Message of RI President Rtn. Francesco Arezzo



This November, as we celebrate The Rotary Foundation, I invite you to consider not only what we give but why we give. The Foundation is more than a fund for projects. It is the beating heart of our promise that service, rooted in trust and friendship, can create lasting change.

Our Action Plan calls us to increase our impact, and the Foundation is how we make this vision real. Since 1988, Rotary and our partners have immunized nearly 3 billion children against polio. We have committed more than \$2.6 billion to this cause, and last year alone we directed \$146 million toward the final push for eradication. These numbers are significant, but the true impact is not in statistics — it is in the lives of children who will never again fear polio. It is in the hope restored to families and the peace built in communities once defined by disease.

But polio is only one story among many. Each year, Rotary Peace Centers train new generations of leaders who will transform conflict into dialogue and division into understanding. In 2023-24, nearly 100 new fellows began their studies, continuing a legacy of more than 1,800 peacebuilders from over 140 countries. When we invest in them, we are planting seeds of peace that will bear fruit for decades to come.

The Foundation also touches lives through district and global grants, supporting projects large and small. A clean water well for a rural community, scholarships for young professionals, medical care in the wake of disaster — these are not temporary gestures, but steps toward dignity, resilience, and opportunity. This is how Rotary service becomes lasting impact. And when natural disasters strike, our Foundation allows Rotary to act quickly with disaster response grants.

Our Foundation is not about what we can do alone but what we can do together. Each contribution, no matter its size, joins with others to create a collective act of faith in humanity and in the future.

The last mile of any great journey is always the hardest. We see this in our final steps toward ending polio, in our work for peace, and in every project that seeks to lift people out of despair. Yet every time we give, we declare that our work will continue regardless of the challenge.

This November, let us give with gratitude, with joy, and with hope. Through our Foundation, we Unite for Good, and in doing so, we leave behind not only projects but a legacy of peace, trust, and Service Above Self.

The Four-Way Test has served as a moral compass for members and their friends to live by their professional and personal relationships.



Rotary International District 3192 hosted UDHYAM 2025 — the Intercity General Forum (ICGF) on Vocational Service — at the majestic Anantya Palace Grounds, Bengaluru, under the leadership of District Governor Rtn. Prof. Elizabeth Cherian and hosted by Rotary Bangalore Udyog.

Themed Enterprise, Endeavour, and Purposeful Action, the event was a resounding celebration of one of Rotary's avenues — Vocational Service — which integrates professional excellence with ethical leadership and community upliftment.

A Gathering of Visionaries and Change-Makers

Over 800 Rotarians, professionals, business leaders, educators, and youth gathered for an inspiring evening of fellowship, learning, and collaboration. The event was inaugurated with an interfaith prayer and cultural invocation song, “Hachhevu Kannada Deepa”, celebrating Karnataka's linguistic and cultural heritage.

The forum was graced by eminent dignitaries including Chief Guest Mr. Ravi Tennety (Managing Director, NTT), Vocational Excellence Awardee Mr. V. Srinivasa Raju, Rtn. Dr. Radhakrishna P. M., and Rtn. Ganesh Balakrishnan among others.

Inspiring Addresses and Key Highlights

District Governor Rtn. Prof. Elizabeth Cherian, in her keynote, emphasized that while the world evolves with technology, “human relationships will never go out of style.” She called upon Rotarians to refine their professional and personal lives with ethics, empathy, and excellence, noting that “Rotary blends enterprise with empathy — and that a handshake, a smile, and a helping hand still matter the most.”

Chief Guest Mr. Ravi Tennety underscored the importance of practical, skill-based learning over theoretical education, introducing the concept of a “Skill Passport” to digitally record each student's vocational journey. He praised Rotary's CNC Operator Training Programme as a transformational model for youth empowerment.

Mr. V. Srinivasa Raju, recipient of the Rotary Vocational Excellence Award, shared his visionary initiative of planting 3 crore saplings in collaboration with 39 spiritual leaders, merging faith with ecological responsibility. His call to action — “kudi kudi madi nodi” (plant, nurture, observe, protect) — resonated deeply with Rotary's ideals of service and sustainability.

The panel discussion “Hatke Career”, moderated by Rtn. Ramkumar Seshu with panellists Rtn. Sridhara Murthy, Rtn. Sandhya Raghunandan, and Rtn. Arnav Raja, inspired young professionals to pursue unconventional career paths driven by passion and purpose.

A Celebration of Vocational Spirit

The evening culminated in a vibrant cultural performance by Smt. Savithakka Troupe, celebrating Karnataka's rich folk traditions and the dignity of labour. The event closed with dinner and fellowship, fostering deeper bonds among Rotarians.

