FULL MOON HIKE - \$10

Pre-registration Required

Jan 2 - 4pm-6pm, Feb 2, Mar 3 - 5pm-7pm

Ages 14 & up (participants under 18 require a paid chaperone)

Location: Pineland Farms Market

Gather your friends or family and experience the beauty of the night under a glowing full moon. We'll set off for a moderate level hike through one of our many scenic trails. After our walk, unwind by a cozy firepit and take in breathtaking views of the moonlit sky, surrounded by stars and the peaceful sounds of nature. If conditions allow, we will be snowshoeing for the winter. Snowshoes will be provided, but feel free to bring your own poles. If trail conditions are not suitable for hiking or snowshoeing, we will be utilizing the Pineland roadways for our experience. **Required Gear:** Waterproof and warm footwear. Gloves, a hat, and layers to stay comfortable during our adventure. Water bottle and headlamp or flashlight

NEEDLE FELTING FOR BEGINNERS - \$20

Join us for a needle felting program designed for absolute beginners. Needle felting is a type of textile art which uses specialized needles to form wool into 3-D shapes, creating unique art pieces. Participants will get the chance to meet our sheep, learn about how wool is processed, and create their own felted chicken to take home using a combination of dyed wool and natural, undyed wool from our own sheep. Participants of all skill levels are welcome.

VERNAL EQUINOX FOREST BATHING - \$20

MAPLE SUGARING FOR ADULTS - \$10




