

What is an Access to Higher Education Diploma?

For many people, achieving their dream career is not always a straightforward path, and traditional qualifications don't fit everyone's journey to success.

That's where Access to Higher Education Diplomas come in, designed to help adults gain the skills and qualifications they need to progress to University and beyond!

What is an Access to Higher Education Diploma?

An Access to HE Diploma is a nationally recognised Level 3 qualification that enables people without traditional qualifications to get into University.

Who are Access to HE Diplomas for?

Access to HE Diplomas are perfect for adults aged 19 and over who want to:

- Return to education to achieve the qualifications needed for University
- Switch careers
- Expand their skills to gain a promotion at work

What is it equivalent to?

Access to HE Diplomas are equivalent to other Level 3 qualifications like A Levels. They are recognised by Universities as an alternative to traditional academic qualifications.

How long does an Access to HE Diploma take?

Access to HE Diplomas take one year to complete and are offered as either a daytime or evening option. They are typically studied two days a week, from September to June.

Can you study an Access to HE Diplomas online?

The Distance Learning Access to HE Diploma (Health) is studied 100% online. This means that for this particular course, you don't need to come into the College at all, giving you extra flexibility to fit your course around your life and other responsibilities.



If you are aged 19 to 23 and you do not already hold a full Level 3 qualification (such as two A Levels or a Level 3 BTEC Diploma), your course will be FREE.

If you are aged 19 to 23 and you already have a full Level 3 qualification, or if you are aged 24 or over on the start date of your course, you will have to pay fees. However, you can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to pay for part of, or the full cost of, your course.

Did you know that an Access to HE Diploma is cheaper than a foundation year?

Access to HE Diplomas are a lot cheaper than studying a foundation year or year 0 at University, offering an affordable pathway to Higher Education that is tailored to prepare you for your future.

Advanced Learner Loan

If you are aged 19 or over at the start of your course, you can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover your tuition fee through Student Finance England via www.gov.uk/student-finance.

This loan is designed to pay for part of, or the full cost of, your tuition. You'll only have to start making repayments after you complete your course and are earning over £27,295.





Some degrees require English and maths qualifications – and it's important to have these qualifications before you begin an Access to HE Diploma.

If you don't have a Grade 4 (C) or above in English and maths or are not working towards a Level 2 in maths and English, we can help.

Studying a Functional Skills or GCSE qualification is a great place to start before beginning your Access to HE Diploma. These courses are FREE for anyone who is 19+ and doesn't have a previous Grade 4 (C) or above in these subjects.

Functional Skills - English

Entry Level 1, 2 & 3 and Level 1 & 2

This qualification aims to develop your skills and confidence by helping you to improve your skills at a level appropriate to your needs and competence.

You will develop your reading, writing, speaking and listening skills in a number of different ways, practising skills which you will need in your everyday life.

You will be taught using a variety of interactive IT resources alongside formal classroom teaching.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements, learners will be assessed at induction.

Functional Skills - Maths

Entry Level 1, 2 & 3 and Level 1 & 2

This qualification aims to develop your understanding of numbers and your ability to manipulate numbers efficiently and confidently and apply these skills to solve everyday problems.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements, learners will be assessed at induction.

GCSE English Language

Level 2

This qualification provides you with the skills and abilities you need to investigate and analyse language and to experiment and use language creatively. This course will develop your skills in the four language skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening.

Entry requirements

You must have achieved a Grade 3 (D) in GCSE English (language or literature) OR a Level 2 literacy qualification such as Functional Skills OR will have satisfactorily passed a short reading and writing task issued by the College.

GCSE Maths

Level 2

GCSE mathematics is a one-year course designed to enable students to obtain at least a Grade 4 (C). The course covers number, algebra, statistics and geometry.

Entry requirements

You must provide evidence of obtaining a Grade 3 (D) already in GCSE mathematics or be assessing at Level 2 Functional Skills.

Business Studies - Level 3

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: Skills Education Group **When:** Daytime and evening study

Price: £3,022

Overview:

On this course you will study a range of modules that provide you with a great grounding in the fundamentals of businesses, their management and context.

This includes business organisation, management and leadership, as well as wider contexts and specialisms including finance, marketing and entrepreneurship.

Modules may include:

- Human Resource Management

Overview:

This course is for you if you are interested in pursuing a career in the computing and digital industry.

Modules may include:

- Computer Systems

- Database Applications

- Event Drive Programming
- Mobile Development
- Systems Analysis and Design
- · Maths for Computing
- Web Page Design and Production

Careers/University Opportunities:

Applicants must be working towards

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: AIM Awards

When: Daytime study

Price: £5,760

Overview:

This course is a great choice for you if you are interested in pursuing a career in the engineering sector. You will study mechanical and electrical engineering subjects together with chemical engineering and higher mathematics.

