Do we have dock work in our future at MMP?

Editor's Note: This article is the product of discussions between Warren François and Side Lights editor Ken Elkins.

With a favorable vote from the membership this month, I will be installed as Commander of America's Boating Club-Charlotte. It's an honor to lead this fine group of people dedicated to boating education, safety and comradery.

I suffered some health problems in December that required hospitalization, but I'm back on my feet and ready to serve the membership of the Squadron.

I joined the Charlotte Power Squadron in 2002 and became increasingly involved in its management during the last two years, having gone through the ranks of the executive committee and bridge. There I learned that the Squadron has been very well managed by a bridge and committee of seasoned and proven leaders.

We stand today with strong financials, good support from America's Boating Club nationally and an asset that few squadrons enjoy: a place on the lake, Merit Mark Point. We're in the process of installing security at MMP and crews are often at the site to maintain and improve the facility.

If we have any deficiency at Merit Mark, it's the need for substantial improvement on two of the three floating dock systems. Instead of patching the docks, we should start a program to entirely replace the surfaces of the floating portions of the piers.

We could finance this several ways, including simply paying for the materials and supplies out of the funds dedicated to the maintenance and improvement of the facility. That would get us going quickly, and on warmer days of winter we could have crews of volunteers begin work and probably have it completed by the time spring rolls around.

Another way would be to start a fundraiser to finance the work. I personally like the idea of having our own Poker Run, paid for by participants, squadron members and their guests.

Tell me what you think. Do we patch the docks or conduct a refurbishing campaign?
