognizing Signs of Dehydration

Be vigilant for symptoms of dehydration, which can include dry mouth, fatigue, dizziness, rapid heartbeat and muscle cramps Severe dehydration may lead to confusion, fainting, and organ failure.

#### Strategies for Staying Hydrated

- Increase Fluid Intake: Aim to drink at least 2-3 litres (approximately 8 cups) of fluids daily.


Don't rely only on caffeinated drinks

Here is a quick and easy Cucumber-Mint Hydration Drink recipe that's refreshing, hydrating, and perfect for the hot weather:

#### Ingredients:

- 1 medium cucumber (sliced)
- 1-2 sprigs fresh mint leaves
- 1–2 tablespoons honey (optional, for sweetness)
- 4 cups cold water
- 1-2 tablespoons lemon juice (optional)
- Ice cubes (optional)

Slice the cucumber into thin rounds. You can also lightly crush the mint leaves to release more flavour. In a large pitcher, add the cucumber slices and mint leaves. If you're using lemon juice or honey, add them as well. Pour in cold water and stir. Refrigerate for at least 30 minutes to allow the flavours to infuse. You can add ice cubes to the drink before serving. Pour into glass, garnish with a few mint leaves and enjoy!