Modules may include:

- Electrical Principles
- Electronic Circuits
- Mechanical Power Transmission Systems
- Frameworks and Structures
- Advanced Maths
- Environmental Chemistry
- · Academic Study Skills
- Progression to HE
- Plus, other topics in relation to Electrical and Mechanical Engineering

Careers/University Opportunities:

This qualification will provide you with a range of transferable skills allowing you to progress onto a range of our HE courses at University Centre Middlesbrough (UCM).

Past students have progressed onto the Higher National Certificate in Engineering at UCM; pathways include Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Instrumentation Operations Engineering, Manufacturing Engineering or Mechanical Engineering. After completing the Higher National Certificate students can progress onto the Higher National Diploma and then complete the BEng (Hons) Engineering top-up degree.



Entry Requirements:

Due to the nature of this programme, you must demonstrate the ability to be working at a minimum of Level 2 in mathematics and English.

This can be demonstrated by your achievement of a Grade 4 (C) or equivalent in GCSE English, maths, and science, or through a diagnostics test at interview.



Health - Nursing/Paramedic/Midwifery - Level 3

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: Skills and Education Group (SEG)

When: Daytime, evening and distance learning courses available

Price: £5,040

Overview:

This course is a great choice if you are interested in pursuing a career in the health sector.

You will have the opportunity to work with aspects of applied human biology, immunopathology, psychological and sociological aspects of health as well as value-based health care and contemporary issues in health.

Modules may include:

- Poverty in Contemporary Britain
- · Mental Health
- Professionalism and Multidisciplinary Teams
- Psychological Perspectives in Health
- Safeguarding
- Nutrition and Digestion
- Cardiovascular and Respiratory Emergencies

Careers/University Opportunities:

This qualification will provide you with a range of transferable skills, allowing you to progress onto a range of HE courses.

Past students have progressed onto our foundation degrees in Health, Wellbeing and Social Care, Early Childhood Practice, Social and Public Sector Studies and Youth, Childhood and Community Studies and then have then progressed to complete a relevant top-up degree offered at University Centre Middlesbrough.



Entry Requirements:

You must have both maths and English at Level 2 or above for the Diploma in Health Science Professions.

Experience in the care industry will also be taken into consideration if you have not been in education for some time.

You will be asked to complete a short personal statement detailing your Higher Education aspirations and any relevant skills or knowledge you currently have.

If you don't currently hold maths and English at Level 2, ask us about our 10-week Pre-Access course.

Law and Criminology - Level 3

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: Skills and Education Group (SEG)

When: Daytime study

Price: £3,022

Overview:

This course provides an introduction to the study of law. This course is for anyone thinking of applying to University to study either this discipline or a law related honours degree.

The units introduce students to the English Legal system, covering key areas of civil law, criminal law and the discipline of criminology. The ungraded units will prepare students for the extended writing skills required for undergraduate study.

Modules may include:

- The Court System and Legal Personnel
- Non-Fatal Offences
- The Law of Homicide
- The Law of Negligence
- Consumer Law
- Crimes of Dishonesty
- Law and Morality
- Miscarriage of Justice
- Sources of English Law
- The Elements of a Crime
- The Formation of a Contract

Careers/University Opportunities:

This course is suited to students who wish to study a Law, Criminology or joint degree. This could then lead to a career in legal professions and criminal justice agencies after undergraduate study.



Entry Requirements:

You should have a minimum of GCSE English and maths at Grade 4 or be working towards Level 2 functional skills or equivalent.



Policing - Level 3

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: AIM Awards

When: Daytime study

Price: £4,320

Overview:

This course will prepare you for University and for a career in the Police Force. It will develop your knowledge and skills in a range of different policing disciplines, developing your understanding of the powers of the police, the role of a police officer and associated partner agencies. The course will run one day per week between 9am and 6pm, plus home study.

Modules may include:

- Police Powers
- Evidence
- Homicide
- · Criminal Law and Procedures
- Introduction to Law Enforcement
- The Causes of Crime
- The Penal System
- Crime in Context
- · Academic Study Skills

Careers/University Opportunities:

After completing your course, you can progress to the Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship or a Professional Policing degree at University, or a degree related to policing and criminology.

Please also read the Police Officer entry requirements prior to applying for the course.



Entry Requirements:

You must have successfully completed GCSE English and maths at Grade 4 or above (C or above) or Functional Skills English and maths at Level 2 (discretion may be given for those currently awaiting results or working toward). You will also be required to submit two references.



Science - Level 3

Duration: 1 year

Awarding Body: Skills and Education Group (SEG)

When: Daytime study

Price: £3,384

Overview:

This course offers an exciting route to higher education and a new career in a range of science disciplines.

You will cover maths and English to support your studies and be graded on units in biology, chemistry and physics. There is also a focus on developing laboratory practical skills and analysis, which is integral to any science degree.

Modules may include:

- Infection and Immunity
- Organic Chemistry
- Conducting a Science Project
- Chemistry of Pollution
- Exponentials, Logarithms, Trigonometry and Series