Rotary Siddarabetta in association with their CSR partners - LSG and YSF, donated 11 sewing machines to Yelerampura Organisation, which is a Training Centre to provide training to underprivileged women, enhancing their tailoring skills so that they are gainfully employed.



RB Indiranagar in association with Unnati has launched a series of Career oriented training programs for Commerce graduate and post graduate students. Unnati currently offers two Skill Development programs - Business Associates and Banking. These 35 days courses include training in English Communication, Life Skills, Tally and basic Banking followed by placement in retail chains, BPOs, Banks and other service sectors. These modules prepare students for NISM Series V certification, significantly improving their employability.



Rotary Nelamangala in association with 10 other clubs distributed 46 Sewing machines to underprivileged women who were also trained.



Rotary Club of Tumkur Prerna conducted a 3 day Employability Skills Training program for the students of Siddaganga Polytechnic, Tumkur.


Disease Prevention & Treatment


Other News

In November, Rotary clubs worldwide highlight how the Foundation turns generosity into action. Clubs and Districts use November to educate members and the community on the Foundation's vital work and to encourage financial contributions, ensuring the long-term viability of the humanitarian and educational programs.

Since its founding over 100 years ago, TRF has spent US \$4billion on life-changing, sustainable projects.

Examples abound on the life changing impact of TRF contributions

Eradicating Polio

In India, TRF support was part of the broader partnership that led to India being certified as polio-free.

Maternal and Child Health

In Uganda, grants funded training for healthcare workers to use ultrasound devices to diagnose life-threatening conditions during pregnancy.

In Brazil, Foundation grants helped a neonatal intensive care unit in the Ribeira Valley, which helped halve the infant mortality rate in the region.

Clean Water and Sanitation

In Sri Lanka a matching grant helped build sanitation facilities for 15 families in a community.

Solar-powered pumps and lighting for a tribal village in Maharashtra addressed both drinking water and irrigation concerns.

Education, Vocational Training and Economic Development

TRF supported a school relocation, sanitation installation and a small-scale enterprise in Nicaragua.

In Nigeria, a polio survivor started a business making bicycle wheelchairs for other polio survivors, enabled by a TRF grant.

Protecting the Environment

The foundation has provided eco-stoves in Guatemala that reduce carbon emissions and decrease the amount of firewood needed.

Building Peace and International Understanding

One of the TRF's area of focus is peace and conflict resolution. Fellows trained through the Peace Centres supported by the TRF, work internationally helping collaboration across borders and cultures and working towards more inclusive communities.

The Rotary Foundation stands as a powerful testament to what can be achieved when compassion meets action. Through its unwavering commitment, the Foundation continues to transform lives and strengthen communities across the globe. Its work reminds us that meaningful change begins with a shared vision of service above self- a vision that continues to inspire generations of Rotarians and partners worldwide. As the Foundation looks toward the future, its legacy of hope, generosity, and global fellowship will continue to lead the way towards a more just, healthy and peaceful world.

Rotary's Walkathon Marks World Polio Day 2025

Bengaluru, Oct (City Times): In observance of World Polio Day on 24th October 2025, Rotary District 3192 organized a Walkathon on Thursday, 23rd October at 6:30 PM, started from the Kempe Gowda Statue at Vidhana Soudha and ending at the Rotary House of Friendship, Lavelle Road. The event celebrates Rotary's decades-long leadership in eradicating polio and calls on citizens to unite for a polio-free world. A Legacy of Leadership in Polio Eradication. For more than four decades, Rotary International



has stood at the forefront of the global campaign to eradicate polio. In 1979, Rotary launched its first immunization project in the Philippines, setting in motion a worldwide movement that would change the course of public health. By 1985, Rotary introduced PolioPlus — the first and largest private-sector initiative supporting global immunization — raising an unprecedented \$247 million, more than double its original goal. Three years later, in 1988, Rotary

became a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI), joining forces with the World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and later the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. At that time, polio paralyzed more than 350,000 children annually across 125 countries. Today, thanks to this historic partnership, polio cases have been reduced by 99.9%, and more than 2.5 billion children have been immunized — marking one of the greatest achievements

in global health history. Rotary's Global Partnerships and Impact: Rotary's collaboration with the World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF, and other partners has been pivotal in reaching the world's most remote communities, building trust in vaccines, and mobilizing the resources needed to protect every child. Rotary has contributed over \$1 billion to UNICEF alone, supporting the distribution of more than 1 billion doses of oral polio vaccine each year — according to over half of the global supply.
