Home Energy

Fill out Conservation.org's easy carbon footprint calculator to determine your current environmental impact.

Expand your knowledge of energy burden by completing C3's Energy Burden Calculator.

Fill out C3's DIY Energy Equipment Inventory.

Research local, state, and federal financial incentives to see if you qualify for cost-saving programs.

Obtain a home energy check-up from the Local Energy Alliance Program (LEAP) to learn about the efficiency of your home.

- Research high-efficiency heat pumps, water heaters, and appliances for your future upgrade.
- Fill out Google's Project Sunroof tool to assess your viability of going solar.

Transportation

Calculate your savings if you were to switch from your gas-fueled car to a hybrid or electric car.

Food

Watch an educational film or video about the impact of our diet.

Explore C3's policy reports and recommendations for how we can advance climate action in our community.
